Zhitong 16-Inch Kids' Bicycle Instruction Manual

INTRODUCTION

Welcome to the Zhitong 16-inch Kids' Bicycle instruction manual. This document provides essential information for the safe assembly, operation, and maintenance of your child's new bicycle. Please read it thoroughly before use and retain it for future reference.

This bicycle is designed to help children develop balance and coordination, promoting healthy physical development. It features a durable carbon steel frame, pneumatic tires, and a convenient front basket.

SAFETY INSTRUCTIONS

- **Always wear a helmet:** Ensure your child wears a properly fitted helmet at all times while riding.
- **Supervision:** Children should always be supervised by an adult while riding.
- **Check before riding:** Before each ride, check that the brakes are functioning correctly, tires are adequately inflated, and all bolts and quick releases are securely tightened.
- **Riding environment:** Ride in safe, open areas away from traffic, steep hills, and obstacles.
- **Training wheels:** Training wheels are provided to assist with balance during the initial learning phase. Remove them once your child has developed sufficient balance.

SETUP AND ASSEMBLY

Assembly typically involves attaching the front wheel, handlebars, pedals, saddle, and basket. Follow these steps carefully:

Step 1: Attach the Front Wheel

Insert the front wheel into the fork. Ensure the brake calipers align correctly with the wheel rim. Secure the wheel using the provided nuts or quick-release mechanism, tightening them firmly.

Step 2: Install the Handlebar

Insert the handlebar stem into the fork's steerer tube. Adjust the height and angle for your child's comfort. Tighten the stem bolt securely to prevent movement.

Step 3: Install the Saddle

Insert the saddle post into the frame's seat tube. Adjust the saddle height so your child can comfortably touch the ground with their toes. Tighten the quick-release or bolt firmly.

Step 4: Attach the Pedals

Identify the left (L) and right (R) pedals. The left pedal tightens counter-clockwise, and the right pedal tightens clockwise. Thread them carefully into the crank arms and tighten with a wrench.

Step 5: Install the Front Basket

Attach the front basket to the handlebar using the provided brackets and screws. Ensure it is securely fastened and does not obstruct steering or braking.

OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

Riding with Training Wheels

The training wheels provide stability for beginners. Ensure they are adjusted so that the bicycle is slightly tilted, allowing the child to learn to balance. Once your child gains confidence and balance, the training wheels can be removed.

Braking

This bicycle is equipped with caliper brakes. Teach your child to gently squeeze both brake levers simultaneously to slow down and stop. Practice braking in a safe, open area until they are proficient.

Adjusting Seat Height

As your child grows, adjust the saddle height to ensure proper leg extension and comfort. The child should be able to touch the ground with their toes while seated, allowing for safe stops and starts.

MAINTENANCE

- **Tire Pressure:** Regularly check and maintain the recommended tire pressure (usually indicated on the tire sidewall) for optimal performance and safety.
- **Brakes:** Inspect brake pads for wear and ensure brake cables are not frayed. Adjust brake tension as needed for effective stopping power.
- **Chain:** Keep the chain clean and lubricated to ensure smooth operation, prevent rust, and extend its lifespan.
- **Bolts and Fasteners:** Periodically check all bolts, nuts, and quick releases for tightness. Loose fasteners can lead to instability and accidents.

- **Cleaning:** Clean the bicycle with a damp cloth and mild soap. Avoid high-pressure washing, which can damage bearings and other sensitive components.

For more complex repairs or adjustments, consult a professional bicycle mechanic.

TROUBLESHOOTING

Problem: Brakes are not effective.

Solution: Check brake pad alignment and wear. Adjust cable tension at the brake lever or caliper. Ensure brake levers are easily accessible and functional for the child.

Problem: Pedals are stiff or noisy.

Solution: Ensure pedals are securely tightened to the crank arms. Lubricate the pedal bearings if necessary. If noise persists, inspect for damage.

Problem: Training wheels are uneven.

Solution: Adjust the height of the training wheels to ensure the bike has a slight tilt, allowing the child to learn balance. Ensure they are securely fastened to the rear axle.

Problem: Bicycle feels unstable.

Solution: Check tire pressure in both wheels. Ensure all frame connections, wheel axles, handlebar, and saddle are securely tightened. Re-check assembly steps if recently assembled.
