### INTRODUCTION

## INCLUDED COMPONENTS

- Lock Body
- Keys (3 high-class stainless steel keys)
- Strap + Screw (for mounting bracket installation)
- Lock Frame (mounting bracket)
- Instruction Manual (this document)

## SETUP AND INSTALLATION

The West Biking Folding Bike Lock comes with a convenient mounting bracket for easy transport on your bicycle. Follow these steps to install the bracket and store your lock.

### Mounting the Bracket

1. **Choose Location:** Identify a suitable location on your bike frame, typically the seat post or down tube, where the mounting bracket will not interfere with pedaling or other bike components.
2. **Attach Straps:** Use the provided straps to secure the mounting bracket firmly to the chosen part of your bike frame. Ensure the straps are tightened securely to prevent movement during rides.
3. **Insert Lock:** Once the bracket is securely mounted, slide the folded bike lock into the bracket. The design allows for a snug fit, keeping the lock stable.

## OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

Using your West Biking Folding Bike Lock is straightforward. Its flexible design allows for various locking configurations.

### Locking Your Bicycle

1. **Remove from Bracket:** If stored in the mounting bracket, simply pull the lock out.
2. **Unfold the Lock:** The lock consists of multiple foldable segments. Unfold them to extend the length of the lock.
3. **Secure Your Bike:** Wrap the extended lock around your bicycle frame (and wheel, if desired) and a fixed object such as a bike rack, lamppost, or tree. Ensure the fixed object is sturdy and cannot be easily moved or cut.
4. **Insert and Turn Key:** Align the end of the lock with the main lock body and insert one of the provided keys. Turn the key to engage the locking mechanism. Remove the key and store it safely.

### Unlocking Your Bicycle

1. **Insert Key:** Insert the key into the lock cylinder.
2. **Turn Key:** Turn the key to disengage the locking mechanism.
3. **Remove Lock:** Once unlocked, separate the ends of the lock and remove it from your bicycle and the fixed object.
4. **Fold and Store:** Fold the lock back into its compact form and place it back into its mounting bracket for convenient transport.

Proper maintenance will extend the life and ensure the smooth operation of your West Biking Folding Bike Lock.

- **Keep Clean:** Periodically wipe down the lock body and segments with a damp cloth to remove dirt and grime. Avoid harsh chemicals that could damage the ABS material or rubber lacquer coating.
- **Lubricate Lock Cylinder:** If the key becomes difficult to turn, apply a small amount of graphite lubricant or a specialized lock lubricant into the keyhole. Avoid using oil-based lubricants as they can attract dirt.
- **Check Rivets:** Occasionally inspect the rivets connecting the lock segments to ensure they are secure and show no signs of excessive wear.
- **Key Care:** Keep your keys clean and dry. Avoid bending or forcing them into the lock. Remember that serial numbers are available for key remake if lost.

## TROUBLESHOOTING

If you encounter issues with your West Biking Folding Bike Lock, try the following solutions:

- **Key is Stiff or Hard to Turn:**
  - Ensure the key is fully inserted.
  - Apply graphite lubricant to the keyhole and gently work the key in and out.
  - Check for any debris inside the keyhole and carefully remove it if present.
- **Lock Segments are Stiff:**
  - Clean the joints between the segments to remove accumulated dirt.
  - Apply a small amount of silicone spray or a dry lubricant to the pivot points of the segments.
- **Mounting Bracket Feels Loose:**
  - Re-tighten the straps securing the bracket to your bike frame.
  - Ensure the bracket is positioned correctly and not obstructed.
