SETUP

OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

The Stack-a-Cat toy is designed for intuitive play, encouraging exploration and learning.

Stacking the Rings:

- 1. Place the wobble base on a flat, stable surface.
- 2. Identify the largest ring (red) and place it onto the central post of the wobble base.
- 3. Next, take the medium-sized ring (green) and stack it on top of the red ring.
- 4. Finally, place the smallest ring (blue) on top of the green ring.
- 5. Complete the stack by placing the cat head topper on the very top.

Interactive Play:

- Encourage your child to grasp and manipulate the rings, developing fine motor skills.
- Gently push the assembled toy to make it wobble and produce fun sounds from its rounded base.
- Discuss the colors and patterns on each ring to enhance visual recognition.

MAINTENANCE
