1. SETUP AND INSTALLATION

1.1 Package Contents

Before installation, verify that all components are present in the package:

- CAMECHO Android 10.0 Car Stereo Unit
- Power Cable
- USB Cables (2x)
- GPS Antenna
- RCA Input/Output Cables
- Rear View Camera (Waterproof with 12 IR lights)
- Stents (Mounting Brackets)
- User Manual

1.2 Unit Dimensions and Installation

The main unit is a double DIN car stereo with a 9.7-inch vertical touchscreen. Ensure your vehicle's dashboard opening is compatible with the unit's dimensions.

- **Unit Dimensions:** 21.8 (L) x 22.2 (H) x 5 (D) cm
- **Screen Size:** 9.7 inches






1.3 Wiring Diagram




Image: Comprehensive wiring diagram indicating connections for power, speakers, camera input, USB, and other peripheral devices.



2. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

2.1 Basic Operation

- **Power On/Off:** Press and hold the power button (usually labeled 'VOL' or 'PWR') on the unit's front panel.
- **Volume Control:** Use the physical volume knob on the unit or the touchscreen controls.
- **Touchscreen:** Navigate the Android interface by tapping, swiping, and pinching on the 9.7-inch capacitive touchscreen.

2.2 Bluetooth Functionality

The unit supports Bluetooth 4.0 for hands-free calling and A2DP for high-quality music streaming. Pair your smartphone to the car stereo to access these features.

- **Pairing:** Go to the Bluetooth settings on the car stereo and your phone. Search for available devices and

select 'CAMECHO' (or similar device name). Confirm the pairing code if prompted.

- **Hands-Free Calls:** Once paired, you can make and receive calls directly from the car stereo. The phone book can be synchronized automatically.
- **Music Playback:** Stream audio from your phone to the car stereo via Bluetooth.

2.3 GPS Navigation

The unit comes with pre-installed navigation software. You can use online navigation via WiFi or download offline maps.

- **Online Navigation:** Connect to a WiFi hotspot to use online mapping services.
- **Offline Maps:** The unit includes a map APK named "Here wego". Download free maps manually for offline use. Older versions may have iGo/Sygiec maps pre-installed.

2.4 WiFi Connectivity

Connect the car stereo to a WiFi network to access online features, download apps, and browse the internet.

- **Connecting to WiFi:** Go to Settings > Network & Internet > Wi-Fi. Select your desired network and enter the password.
- **App Installation:** Once connected, you can install various Android applications from the app store.

2.5 Mirror Link Function

Mirror Link allows you to display your smartphone's screen on the car stereo. This feature supports both iOS and Android devices.

- **iOS Devices:** Connect via WiFi for one-way projection (phone to stereo).
- **Android Devices:** Connect via WiFi or USB data cable for two-way connection (control phone from stereo, and vice-versa).

2.6 FM / RDS Radio

Tune into your favorite radio stations. The RDS function provides additional information like station name, song title, and traffic announcements.

- **Tuning:** Use the touchscreen interface to scan for stations or manually enter frequencies.

- **RDS:** Radio Data System automatically displays relevant information when available.

2.7 Rear View Camera Input

The included waterproof rear view camera automatically displays the rear view on the stereo screen when the vehicle is put into reverse gear, assisting with parking.

- **Installation:** Connect the camera to the dedicated 'Rear Camera Input' port on the stereo unit and ensure proper power connection.
- **Automatic Display:** The screen will automatically switch to the camera view when reverse gear is engaged.

2.8 Steering Wheel Control

The unit supports steering wheel control, allowing you to manage audio and other functions without taking your hands off the wheel. This requires proper wiring and configuration.

Customize the color of the physical buttons on the unit to match your vehicle's interior lighting or your personal preference.




Image: The car stereo's screen displaying the interface for customizing the color of the physical buttons, featuring a color palette and adjustment sliders.

3. MAINTENANCE

3.1 Cleaning the Unit

- For stubborn smudges, slightly dampen the cloth with water or a screen-safe cleaner.
- Avoid using abrasive cleaners, solvents, or harsh chemicals, as these can damage the screen and finish.

3.2 Software Updates

Periodically check for software updates to ensure your unit has the latest features and bug fixes. Updates are typically available through the manufacturer's website or via an over-the-air (OTA) update if the unit is connected to WiFi.

4. TROUBLESHOOTING

If you encounter issues with your CAMECHO car stereo, refer to the following common problems and solutions:

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
No Power	Incorrect wiring, blown fuse, vehicle battery issue.	Check power connections (ACC, B+, GND). Verify vehicle fuses. Ensure battery is charged.
No Sound	Speaker wires disconnected, volume too low, incorrect audio source.	Check speaker wiring. Increase volume. Select correct audio source (FM, Bluetooth, USB).
Bluetooth Connection Issues	Phone not discoverable, incorrect pairing, interference.	Ensure Bluetooth is enabled on both devices. Delete previous pairings and re-pair. Move closer to the unit.
GPS Not Working / Inaccurate	GPS antenna not connected, poor signal, outdated maps.	Ensure GPS antenna is securely connected and placed in an unobstructed location. Update maps if necessary.
Rear Camera Not Displaying	Camera wiring issue, reverse trigger wire not connected.	Verify camera video input and power connections. Ensure the reverse trigger wire is correctly connected to the vehicle's reverse light circuit.
Unit Unstable in Dash	Improper mounting, missing cage.	Ensure the provided brackets are securely fastened to the unit and the vehicle's dash. If a mounting cage is required for your vehicle, it may need to be purchased separately.
