1. INTRODUCTION AND OVERVIEW

This instruction manual provides detailed guidance for the assembly, operation, maintenance, and storage of your TIMBER RIDGE 400L Large Capacity Folding Double Decker Wagon. Designed for versatility and durability, this wagon features a unique two-tier storage system and all-terrain wheels, making it suitable for various outdoor activities.

Key features include:

- **Extra Long Design:** Features an extended lower shelf measuring 54 inches, ideal for transporting oversized items such as chairs, tents, and canopies.
- **High Capacity Load:** Constructed with sturdy steel pipes supporting up to 225 lbs per layer, totaling 450 lbs. Open dimensions are 54"L x 18.5"W x 34.5"H (with extended shelf).
- **All-Terrain Performance:** Equipped with 7.5" diameter all-terrain wheels with brakes. The middle tread is made of rubber for quiet and wear-resistant operation. 360° rotating front wheels ensure easy maneuverability.
- **Compact & Easy Handling:** No assembly required. Sets up easily by pushing the bottom. Collapsible design folds compactly to 15"L x 7"W x 35.5"H.
- **Adjustable ABS Handle:** The handle is adjustable up to 2'8" and stays within easy reach when not in use, preventing it from falling to the floor.

2. SETUP INSTRUCTIONS

Follow these steps to unfold and prepare your wagon for use:

1. **Unfolding the Wagon:** Place the folded wagon on a flat surface. Gently push down on the center of the wagon's base until the frame fully expands.
2. **Securing the Base:** Once fully expanded, place the provided padded bottom insert firmly into the main compartment to create a stable base.
3. **Extending the Lower Shelf:** Locate the extended lower shelf at one end of the wagon. Unfold it downwards and secure any latches or Velcro straps to ensure it is fully extended and stable.
4. **Adjusting the Handle:** Press the button on the handle to adjust its height to your preferred pulling position. The handle is designed to stay upright when released.
5. **Checking the Wheels:** Ensure all four all-terrain wheels are securely attached and can rotate freely. The front wheels offer 360° rotation for easy steering.

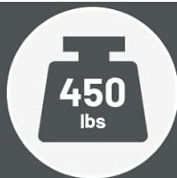
3. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

Your double decker wagon is designed for efficient and versatile transport. Here's how to operate it effectively:

- 1. Utilizing the Double-Decker Feature:** The main compartment (upper deck) is suitable for general items, while the extended lower shelf is specifically designed for longer items such as beach chairs, fishing rods, or small tents. Ensure items on the lower shelf are balanced and do not exceed the 225 lbs per layer weight limit.
- 2. Maneuvering the Wagon:** Use the adjustable handle to pull the wagon. The 360° rotating front

wheels allow for smooth turns and easy navigation around obstacles.

3. **Using the Brakes:** The all-terrain wheels are equipped with brakes. To engage the brakes, press down firmly on the red levers located near the front wheels. To release, lift the levers. Always engage the brakes when loading or unloading the wagon, or when parked on an incline.
4. **Side Pockets and Cup Holders:** Utilize the integrated side pockets and mesh cup holders for smaller items, beverages, or personal belongings for quick access.





WEIGHT CAPACITY **450 lbs**

4. FOLDING AND STORAGE

To collapse your wagon for compact storage and transport, follow these steps:

1. **Remove Contents:** Ensure all items are removed from both the upper and lower compartments.
2. **Collapse the Lower Shelf:** Fold up the extended lower shelf and secure it in its closed position.
3. **Remove Bottom Insert:** Take out the padded bottom insert from the main compartment.
4. **Folding the Wagon:** Locate the pull strap in the center of the main compartment. Pull this strap upwards firmly. The wagon frame will begin to collapse inwards. Continue pulling until the wagon is fully folded into a compact unit.
5. **Secure the Folded Wagon:** Use the integrated strap with Velcro closure to secure the folded wagon, preventing it from unfolding during transport.
6. **Store Bottom Insert:** The removed bottom insert can be stored in the dedicated side pocket of the folded wagon for convenience.
7. **Apply Cover:** If a protective cover is provided, slide it over the folded wagon to protect it from dust

and damage.

5. MAINTENANCE

Proper maintenance will extend the life of your TIMBER RIDGE wagon:

- **Cleaning:** The fabric components of the wagon can be cleaned by wiping with a damp cloth. For stubborn dirt, a mild soap solution can be used. Allow to air dry completely before folding and storing.
- **Wheel Care:** Periodically check the wheels for any debris or obstructions. Ensure the wheel bearings are free of sand or dirt to maintain smooth operation.
- **Frame Inspection:** Regularly inspect the steel frame for any signs of damage, bending, or loose

fasteners. Tighten any loose screws as needed.

- **Storage:** Store the wagon in a dry, cool place away from direct sunlight when not in use to prevent material degradation.

6. TROUBLESHOOTING

If you encounter any issues with your wagon, refer to the following common troubleshooting tips:

- **Wagon not unfolding/folding smoothly:** Ensure there are no obstructions in the folding mechanism. Check that the bottom insert is removed before folding. Apply gentle, even pressure when unfolding.
- **Wheels not rotating freely:** Inspect wheels for trapped debris (sand, small stones, grass). Clean the wheel axles if necessary.
- **Brakes not engaging/disengaging:** Check for any obstructions around the brake levers. Ensure the levers are fully pressed down or lifted.
- **Wagon feels unstable:** Verify that the frame is fully extended and locked into place. Ensure the bottom insert is correctly positioned and the lower shelf is securely attached. Do not exceed the stated weight capacity.
