INTRODUCTION

This manual provides essential instructions for the safe and efficient operation, installation, and maintenance of your Hamilton Beach Portable Dishwasher, Model HBDW180WHITE. Please read this manual thoroughly before using the appliance and retain it for future reference.

Key features of your dishwasher include:

- Portable design with wheels for easy relocation.
- Capacity for up to 8 standard place settings.
- Low water consumption for efficient use.
- Simple connection to most kitchen taps.
- Durable stainless steel interior.
- Compact size designed to fit under most kitchen cabinets.

SAFETY INFORMATION

Always follow basic safety precautions when using electrical appliances to reduce the risk of fire, electric shock, or injury. This dishwasher is intended for household use only.

- Ensure the dishwasher is properly grounded.
- Do not operate the dishwasher if it is damaged or malfunctioning.
- Keep children away from the dishwasher, especially during operation.
- Use only detergents and rinse aids specifically designed for automatic dishwashers.
- Do not touch the heating element during or immediately after use.
- Unplug the appliance before cleaning or performing maintenance.

PRODUCT COMPONENTS

Familiarize yourself with the main components of your portable dishwasher.

- **Upper Rack:** For smaller items like cups, glasses, and small bowls.
- **Lower Rack:** For plates, larger bowls, and pots.
- **Silverware Basket:** For forks, spoons, and knives.
- **Detergent Dispenser:** Located on the inner door panel.
- **Rinse Aid Dispenser:** Adjacent to the detergent dispenser.
- **Control Panel:** Located on the top front edge of the door.
- **Caster Wheels:** For mobility, with lockable features.

SETUP AND INSTALLATION

Proper setup ensures optimal performance and safety.

Unpacking

1. Carefully remove all packaging materials.
2. Inspect the dishwasher for any shipping damage. Report any damage immediately to your retailer.
3. Ensure all accessories are present: upper rack, lower rack, silverware basket, and quick connect adapter.

Positioning the Dishwasher

- Place the dishwasher on a flat, stable surface near a sink with a faucet.
- Ensure there is adequate space for the door to open fully.
- The dishwasher is equipped with caster wheels for easy movement. Lock the wheels once positioned.

Water Connection

1. Attach the quick connect adapter to your kitchen faucet. Ensure a tight seal to prevent leaks.
2. Connect the dishwasher's water inlet hose to the quick connect adapter.
3. Place the drain hose into the sink. Ensure it is securely positioned to prevent it from dislodging during operation.
4. Turn on the hot water faucet.

Electrical Connection

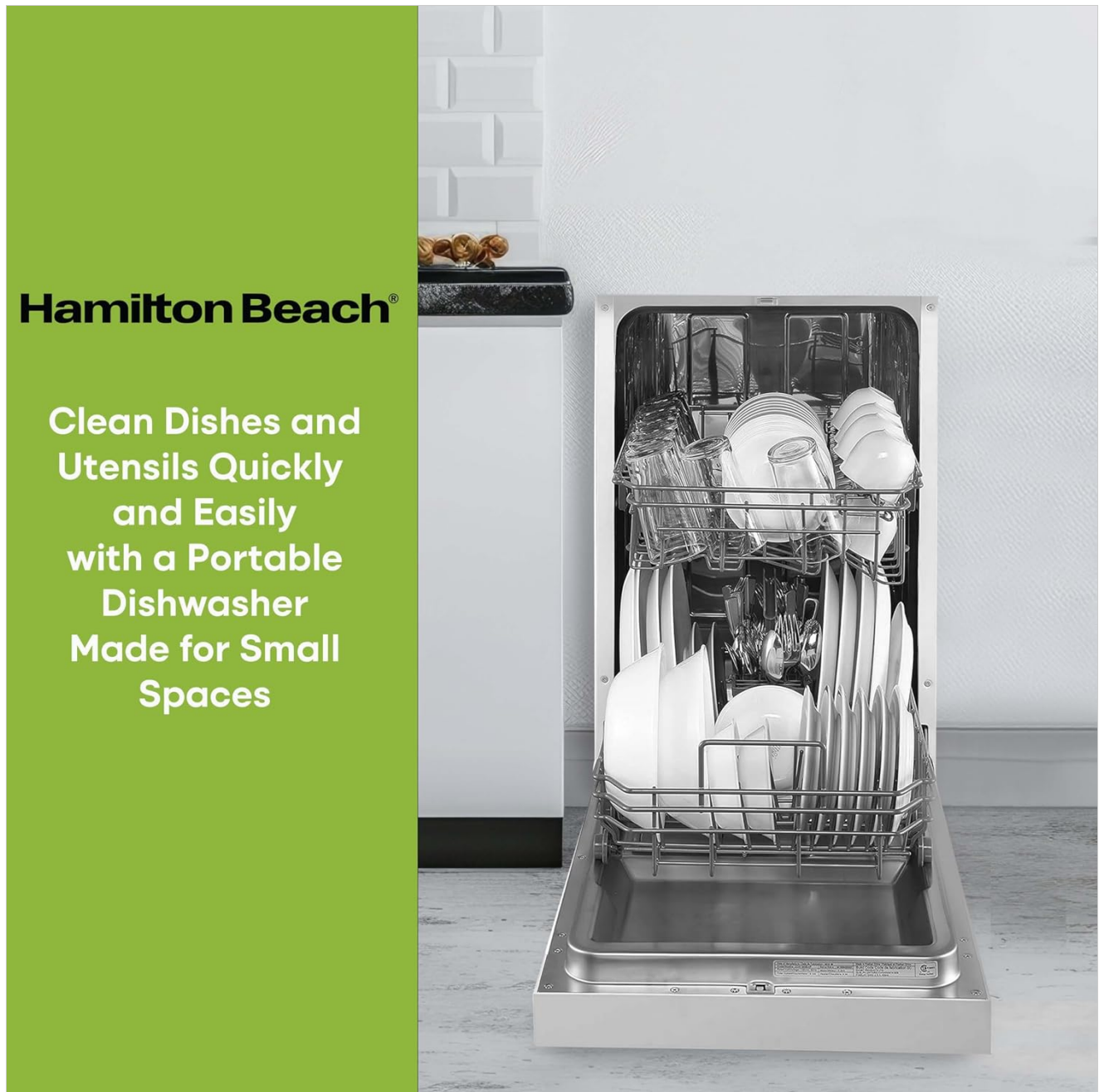
- Plug the dishwasher into a dedicated, grounded 120V electrical outlet.
- Do not use extension cords or adapters.

OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

Follow these steps for effective dishwashing.

Loading the Dishwasher

- Scrape off large food particles from dishes.
- Place larger items in the lower rack and smaller, delicate items in the upper rack.
- Ensure dishes do not block the spray arms.
- Place silverware in the basket with handles down for forks and spoons, and handles up for knives for safety.

Adding Detergent and Rinse Aid

- Fill the detergent dispenser with the recommended amount of automatic dishwasher detergent.
- Fill the rinse aid dispenser to the indicated level. Rinse aid helps with drying and prevents spots.

Selecting a Wash Cycle

Your dishwasher offers multiple wash cycles:

- **Normal:** For regularly soiled dishes.
- **Intensive:** For heavily soiled pots and pans.

- **Economy:** For lightly soiled dishes, uses less energy and water.
- **Glass:** Gentle cycle for delicate glassware.
- **Soak:** Pre-wash cycle for loosening stubborn food.
- **Rapid:** Quick wash for lightly soiled items that need to be cleaned fast.

Press the desired cycle button on the control panel. The LED display will indicate the selected cycle.

Starting the Dishwasher

1. Close the dishwasher door securely.
2. Press the "Start" button. The dishwasher will begin the selected cycle.

MAINTENANCE AND CARE

Regular maintenance ensures the longevity and efficiency of your dishwasher.

Cleaning the Exterior

- Wipe the exterior surfaces with a soft, damp cloth and mild detergent.
- Avoid abrasive cleaners or solvents.

Cleaning the Interior and Filters

- Regularly clean the spray arms to ensure nozzles are not clogged.
- Remove and clean the filter assembly at the bottom of the dishwasher to prevent food particle buildup. Rinse under running water.
- Periodically run a dishwasher cleaning cycle with a specialized dishwasher cleaner.

Winterizing (for storage)

- If storing the dishwasher in an unheated area, drain all water from the unit and hoses to prevent freezing damage.

TROUBLESHOOTING

Refer to this section for common issues and their solutions before contacting customer support.

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Dishwasher does not start	Power cord not plugged in; door not closed properly; circuit breaker tripped.	Ensure power cord is secure; close door firmly; check circuit breaker.
Dishes are not clean	Improper loading; clogged spray arms; insufficient detergent; incorrect cycle.	Reload dishes correctly; clean spray arm nozzles; use appropriate detergent amount; select suitable wash cycle.
Water not draining	Clogged drain hose or filter; drain hose kinked.	Clean drain filter; ensure drain hose is clear and not kinked.
Leaks from dishwasher	Loose hose connections; improper door seal.	Check and tighten all hose connections; inspect door gasket for damage and ensure door is fully closed.
Excessive noise	Dishes rattling; foreign object in pump; dishwasher not level.	Rearrange dishes; check for foreign objects; ensure dishwasher is on a level surface.
