- Disable any antivirus software temporarily to prevent interference during installation.
- It is recommended to turn off autoplay for your DVD drive in Windows settings to avoid potential CRC errors during installation.
- 2. Insert Disc 1: Insert the first DVD-ROM into your computer's DVD drive.

3. Start Installation:

- If the installer does not launch automatically, navigate to your DVD drive in File Explorer and double-click the setup.exe file.
- Follow the on-screen prompts to begin the installation process.
- 4. **Disc Swapping:** The installer will prompt you to insert subsequent DVD-ROMs as needed. Ensure discs are clean and free of scratches to prevent read errors.
- Product Key Activation: During or after the DVD installation, you will be prompted to enter your unique product key. This key is typically found inside the game packaging. An active Microsoft account is required for activation and ongoing use.
- 6. **Initial Download:** After the DVD installation is complete and the product key is entered, the game will connect to the internet to download additional content and the latest updates. This download can be substantial (e.g., 70-100 GB or more) and requires a stable broadband internet connection.
- 7. **Launch the Game:** Once all downloads and updates are complete, you can launch Microsoft Flight Simulator from your desktop shortcut or the Start Menu.

MAINTENANCE

While Microsoft Flight Simulator 2020 is software, regular maintenance practices can ensure optimal performance and stability.

- **Keep Drivers Updated:** Ensure your graphics card drivers and other system drivers are always up to date. Visit your hardware manufacturer's website for the latest versions.
- Game Updates: The simulator frequently receives updates. Ensure you have a stable internet connection to
 download these updates when prompted, as they often include performance improvements, bug fixes, and new
 content.
- **Disk Space Management:** Periodically check your hard drive for sufficient free space. Large updates and add-ons can consume significant storage.

TROUBLESHOOTING

Encountering issues during installation or gameplay can be frustrating. Here are some common problems and their potential solutions:

Installation Errors (e.g., "Transfer Error", "File Missing")

- Clean Discs: Ensure all DVD-ROMs are clean and free of smudges or scratches. Use a soft, lint-free cloth to gently wipe them.
- **Disable Antivirus:** Temporarily disable your antivirus software during installation. Remember to re-enable it afterward.
- **Disable Autoplay:** Turn off the "Autoplay" feature for your DVD drive in Windows settings before starting the installation.
- Copy Discs to Hard Drive: As a last resort, you can try copying the contents of each DVD to a separate folder on your hard drive (e.g., "Disc1", "Disc2", etc.) and then running the setup from the copied Disc 1 folder. This can sometimes bypass read errors from the physical discs.
- Sufficient Disk Space: Verify you have ample free space (at least 150 GB) on your target installation drive.

"Code Already Used" or Activation Issues

- Microsoft Account: Ensure you are logged into the correct Microsoft account that the game was initially activated with.
- Internet Connection: A stable internet connection is required for activation.
- Contact Support: If the issue persists, contact Microsoft Support directly. Provide your product key and proof of purchase.

Performance Issues (Low FPS, Stuttering)

- Update Drivers: Ensure your graphics card drivers are up to date.
- Adjust Graphics Settings: Lower in-game graphics settings (e.g., resolution, texture quality, cloud quality, antialiasing).
- Close Background Applications: Close any unnecessary applications running in the background to free up system resources.
- Internet Speed: A slow internet connection can impact streaming world data, leading to stutters.

Game Crashes

- Verify System Requirements: Double-check that your PC meets or exceeds the minimum system requirements.
- Check for Updates: Ensure the game is fully updated.
- Overheating: Monitor your CPU and GPU temperatures. Overheating can cause crashes. Ensure proper

ventilation for your PC.

• Corrupted Files: Consider verifying game files through the Microsoft Store or Xbox app.


