## 1. INTRODUCTION

Thank you for choosing the Nania Befix Car Seat. This manual provides essential information for the correct installation, use, and maintenance of your car seat. Please read it thoroughly before use and keep it in a safe place for future reference. This car seat is designed for children weighing 15-36 kg (approximately 4 to 12 years old), corresponding to Group 2/3. It is manufactured and tested in France and approved according to ECE R44/04 safety standards, having received 4 stars in ADAC tests.

## 2. SAFETY INFORMATION

- **Weight Group:** This car seat is suitable for children weighing 15 to 36 kg (Group 2/3).
- **Installation:** The seat must be installed forward-facing only, in the rear of the vehicle.
- **Vehicle Seat Belt:** The child must be secured using the vehicle's 3-point safety belt. Ensure the belt is correctly routed and tensioned.
- **Side Impact Protection:** The Befix car seat is equipped with lateral protection to safeguard the child in case of a side collision.
- **Headrest Adjustment:** Always adjust the headrest to ensure it properly supports the child's head and aligns with their shoulders.
- **Damage:** Do not use the car seat if it has been involved in an accident or shows any signs of damage.
- **Supervision:** Never leave a child unattended in the car seat.

## 3. PRODUCT OVERVIEW

The Nania Befix Car Seat is a lightweight and portable booster seat designed for comfort and safety. Key

features include an adjustable headrest, removable head cushion, and a washable cover.

## 4. SETUP AND INSTALLATION

The Nania Befix Car Seat is a booster seat with a backrest, designed for easy installation using the vehicle's 3-point seat belt.

1. **Positioning:** Place the car seat on a suitable rear vehicle seat, ensuring it is facing forward.
2. **Child Placement:** Seat the child in the car seat.
3. **Securing the Child:** Pull the vehicle's 3-point safety belt across the child and the car seat.
4. **Belt Routing:** Ensure the lap portion of the belt passes under the armrests of the car seat and across

the child's hips. The diagonal shoulder belt must pass through the red belt guide near the child's shoulder and across their chest, away from the neck.

5. **Buckling:** Insert the seat belt buckle into the vehicle's buckle receiver until it clicks securely.
6. **Tensioning:** Pull the shoulder belt to remove any slack, ensuring the belt is snug against the child and the car seat. The car seat should be firmly held in place by the tensioned belt.
7. **Headrest Adjustment:** Adjust the headrest height so that it is level with or slightly above the child's shoulders, providing optimal head and neck support.

## 5. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

Once installed, operating the Nania Befix Car Seat involves correctly securing your child for each journey.

1. **Seating the Child:** Ensure the child is seated comfortably and correctly in the car seat, with their back against the backrest.
2. **Securing the Belt:** Always use the vehicle's 3-point safety belt to secure the child. Follow the belt routing instructions from Section 4.
3. **Checking Fit:** Before every journey, check that the seat belt is not twisted, is properly routed through all guides, and is tightly secured across the child's body. There should be no slack in the belt.
4. **Headrest:** Verify that the headrest is at the correct height for the child's current stature.

## 6. MAINTENANCE

Regular maintenance ensures the longevity and hygiene of your Nania Befix Car Seat.

- **Cleaning the Cover:** The car seat cover is removable and hand-washable. Refer to the care label on the cover for specific washing instructions. Do not machine wash or tumble dry unless explicitly stated.
- **Cleaning the Shell:** The plastic parts of the car seat can be cleaned with a damp cloth and mild soap. Do not use harsh chemicals or abrasive cleaners.
- **Inspection:** Periodically inspect the car seat for any signs of wear, damage, or loose parts. Pay close attention to the seat belt guides and the integrity of the plastic shell.
- **Storage:** When not in use, store the car seat in a cool, dry place away from direct sunlight.

---

## 7. TROUBLESHOOTING

If you encounter issues with your Nania Befix Car Seat, consider the following:

- **Car Seat Feels Loose:** Ensure the vehicle's 3-point seat belt is pulled taut and has no slack. Re-route the belt if necessary, following the instructions in Section 4.
- **Belt is Twisted:** Unbuckle the belt, straighten it, and re-route it carefully through all designated guides.
- **Headrest Not Adjusting:** Check for any obstructions or debris in the adjustment mechanism. Ensure you are pressing the adjustment lever or button firmly while moving the headrest.

- **Child Uncomfortable:** Verify the headrest is at the correct height and the seat belt is not digging into the child's neck or shoulders. Adjust as needed.

If problems persist, contact the retailer or manufacturer for assistance.
