INTRODUCTION

This manual provides essential information for setting up, operating, maintaining, and troubleshooting your Amazon Fire HD 10 tablet (2021 Release). Please read this guide thoroughly to ensure optimal use of your device.

SETUP

1. Unboxing and Initial Charge

Upon unboxing, ensure all components are present: the Fire HD 10 tablet, a USB-C (2.0) cable, and a 9W power adapter. Before first use, fully charge your tablet using the provided adapter and cable. A full charge from 0% to 100% typically takes approximately 4 hours while the device is in standby.

2. Powering On/Off

- **To Power On:** Press and hold the power button located on the side of the tablet until the Amazon logo appears.
- To Power Off: Press and hold the power button, then select 'Power Off' from the on-screen options.
- To Restart: Press and hold the power button, then select 'Restart' from the on-screen options.

3. Initial Setup

Follow the on-screen prompts to complete the initial setup:

- 1. Language Selection: Choose your preferred language.
- 2. **Wi-Fi Connection:** Select your Wi-Fi network and enter the password. The tablet supports 2.4 GHz and 5.0 GHz networks.
- 3. **Amazon Account Registration:** Sign in with your existing Amazon account or create a new one. This links your tablet to your Amazon content and services.
- 4. **Time Zone and Date:** Confirm your local time zone and date settings.
- 5. **Software Updates:** The tablet may check for and install available software updates. Allow this process to complete.

OPERATING

1. Navigation and Gestures

- Tap: Select an item or open an app.
- Swipe: Move between screens, scroll through content, or dismiss notifications.
- Pinch-to-Zoom: Enlarge or reduce content on the screen.
- Long Press: Access contextual menus or move app icons.

2. App Management

Applications can be downloaded from the Amazon Appstore. Google Play is not supported. To install apps:

- 1. Open the **Appstore** application.
- 2. Browse or search for desired applications.
- 3. Select an app and tap Get or the price to download and install.



3. Split Screen Feature

The Fire HD 10 supports split-screen multitasking, allowing two compatible applications to run side-by-side. To use this feature:

- 1. Open the first application.
- 2. Swipe up from the bottom of the screen to reveal the navigation bar, then tap the square 'Recent Apps' icon.
- 3. Long-press on the first app's preview and drag it to one side of the screen.
- 4. Select a second compatible app from the recent apps list to fill the other half of the screen.



4. Connectivity

- Wi-Fi: Access Wi-Fi settings from the Quick Settings menu (swipe down from the top of the screen) or through Settings > Wi-Fi & Bluetooth.
- **Bluetooth:** Enable Bluetooth in **Settings > Wi-Fi & Bluetooth** to pair with compatible devices like headphones, speakers, or keyboards.

5. Camera Usage

The Fire HD 10 features a 2 MP front-facing camera and a 5 MP rear-facing camera, both capable of 720p HD video recording. Open the Camera app to capture photos and videos.

6. Audio

The tablet includes dual integrated speakers and a 3.5 mm stereo jack for headphones. External volume controls are located on the side of the device.

MAINTENANCE

1. Charging

Always use the provided USB-C cable and 9W power adapter for charging. Avoid using unapproved chargers, which may damage the device or lead to safety risks.

2. Storage Management

The Fire HD 10 comes with 32 GB or 64 GB of internal storage. You can expand storage up to 1 TB using a microSD card (sold separately). To manage storage:

- Go to Settings > Storage to view usage and free up space.
- Insert a microSD card into the designated slot to add external storage. Note that some apps may require installation on internal storage.

3. Cleaning the Device

Use a soft, lint-free cloth to clean the screen and body of the tablet. Avoid abrasive materials or harsh chemicals. If necessary, slightly dampen the cloth with water. Do not spray cleaners directly onto the device.

4. Battery Care

To prolong battery life:

- Avoid extreme temperatures.
- Reduce screen brightness when possible.
- · Close unused applications running in the background.
- · Disable Wi-Fi and Bluetooth when not in use.

TROUBLESHOOTING

Common Issues and Solutions

- **Device Not Turning On:** Ensure the tablet is charged. Connect it to the power adapter for at least 30 minutes, then try powering on again.
- Wi-Fi Connectivity Issues: Check if Wi-Fi is enabled in settings. Restart your Wi-Fi router and the tablet. Ensure you are within range of the network.
- Apps Crashing or Not Responding: Close and reopen the app. If the issue persists, clear the app's cache
 (Settings > Apps & Games > Manage All Applications > [App Name] > Clear Cache or uninstall and
 reinstall the app.
- Slow Performance: Close unused apps. Check available storage and free up space if necessary. Restarting the tablet can also improve performance.
- Screen Not Responding: Perform a forced restart by holding the power button for 20-30 seconds until the
 device reboots.

Factory Reset

If persistent issues occur, a factory reset can resolve many software-related problems. **Warning:** A factory reset will erase all data on your tablet. Back up important data before proceeding. To perform a factory reset, go to **Settings** >
