1. IMPORTANT SAFETY INFORMATION

Please read this entire manual carefully before installing and using your AREBOS Inflatable Hot Tub. Failure to follow these instructions could result in serious injury or property damage. Keep this manual for future reference.

- **Electrical Safety:** Always connect the hot tub to a grounded power outlet. Do not use extension cords. Ensure all electrical connections are dry and protected from water.
- **Water Chemistry:** Maintain proper water chemistry (pH, sanitizer levels) to ensure safe and hygienic water conditions. Improper chemistry can lead to health issues and damage to the hot tub.
- **Temperature:** The water temperature should not exceed 40°C (104°F). Pregnant women, young children, and individuals with health conditions should consult a physician before use.
- **Supervision:** Children should always be supervised by an adult when in or near the hot tub.
- **Placement:** Place the hot tub on a flat, stable, and level surface capable of supporting the weight of the filled hot tub and its occupants. Ensure adequate drainage.

2. SETUP AND INSTALLATION

Follow these steps for proper setup of your AREBOS Inflatable Hot Tub.

1. **Unpacking:** Carefully remove all components from the packaging. Ensure all parts listed in the packing list are present.
2. **Site Selection:** Choose a suitable location for your hot tub. The surface must be flat, stable, and free of sharp objects. Consider proximity to a power outlet and a water source.
3. **Automatic Inflation:** Connect the hot tub to a power source. The hot tub features an automatic inflation function. Simply press the inflation button on the control panel, and the spa will inflate itself. Ensure the air valve is securely closed after inflation.
4. **Filling with Water:** Once inflated, fill the hot tub with water using a garden hose. Fill to the recommended water level indicated on the inner wall of the spa (between MIN and MAX lines).

5. **Filter Installation:** Install the filter cartridge into the designated filter housing inside the hot tub. Ensure it is securely fastened.

- **Power On/Off:** Press the power button to turn the hot tub system on or off.
- **Temperature Adjustment:** Use the 'Temp Up' and 'Temp Down' buttons to set your desired water temperature, up to 40°C. The display will show the current water temperature.
- **Heater Function:** Activate the heater by pressing the 'Heater' button. The heater will automatically turn off once the set temperature is reached and reactivate if the temperature drops.
- **Massage Jets (Bubbles):** Press the 'Bubble' button to activate the 130 powerful air jets for a relaxing massage experience. Press again to turn off.
- **Filter System:** The 'Filter' button controls the filtration system. It is recommended to run the filter regularly to maintain water clarity. The system includes an alarm function for filter maintenance.
- **Automatic Shut-off/Standby:** The hot tub features automatic shut-off and standby modes for safety and energy efficiency.

4. MAINTENANCE

Regular maintenance is crucial for the longevity and hygienic operation of your hot tub.

- **Filter Cartridge Cleaning/Replacement:** The high-performance filter with 80 slits should be cleaned regularly (e.g., weekly) and replaced every few months, depending on usage. A filter alarm will indicate when attention is needed.
- **Water Treatment:** Regularly test the water pH and sanitizer levels (e.g., chlorine or bromine). Adjust as necessary using appropriate hot tub chemicals to prevent algae growth and ensure water quality.
- **Cleaning the Hot Tub:** Periodically drain the hot tub and clean the interior surfaces with a soft cloth and mild, non-abrasive cleaner. Rinse thoroughly before refilling.
- **Cover Care:** Keep the hot tub cover clean and free of debris. This helps maintain water temperature and prevents contamination.
- **Winterization (for outdoor use):** If using outdoors in cold climates, follow proper winterization procedures to prevent freezing and damage to the hot tub and its components. This typically involves draining, cleaning, drying, and storing in a protected area.

5. TROUBLESHOOTING

This section addresses common issues you might encounter with your AREBOS Inflatable Hot Tub.

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Hot tub not inflating	Power not connected; air valve open; inflation button not pressed.	Ensure power is connected. Close air valve. Press the automatic inflation button.
Water not heating	Heater not activated; filter dirty; ambient temperature too low; cover not on.	Activate heater. Clean or replace filter. Ensure hot tub is covered to retain heat.
Massage jets not working	Bubble function not activated; power issue.	Press the 'Bubble' button. Check power connection.
Filter alarm / Dirty water	Filter cartridge clogged; improper water chemistry.	Clean or replace the filter cartridge. Test and adjust water chemistry (pH, sanitizer).
Water leaking	Loose connections; small puncture.	Check all connections for tightness. Use the provided repair kit for small punctures.
