#### 1. Introduction

This manual provides detailed instructions for the setup, operation, maintenance, and troubleshooting of your Victrix Gambit Black Wireless and Wired Gaming Headset. Designed for competitive gaming, this headset offers superior audio performance and comfort for PlayStation PS4 and PS5 consoles.

## 2. KEY FEATURES

- **Powerful Pro Audio:** Engineered by esports professionals with 50mm HD Speaker Drivers for precision surround sound. Supports 3D Audio on PS5 for enhanced spatial awareness.
- Wireless & Wired Capability: Offers wireless connectivity up to 40 feet and includes a 3.5mm cable for wired connection, suitable for tournament play. Officially licensed for PlayStation 4 (PS4) and PlayStation 5 (PS5).
- **Noise-Canceling Microphone:** Features a bi-directional, noise-canceling microphone for crystal clear voice communication. The microphone can be flipped up to mute instantly.
- All-Day Comfort: Designed with an ultra-lightweight frame and cool vegan leather ear cushions for extended gaming sessions. Provides over 16 hours of battery life.
- Next-Gen Esports Gaming: Tuned for popular competitive games, ensuring optimal audio performance.

## 3. SETUP GUIDE

#### 3.1. Unboxing and Components

Before beginning, ensure all components are present in the packaging:

- · Victrix Gambit Gaming Headset
- · USB Wireless Transmitter
- 3.5mm Audio Cable with In-line Controls
- USB Charging Cable
- · User Manual (this document)

#### 3.2. Initial Charging

For optimal performance, fully charge the headset before first use. Connect the USB charging cable to the headset's charging port and to a powered USB port (e.g., on your console or a USB wall adapter). The LED indicator on the headset will show charging status.

## 3.3. Connecting Wirelessly (PlayStation PS4/PS5)

- 1. Insert the USB Wireless Transmitter into an available USB port on your PlayStation console.
- 2. Power on the headset by pressing and holding the Power button until the LED illuminates.
- 3. The headset and transmitter should automatically pair. A solid LED on both devices indicates a successful connection.
- 4. On your PlayStation, navigate to Settings > Sound > Audio Output and ensure the output device is set to the Victrix Gambit Headset.

The Victrix Gambit headset supports both wireless and wired modes, offering flexibility for home and tournament use.

#### 3.4. Connecting with Wired Mode

To use the headset in wired mode, connect the included 3.5mm audio cable to the headset's 3.5mm port and to the controller's 3.5mm jack. This mode is ideal for tournament play or when battery power is low. In wired mode, the headset's internal battery is bypassed, and power is drawn from the connected device.




Figure 3.2: Side view of the headset, showing the power button and other controls.

## 4. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

#### 4.1. Power On/Off

- Power On: Press and hold the Power button on the headset until the LED indicator lights up.
- Power Off: Press and hold the Power button until the LED indicator turns off.

#### 4.2. Volume Control

Adjust the master volume using the volume wheel located on the headset's earcup. Rotate the wheel up to increase volume and down to decrease it.

#### 4.3. Microphone Usage

The bi-directional, noise-canceling microphone is designed for clear communication.

- Activate/Deactivate: Flip the microphone boom down to activate it. Flip it up to mute the microphone. A click sound indicates the mute status change.
- **Microphone Monitoring:** The headset features a three-stage mic monitor. Adjust this setting to hear your own voice feedback through the headset, preventing you from speaking too loudly.

#### 4.4. Mode Switching (Wireless/Wired)

The headset automatically detects whether it is in wireless or wired mode. When the 3.5mm cable is connected, the headset operates in wired mode. When disconnected, it will attempt to connect wirelessly via the USB transmitter.




Figure 4.2: On-ear audio controls for the headset.

## 5. ADVANCED AUDIO FEATURES

## 5.1. 3D Audio and Spectral Hearing

The Victrix Gambit headset is optimized for 3D Audio on PS5, providing an immersive spatial sound experience. Its 50mm HD speaker drivers deliver a superior dynamic range, referred to as Spectral Hearing, allowing you to pinpoint audio cues with precision.

### 6. COMFORT AND DESIGN

## 6.1. Lightweight Design and Earcups

The headset features an ultra-lightweight design for extended comfort during long gaming sessions. The noise-isolating earcups are wrapped in plush, vegan leather, providing both comfort and effective sound isolation to block out distractions.

#### 7. MAINTENANCE

## 7.1. Cleaning

To maintain your headset's condition, regularly wipe the earcups and headband with a soft, dry cloth. For stubborn dirt, a slightly damp cloth with mild soap can be used, but ensure no moisture enters the speaker grilles or ports. Do not use harsh chemicals or abrasive cleaners.

## 7.2. Storage

Store the headset in a cool, dry place away from direct sunlight and extreme temperatures. Avoid placing heavy objects on the headset to prevent damage to the headband or earcups. When not in use for extended periods, ensure the headset is fully charged before storage to preserve battery health.

## 8. TROUBLESHOOTING

If you encounter issues with your Victrix Gambit headset, refer to the table below for common problems and solutions.

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution		
No audio from headset (Wireless)	Headset not paired; Low battery; Incorrect audio output settings.	Ensure USB transmitter is connected and headset is powered on. Recharge headset. Check PlayStation audio settings to ensure Victrix Gambit is selected as output device.		
No audio from headset (Wired)	Cable not fully inserted; Faulty cable; Controller audio settings.	Ensure 3.5mm cable is securely connected to both headset and controller. Try a different 3.5mm cable if available. Check PlayStation controller audio settings.		
Microphone not working	Microphone muted; Incorrect input device settings; Microphone boom not fully down.	Flip the microphone boom fully down to unmute. Check PlayStation audio settings to ensure Victrix Gambit is selected as input device.		
Poor sound quality/static	Interference (Wireless); Loose cable (Wired); Low battery.	Move closer to the USB transmitter or away from other wireless devices. Re-seat the 3.5mm cable. Recharge headset.		
Headset not charging	Faulty USB cable; USB port not powered.	Try a different USB charging cable. Use a different USB port or wall adapter.
