INTRODUCTION

This manual provides detailed instructions for the assembly, operation, and maintenance of your ModernLuxe Twin-Over-Full Bunk Bed with 2 Drawers. Please read all instructions carefully before assembly and use to ensure safe and correct installation and functionality.

SAFETY INFORMATION

General Safety Guidelines

- Always follow the manufacturer's recommended weight limits. The upper bed has a weight capacity of 175 lbs, and the bottom bed has a weight capacity of 275 lbs.
- Ensure all connections are securely tightened before use and periodically check for tightness. Loose connections can lead to instability.
- The upper bunk is equipped with high guard rails for safety. Do not remove or modify these rails.
- Use only mattresses that comply with the recommended dimensions to prevent gaps that could pose a hazard.
- Do not allow children under 6 years of age to use the upper bunk.
- Always use the provided ladder for access to the upper bunk. Do not jump on or off the bunk bed.
- Prohibit horseplay on or under the bed.
- Periodically inspect the bed for any signs of damage or wear. Replace damaged parts immediately.

PACKAGE CONTENTS

Please verify that all components are present and undamaged before beginning assembly. If any parts are missing or damaged, contact customer support immediately.

SETUP AND ASSEMBLY

Tools Required

- Phillips Head Screwdriver (not included)
- Allen Wrench (included)

It is recommended that two adults assemble this bunk bed for safety and ease of installation.

Assembly Steps

1. **Step 1: Unpack and Identify Parts.** Carefully remove all components from the packaging. Lay them out on a soft, clean surface (e.g., a carpet or blanket) to prevent scratches. Refer to the provided parts list and diagrams to identify each component.
2. **Step 2: Assemble Lower Bed Frame.** Attach the side rails to the headboard and footboard of the lower bed using the provided hardware. Ensure all connections are finger-tight only at this stage.
3. **Step 3: Install Lower Bed Slats.** Place the wooden slats across the lower bed frame. Secure them with screws as indicated in the assembly diagram.
4. **Step 4: Assemble Upper Bed Frame.** Repeat Step 2 for the upper bed frame components.
5. **Step 5: Install Upper Bed Slats.** Repeat Step 3 for the upper bed frame.
6. **Step 6: Attach Upper Bed to Lower Bed.** Carefully lift the assembled upper bed frame and align it with the posts of the lower bed. Secure it using the designated bolts and nuts. This step requires two people.
7. **Step 7: Attach Ladder.** Secure the ladder to the upper bed frame as shown in the diagram, ensuring it is firmly attached.
8. **Step 8: Install Guard Rails.** Attach the guard rails to the upper bunk, ensuring they are securely fastened to prevent falls.
9. **Step 9: Assemble Storage Drawers.** Follow the separate instructions provided for assembling the two storage drawers. Once assembled, insert the drawers under the lower bed.
10. **Step 10: Final Tightening.** Once all components are in place, systematically tighten all bolts and screws using the Allen wrench and screwdriver. Do not overtighten, but ensure all connections are firm and secure.

OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

Using the Bunk Bed

- **Mattress Placement:** Place a standard twin-size mattress on the upper bunk and a standard full-size mattress on the lower bunk. Ensure mattresses fit snugly within the frame and do not exceed the maximum recommended thickness for the upper bunk (if specified in separate documentation).
- **Ladder Use:** Always use the ladder to access the upper bunk. Ensure the ladder is securely attached before climbing and descending.
- **Storage Drawers:** The two integrated drawers provide convenient storage for bedding, toys, or other items. Pull them out gently to access contents and push them in fully when not in use to prevent tripping hazards.

MAINTENANCE

Cleaning

- Wipe down the bed frame with a soft, damp cloth. Avoid using harsh chemicals, abrasive cleaners, or polishes, which can damage the finish.
- For spills, blot immediately with a clean, dry cloth to prevent staining.

Regular Checks

- Periodically (every 3-6 months) check all bolts, screws, and connections to ensure they remain tight. Retighten as necessary to maintain structural integrity and safety.
- Inspect the bed frame, ladder, and guard rails for any signs of wear, cracks, or damage. Address any issues promptly to maintain safety and prevent further deterioration.

TROUBLESHOOTING

Common Issues and Solutions

- **Squeaking Noises:** Tighten all bolts and screws. Ensure the bed is on a level surface. If squeaking persists, disassemble and reassemble, ensuring all parts are correctly aligned and tightened.
- **Loose Connections:** Regularly check and tighten all hardware. If a bolt or screw is stripped, contact customer support for a replacement part. Do not attempt to use damaged hardware.
- **Drawers Not Sliding Smoothly:** Check for obstructions in the drawer glides. Ensure the drawers are assembled correctly and the glides are properly aligned and free of debris.
- **Bed Feels Unstable:** Verify that all assembly steps have been completed correctly and all hardware is fully tightened. Ensure the bed is placed on a flat, stable floor. Uneven flooring can cause instability.
