IMPORTANT SAFEGUARDS

When using electrical appliances, basic safety precautions should always be followed to reduce the risk of fire, electric shock, and injury to persons.

- Read all instructions before operating the appliance.
- Do not touch hot surfaces. Use handles or knobs.
- To protect against electrical shock, do not immerse cord, plugs, or the main unit in water or other liquid.
- Close supervision is necessary when any appliance is used by or near children.
- Unplug from outlet when not in use and before cleaning. Allow to cool before putting on or taking off parts.
- Do not operate any appliance with a damaged cord or plug, or after the appliance malfunctions or has been damaged in any manner.
- The use of accessory attachments not recommended by the appliance manufacturer may cause injuries.
- Do not use outdoors.
- Do not let cord hang over edge of table or counter, or touch hot surfaces.
- Do not place on or near a hot gas or electric burner, or in a heated oven.
- Extreme caution must be used when moving an appliance containing hot oil or other hot liquids.
- Always attach plug to appliance first, then plug cord into the wall outlet. To disconnect, turn any control to "off", then remove plug from wall outlet.
- Do not use appliance for other than intended use.
- This appliance is ETL Listed, ensuring it meets safety standards.



SETUP AND FIRST USE

Unpacking

1. Carefully remove the air fryer and all packaging materials from the box.
2. Remove any stickers or labels from the appliance. Ensure all protective films, especially from the control panel and basket, are completely removed.
3. Check that all components are present and undamaged.

Initial Cleaning

- Wash the removable nonstick basket and crisper plate thoroughly with hot water, dish soap, and a non-abrasive sponge. These parts are also dishwasher safe.
- Wipe the inside and outside of the appliance with a damp cloth.
- Do not immerse the main unit in water or any other liquid.
- Ensure all parts are completely dry before use.

Placement

- Place the air fryer on a stable, level, and heat-resistant surface.
- Ensure there is at least 6 inches (15 cm) of free space on the back, sides, and above the appliance to allow for proper air circulation.
- Do not place the appliance against a wall or other appliances.

First Use Preheating

For best results and to eliminate any manufacturing odors, it is recommended to preheat the air fryer before its first use without any food inside.

1. Plug the power cord into a grounded wall outlet.
2. Set the temperature to 400°F (200°C) and the timer for 10-15 minutes.
3. Allow the unit to run through the cycle. A slight odor may be present, which is normal for the first use.
4. Once complete, unplug the unit and let it cool down completely before proceeding with cooking.

OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

Control Panel Overview

The Kobi Air Fryer features an intuitive LED touch display for easy operation.

- **Power Button:** Turns the unit on/off and starts/pauses cooking.
- **Temperature Controls (Up/Down Arrows):** Adjusts cooking temperature from 170°F to 400°F.
- **Time Controls (Up/Down Arrows):** Adjusts cooking time.
- **Preset Icons:** One-touch buttons for common dishes (Fries, Chicken, Steak, Shrimp, Cupcakes, Fish, Vegetables, Bacon).

General Cooking Steps

1. **Prepare Food:** Place your ingredients in the air fryer basket. Do not overfill the basket to ensure even cooking.
2. **Insert Basket:** Slide the basket back into the air fryer until it clicks securely into place.
3. **Power On:** Press the Power button to turn on the unit.

4. Set Temperature and Time:

- *Manual Setting:* Use the Temperature and Time control arrows to set your desired cooking parameters.
- *Preset Program:* Select one of the 8 preset icons. The unit will automatically set the optimal temperature and time for that food type. You can still adjust these settings manually after selecting a preset if needed.

5. **Start Cooking:** Press the Power button again to begin the cooking cycle.

6. **Shake Reminder:** For certain foods, the air fryer may beep to remind you to shake the basket for even cooking. Carefully pull out the basket, shake the contents, and reinsert it. Cooking will resume automatically.

7. **Cooking Complete:** The air fryer will beep when the cooking time is complete. Carefully remove the basket and transfer the cooked food.

Cooking Tips

- **Preheating:** Always preheat the air fryer for 3-5 minutes before adding food for best results and crispiness.
- **Oil Usage:** While not always necessary, a light spray of oil can enhance crispiness for some foods.
- **Batch Cooking:** For larger quantities, cook in smaller batches to ensure even air circulation and crisping.
- **Food Size:** Cut food into uniform pieces for consistent cooking.

MAINTENANCE AND CLEANING

Proper cleaning and maintenance will extend the life of your Kobi Air Fryer and ensure optimal performance.

1. **Unplug and Cool:** Always unplug the air fryer from the power outlet and allow it to cool down completely before cleaning.

2. **Clean Basket and Crisper Plate:**

- The removable nonstick coated basket and crisper plate are dishwasher safe.
- Alternatively, wash them with hot water, dish soap, and a non-abrasive sponge. For stubborn food residue, soak the basket in warm, soapy water for about 10 minutes.
- Ensure these parts are PFOA-free and BPA-free.

3. **Clean Interior:** Wipe the interior of the air fryer with a damp cloth or non-abrasive sponge. For baked-on food, a small amount of mild dish soap can be used. Avoid abrasive cleaners or metal scouring pads.

4. **Clean Exterior:** Wipe the exterior of the air fryer with a damp cloth. Do not use harsh chemicals or abrasive materials, as they may damage the finish.

5. **Storage:** Ensure all parts are clean and dry before storing the air fryer in a cool, dry place.

TROUBLESHOOTING

If you encounter issues with your Kobi Air Fryer, consult the following common problems and solutions:

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
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Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Air fryer does not turn on.	Not plugged in; power outlet issue; unit malfunction.	Ensure the power cord is securely plugged into a working grounded outlet. Check your circuit breaker. If still not working, contact customer support.
Food is not crispy.	Basket overfilled; insufficient preheating; food not shaken; too much moisture.	Do not overfill the basket. Preheat the air fryer before adding food. Shake the basket halfway through cooking. Pat dry moist ingredients before air frying. Lightly spray with oil if desired.
White smoke coming from the appliance.	Grease residue from previous use; cooking fatty foods; protective film not removed.	Clean the basket and interior thoroughly after each use. For fatty foods, drain excess fat during cooking. Ensure all protective films and stickers are removed from the unit before first use.
Appliance smells during first use.	Normal manufacturing residue.	This is normal. Run the air fryer empty for 10-15 minutes at 400°F (200°C) before first use to burn off any residual odors. Ensure good ventilation.
Basket does not slide in properly.	Basket not aligned correctly; debris in the drawer.	Ensure the basket is properly aligned with the grooves. Check for any food particles or debris obstructing the drawer.



