INTRODUCTION

This manual provides comprehensive instructions for the setup, operation, maintenance, and troubleshooting of your PDP Gaming Faceoff Deluxe Wireless Switch Pro Controller. Designed for Nintendo Switch, Switch Lite, and Switch OLED, this controller offers wireless freedom, customizable features, and motion control capabilities to enhance your gaming experience.

SETUP

Charging the Controller

Before initial use, ensure your controller is fully charged. The controller features a built-in rechargeable battery designed for up to 40 hours of gameplay on a single charge.

- Locate the USB charging port on the top edge of the controller.
- Connect the provided USB charging cable to the controller's port and the other end to a USB power source (e.g., Nintendo Switch dock, USB wall adapter, computer USB port).
- The LED indicators on the front of the controller will illuminate to show charging status. They will turn off or change color when fully charged.

Pairing with Nintendo Switch

Follow these steps to wirelessly connect your controller to your Nintendo Switch console:

- 1. Ensure your Nintendo Switch console is powered on and updated to the latest system software.
- 2. From the HOME Menu, select Controllers, then Change Grip/Order.
- 3. On your PDP Gaming Faceoff Deluxe Wireless Switch Pro Controller, press and hold the **Sync Button** (located on the top edge, near the charging port) for a few seconds until the player LEDs begin to flash.
- 4. Once the controller is successfully paired, the player LED(s) corresponding to its assigned player number will remain lit.
- 5. The controller has a wireless range of 30 feet. Ensure you are within this range for optimal performance.

OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

Controller Layout and Functions

The PDP Gaming Faceoff Deluxe Wireless Switch Pro Controller features a standard layout with additional customizable elements.

- Analog Sticks: Two precision analog sticks for movement and camera control. An additional precision analog stick is included for replacement or preference.
- D-Pad: Directional pad for precise input.
- Face Buttons (A, B, X, Y): Standard action buttons.
- Shoulder Buttons (L, R) & Triggers (ZL, ZR): Located on the top of the controller for various in-game actions.
- Plus (+) and Minus (-) Buttons: System menu navigation.
- Home Button: Returns to the Nintendo Switch HOME Menu.
- Capture Button: Takes screenshots or video clips.




Figure 3: Overview of the controller's front buttons and analog sticks.

Customizable Features

This controller allows for personalization to suit your gaming style.

- Interchangeable Faceplate: The unique design allows you to swap out the front faceplate for a different look. Gently lift the existing faceplate from the edges to remove it, and snap a new one into place.
- Interchangeable Joysticks/Thumbsticks: The analog stick caps can be removed and replaced with different styles or heights for improved comfort and precision.
- **Programmable Back Buttons (Paddles):** Two programmable back buttons are located on the underside of the controller. These can be assigned to replicate any other button on the controller for quick access during gameplay. Refer to the specific programming instructions provided with the controller or on the manufacturer's website for detailed steps.

Motion Control

The controller supports motion control features, allowing for immersive gameplay in compatible titles such as Mario Kart 8, Mario Party, Arms, Splatoon 2, and Zelda Breath of the Wild. Ensure the game supports motion controls and that the feature is enabled in the game's settings if applicable.

MAINTENANCE

Cleaning

To maintain the appearance and functionality of your controller:

- Use a soft, dry cloth to wipe down the controller's surface.
- For stubborn dirt, slightly dampen the cloth with water. Avoid using harsh chemicals, abrasive cleaners, or excessive moisture, as these can damage the controller.
- Clean around buttons and analog sticks carefully to prevent debris buildup.

Storage and Battery Care

- Store the controller in a cool, dry place away from direct sunlight and extreme temperatures.
- Avoid dropping or subjecting the controller to strong impacts.
- To prolong battery life, avoid fully discharging the battery frequently. Charge the controller regularly, even if not in constant use.
- If storing for an extended period, charge the battery to approximately 50% before storage.

TROUBLESHOOTING

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution	
Controller does not connect/pair.	Out of range, low battery, pairing issue, console software outdated.	Ensure controller is charged. Move closer to the Nintendo Switch console. Repeat the pairing process (press and hold Sync Button). Check for Nintendo Switch system updates. Clean the controller (refer to Maintenance section). Restart the Nintendo Switch console. Re-pair the controller. If issue persists, contact customer support.	
Buttons or analog sticks are unresponsive.	Debris under buttons, software glitch, physical damage.		
Battery life is shorter than expected.	Aging battery, frequent full discharge, environmental factors.	Ensure full charge before use. Avoid extreme temperatures during use or charging. If significantly degraded, battery may need replacement (contact support).
