Falk Power Builder Excavator Model 120 Instruction Manual

1. INTRODUCTION

Thank you for choosing the Falk Power Builder Excavator Model 120. This ride-on toy is designed to provide hours of imaginative play for young builders. Featuring a fully articulated mechanical shovel, a 360° rotating cabin, and a convenient storage compartment under the seat, this excavator is built for durability and fun. Please read this manual carefully before assembly and use to ensure safe and proper operation.

2. SAFETY WARNINGS

WARNING: Not suitable for children under 36 months. This toy does not provide protection.

- Always supervise children during play.
- Ensure the play area is clear of obstacles and hazards.
- Do not use near stairs, steep inclines, roads, or swimming pools.
- Only one rider at a time.
- Regularly inspect the toy for any damaged or loose parts before each use.

3. WHAT'S IN THE BOX

The Falk Power Builder Excavator package includes the following components:

- Falk Power Builder Excavator main body
- Articulated shovel assembly
- Wheels and axles
- Seat with opening storage compartment
- Customizable license plate with adhesive letters
- Assembly hardware (screws, nuts, etc.)

4. SETUP AND ASSEMBLY

Assembly of the Falk Power Builder Excavator requires adult supervision. Please follow the detailed instructions provided in the separate assembly guide included with your product. General steps include:

1. **Attach the Wheels:** Securely attach all wheels to the main body using the provided axles and fasteners. Ensure they rotate freely.
2. **Assemble the Shovel Arm:** Connect the articulated shovel arm to the excavator body. Verify all pivot points are correctly aligned and secured.
3. **Install the Seat:** Place the seat onto the designated area of the excavator body. Ensure it is firmly attached and the opening mechanism functions correctly.
4. **Personalize the License Plate:** Use the provided adhesive letters to customize the license plate with your child's name or a fun nickname. Attach the personalized plate to the designated area on the excavator.

After assembly, double-check all connections to ensure they are tight and secure before allowing a child to use the toy.

5. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

The Falk Power Builder Excavator is designed for manual operation, encouraging physical activity and imaginative play.

- **Riding:** The child sits on the seat and propels the excavator forward or backward using their feet.
- **Operating the Shovel:** Use the handle and lever on the articulated shovel arm to raise, lower, and scoop. This mimics the action of a real excavator, allowing children to dig and move sand or other light materials.
- **Rotating Cabin:** The cabin can rotate 360 degrees, allowing the child to dig and dump in any direction without repositioning the entire vehicle.
- **Storage Compartment:** The seat opens to reveal a storage compartment, perfect for keeping small toys, snacks, or other treasures during play.

6. MAINTENANCE

- **Inspection:** Periodically check all screws, bolts, and connections to ensure they are tight. Re-tighten if necessary.
- **Moving Parts:** Ensure the shovel arm and rotating cabin move smoothly. If they become stiff, clean any debris from the joints.
- **Storage:** Store the excavator in a dry, sheltered area when not in use to protect it from extreme weather conditions.

7. TROUBLESHOOTING

If you encounter any issues with your Falk Power Builder Excavator, consider the following common solutions:

- **Loose Parts:** If any part feels wobbly or detached, check the assembly instructions and re-tighten all fasteners.
- **Stiff Shovel/Rotation:** Ensure no sand, dirt, or debris is obstructing the moving parts. Clean the joints thoroughly.
- **Difficulty Moving:** Check the wheels for any obstructions or excessive dirt. Ensure the play surface is relatively smooth for optimal movement.
