User Manual: Finding The Sacred Heart - Live In Philly 1986 Vinyl LP

Official Guide for Your Vinyl Album

INTRODUCTION

This manual provides essential information for the care and enjoyment of your "Finding The Sacred Heart - Live In Philly 1986" vinyl LP. This 180gm double vinyl pressing captures the legendary performance of Dio at The Spectrum in Philadelphia during the "Sacred Heart" tour in June 1986. Featuring Ronnie James Dio's powerful vocals and blistering performances of tracks from Dio's early albums, alongside Black Sabbath and Rainbow classics, this album is a monumental live recording for fans of heavy '80s rock.

SETUP AND PREPARATION

1. **Unpacking:** Carefully remove the vinyl records from their sleeves. Handle the records by the edges or the label to avoid touching the grooves.
2. **Cleaning:** Before first playback, and periodically thereafter, gently clean the record surface using a dedicated record brush or cleaning solution. This removes dust and static, ensuring optimal sound quality and preserving the vinyl.
3. **Turntable Placement:** Ensure your turntable is placed on a stable, level surface, away from direct sunlight, heat sources, and excessive vibrations.
4. **Turntable Setup:** Verify that your turntable's tonearm is properly balanced and the tracking force is set according to your cartridge manufacturer's recommendations. An improperly set tonearm can damage your records and stylus.

OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

- **Placing the Record:** Carefully place the vinyl record onto the turntable platter, ensuring it is centered on the spindle.
- **Starting Playback:** Gently lower the tonearm's stylus into the lead-in groove of the record. Avoid dropping the stylus onto the record, as this can cause damage.
- **Volume Adjustment:** Adjust the amplifier volume to a comfortable listening level.
- **Ending Playback:** Once a side is finished, gently lift the tonearm from the record and return it to its rest. Do not let the stylus drag across the record surface.

MAINTENANCE AND STORAGE

Proper maintenance and storage are crucial for preserving the quality and longevity of your vinyl records.

- **Regular Cleaning:** Use an anti-static record brush before each play to remove surface dust. For deeper cleaning, use a specialized record cleaning solution and microfiber cloth.
- **Stylus Care:** Periodically inspect and clean your turntable's stylus according to its manufacturer's instructions. A dirty or worn stylus can damage records and degrade sound.
- **Storage:** Store records vertically in their original sleeves, preferably within protective outer sleeves. Avoid stacking records horizontally, as this can lead to warping.
- **Environmental Conditions:** Store records in a cool, dry place, away from direct sunlight, extreme temperatures, and high humidity. These conditions can cause warping and damage.

TROUBLESHOOTING

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Record skips or repeats.	Dust/debris in grooves, scratched record, incorrect tracking force, uneven turntable surface.	Clean the record thoroughly. Inspect for scratches. Adjust tonearm tracking force. Ensure turntable is level.
Poor sound quality (muffled, distorted).	Dirty stylus, worn stylus, incorrect cartridge alignment, dirty record.	Clean the stylus. Consider replacing worn stylus. Check cartridge alignment. Clean the record.
Excessive static noise.	Dry environment, static buildup on record.	Use an anti-static brush or record mat. Consider a humidifier in dry conditions.





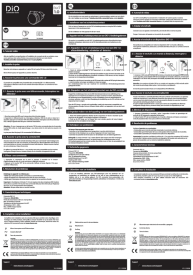
