INTRODUCTION

This manual provides essential information for the safe and efficient operation of your Frigidaire EFRW1225 Wine & Beverage Cooler. This compact unit is designed for chilling and storing up to 12 bottles of wine or 26 cans, featuring a stylish curved glass door, digital temperature control, and quiet operation. Please read these instructions thoroughly before use and retain them for future reference.

SAFETY INFORMATION

- Read all instructions before using the appliance.

- Do not touch cold surfaces immediately after plugging in the unit.
- Ensure proper grounding for electrical safety.
- Do not use mechanical devices or other means to accelerate the defrosting process, other than those recommended by the manufacturer.
- Keep ventilation openings clear of obstruction.
- Do not damage the refrigerant circuit.
- Do not use electrical appliances inside the storage compartments unless they are of the type recommended by the manufacturer.
- Unplug the cooler before cleaning or performing any maintenance.

SETUP

Unpacking

1. Remove all packaging materials, including the foam base and adhesive tape.
2. Inspect the cooler for any damage during transit. Report any damage to your retailer immediately.
3. Clean the interior and exterior surfaces with a soft cloth and mild detergent before first use.

Placement

- Place the cooler on a firm, level surface away from direct sunlight and heat sources (e.g., stoves, heaters).
- Allow at least 5 inches (12.7 cm) of space around the back and sides of the unit for proper ventilation.
- Ensure the ambient temperature is between 60°F (16°C) and 90°F (32°C) for optimal performance.

Power Connection

- Connect the cooler to a dedicated 110V AC power outlet.

- For portable use, the unit is DC rated and includes a car cord for connection to a 12V DC power source (e.g., car adapter).
- Allow the unit to stand upright for at least 2 hours before plugging it in to allow refrigerants to settle.

OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

Control Panel

The control panel is located on the top front of the unit. It features a digital display for temperature, and buttons for temperature adjustment and interior light control.

- **Temperature Adjustment:** Use the 'Up' (▲) and 'Down' (▼) arrows to set your desired temperature. The temperature range is 46°F to 64°F (8°C to 18°C).
- **Light Control:** Press the 'Light' button to turn the interior blue LED light on or off. The light automatically activates when the door is opened.

Loading Beverages

The cooler features removable shelves designed for flexible storage.

- The innovative design allows for vertical storage of up to 26 cans or horizontal storage of up to 12 standard wine bottles.
- Ensure bottles and cans are placed securely to prevent movement and potential damage.
- Avoid overloading the unit, as this can impede air circulation and cooling efficiency.

MAINTENANCE

Cleaning

- Always unplug the cooler before cleaning.
- Clean the interior with a soft cloth, warm water, and a mild, non-abrasive detergent.
- The shelves are removable for easy cleaning.
- Wipe the exterior with a soft, damp cloth. Avoid harsh chemicals or abrasive cleaners.
- Ensure the door gasket is clean and free of debris to maintain a proper seal.

Defrosting

This unit features an automatic defrost system, minimizing the need for manual defrosting. If excessive frost builds up, unplug the unit and allow it to defrost naturally, then wipe away any melted water.

Long-Term Storage

If the cooler will not be used for an extended period:

1. Unplug the power cord.
2. Empty all contents and clean the interior thoroughly.
3. Leave the door slightly ajar to prevent odors and mold growth.

TROUBLESHOOTING

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Cooler does not operate	No power; power cord unplugged; circuit breaker tripped.	Check power supply, plug, and circuit breaker.
Temperature is not cold enough	Door not closed properly; excessive door openings; warm ambient temperature; unit overloaded; poor ventilation.	Ensure door is sealed; reduce door openings; move unit to cooler area; do not overload; ensure proper clearance.
Unit is noisy	Unit not level; loose parts; normal compressor operation.	Adjust leveling feet; check for loose items; compressor noise is normal.
Vibration	Unit not level; contact with wall/cabinet.	Adjust leveling feet; ensure adequate clearance.
