# Sudio Flyg Bluetooth Transmitter Instruction Manual

## INTRODUCTION

---

The Sudio Flyg is a versatile wireless Bluetooth adapter designed to enhance your audio experience by enabling wireless connectivity with analog audio devices. This device allows you to use your preferred wireless headphones or earbuds with systems that typically require a wired connection, such as in-flight entertainment systems, portable gaming devices, and televisions.

Enjoy the freedom of wireless audio with features like a long battery life, lag-free high-fidelity sound, and broad compatibility across various platforms.

## PRODUCT OVERVIEW

### Key Features

- **Wireless Connectivity:** Converts analog audio signals to wireless Bluetooth for use with wireless headphones or earbuds.
- **Extended Battery Life:** Up to 12 hours of playtime, with the ability to operate while charging.

## SETUP INSTRUCTIONS

---

### 1. Powering On and Initial Pairing

1. **Power On:** Press and hold the multifunction button on the Sudio Flyg for 3 seconds. The LED indicator will blink white, indicating that pairing mode has automatically started.
2. **Pair Your Audio Device:** Ensure your wireless headphones or earbuds are in pairing mode and placed near the Sudio Flyg. The Flyg will automatically search for and connect to your device.
3. **Successful Connection:** Once the first device is successfully paired, the LED will blink red.

## 2. Pairing a Second Audio Device

1. While the LED is blinking red (after the first device is paired), place your second audio device in pairing mode near the Sudio Flyg.
2. The Flyg will attempt to pair with the second device.
3. If no second device is successfully paired, the LED will stop blinking red after a period.

## 3. Re-entering Pairing Mode

- If you need to enter pairing mode again (e.g., to pair a new device or if a second device failed to connect), double-click the multifunction button. The LED will resume blinking white.

## OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

---

### Connecting to an Audio Source

1. Extend the appropriate 3.5mm audio jack(s) from the Sudio Flyg.
2. Insert the jack(s) into the AUX port or dual 3.5mm flight audio socket of your desired audio source (e.g., airplane entertainment system, gaming console, TV).
3. Ensure your paired wireless headphones or earbuds are powered on and within range. The Sudio Flyg will automatically connect to them.

## Charging the Sudio Flyg

- Connect the included USB-C charging cable to the Sudio Flyg and a power source.
- The device can be used while it is charging, ensuring uninterrupted audio during long periods of use, such as extended flights.

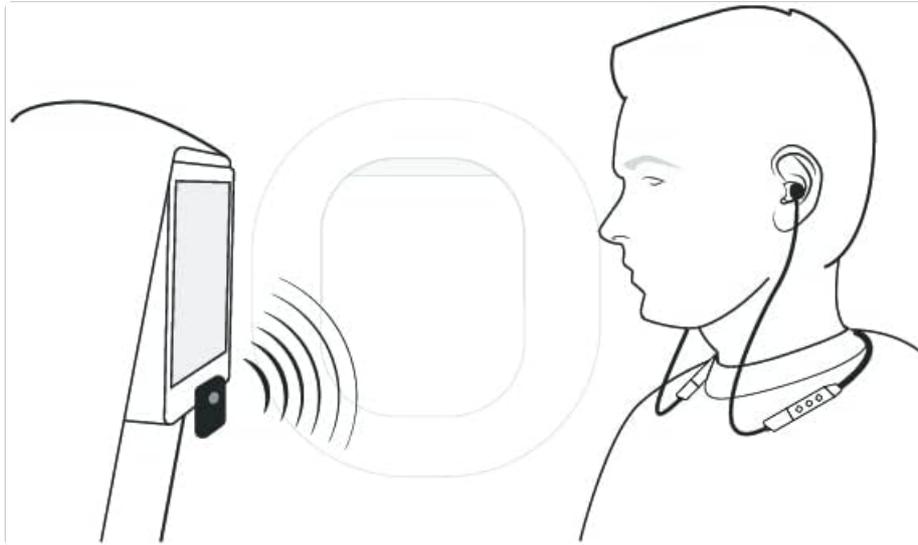


Image: A diagram illustrating the Sudio Flyg connected to an in-flight entertainment system, transmitting audio wirelessly to a user's earbuds.

## MAINTENANCE

- Keep the device dry and clean. Use a soft, dry cloth for cleaning.
- Avoid exposing the device to extreme temperatures or direct sunlight.
- Store the device in a safe place when not in use to prevent physical damage.

## TROUBLESHOOTING

| Problem                                   | Possible Cause  | Solution  |
|---|---|---|
| Device does not power on.                 | Low battery.  | Charge the Sudio Flyg using the USB-C cable.  |
| Cannot pair with headphones/earbuds.      | Headphones not in pairing mode or too far away.               | Ensure your audio device is in pairing mode and within close proximity to the Sudio Flyg. Double-click the Flyg's multifunction button to re-enter pairing mode if necessary. |
| Audio cuts out or connection is unstable. | Interference from other wireless devices; distance from Flyg. | Move closer to the Sudio Flyg. Minimize other active Bluetooth devices nearby. Re-pair the devices if the issue persists.   |
| Low audio volume.                         | Volume settings on source device or headphones.               | Adjust the volume on your connected headphones/earbuds and the audio source device.   |
| Device unpairs automatically.             | Temporary connection issue.                                   | Re-pair the device by double-clicking the multifunction button on the Sudio Flyg and putting your audio device into pairing mode.   |
