1. INTRODUCTION

This user manual provides comprehensive instructions for the ZEFAL Arctica 750ml Insulated Bicycle Bottle. Please read this manual carefully before using the product to ensure proper function, longevity, and safety. This bottle is designed to keep your liquids at an optimal temperature during cycling activities.

2. PRODUCT OVERVIEW

The ZEFAL Arctica 750ml Insulated Bicycle Bottle is a high-quality, insulated sports bottle designed for cyclists. It features an odorless and leak-proof design, made from BPA-free plastic, ensuring safe and clean hydration on the go.

3. SETUP

Before first use, it is recommended to clean the bottle thoroughly. Follow these steps:

1. Unscrew the cap from the bottle body.
2. Wash both the bottle and the cap with warm water and a mild dish soap.
3. Rinse thoroughly to remove all soap residue.
4. Allow all parts to air dry completely before reassembling or storing.

The bottle is designed to fit standard bicycle bottle cages. Simply slide the bottle into your bike's bottle cage until it is securely seated.

4. OPERATION

4.1 Filling the Bottle

1. Unscrew the cap.
2. Fill the bottle with your desired liquid. For optimal insulation, pre-chill or pre-warm the bottle with water before adding your beverage.
3. Do not overfill. Leave a small air gap at the top.
4. Securely screw the cap back onto the bottle, ensuring it is tightened to prevent leaks.

4.2 Drinking from the Bottle

The bottle features a pull-out nozzle for easy drinking. To drink, pull the nozzle upwards with your teeth or fingers. Squeeze the bottle body to dispense liquid. Push the nozzle back down to seal the bottle and prevent leaks when not in use.

4.3 Insulation Performance

The Arctica bottle's insulated design helps maintain the temperature of your beverage. For cold drinks, consider adding ice cubes. For hot drinks, ensure the liquid is not boiling hot to avoid pressure buildup or damage to the bottle. The insulation performance may vary based on ambient temperature and initial liquid temperature.

5. MAINTENANCE

Proper cleaning and maintenance will extend the life of your ZEFAL Arctica bottle and ensure hygienic use.

5.1 Cleaning Instructions

- **Hand Wash Only:** The bottle and cap should be washed by hand. Do not place in a dishwasher, as high temperatures can damage the insulation and plastic.
- Use warm water and a mild detergent. A bottle brush can be used to clean the interior thoroughly.
- Pay special attention to cleaning the nozzle and cap assembly to prevent residue buildup.
- Rinse all components thoroughly with clean water.
- Allow the bottle and cap to dry completely, preferably disassembled, to prevent mold or odor development.

5.2 Storage

Store the bottle with the cap unscrewed or loosely placed to allow air circulation and prevent odors.

6. TROUBLESHOOTING

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Bottle is leaking	Cap not tightened properly; Nozzle not fully closed; Damaged seal or nozzle.	Ensure the cap is screwed on tightly. Push the nozzle down firmly until it clicks into place. Inspect the cap and nozzle for any visible damage or wear; replace if necessary.
Unpleasant odor or taste	Improper cleaning; Residue buildup; Stored with moisture inside.	Clean the bottle thoroughly as per maintenance instructions, paying attention to all parts. Ensure the bottle is completely dry before storage. For persistent odors, a mixture of baking soda and water can be used for soaking.
Liquid not staying cold/hot	Extreme ambient temperatures; Bottle not pre-chilled/warmed; Cap not sealed properly.	Pre-chill or pre-warm the bottle before filling. Ensure the cap is tightly sealed. Note that insulation performance is not absolute and will degrade over time, especially in extreme conditions.
