## INTRODUCTION

---

This manual provides detailed instructions for the assembly, operation, and maintenance of your Lexicon Adra Contemporary Faux Leather Daybed. Please read all instructions carefully before beginning assembly and retain this manual for future reference.

The Adra Daybed features a contemporary design with faux leather upholstery and includes a convenient pull-out trundle bed, offering versatile sleeping or lounging options.

## SAFETY INFORMATION

---

- **Adult Assembly Required:** This product requires adult assembly. Do not allow children to assemble the unit.
- **Keep Small Parts Away from Children:** Small parts can pose a choking hazard. Keep them out of reach of children during assembly.
- **Use Correct Tools:** Ensure you have the necessary tools as specified in the assembly section.
- **Inspect All Components:** Before assembly, check all parts for damage. Do not use if any part is damaged. Contact customer support for replacements.
- **Secure All Fasteners:** Ensure all bolts, screws, and connectors are securely tightened before use. Periodically check and re-tighten as needed.
- **Weight Capacity:** Do not exceed the recommended weight capacity for the daybed or trundle.
- **Mattress Thickness:** For optimal fit and safety, use twin mattresses no thicker than 8 inches for both the main daybed and the trundle bed.

## PACKAGE CONTENTS

---

Please verify that all components listed below are present before beginning assembly. If any parts are missing or damaged, please contact Lexicon customer support.

- Daybed Frame (Wood and engineered wood components)

- Faux Leather Upholstery Panels
- Trundle Bed Frame with Casters
- Hardware Pack (Screws, bolts, washers, Allen wrench, etc.)
- Bed Slats/Support System

## SETUP AND ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTIONS

---

Assembly of the Lexicon Adra Daybed requires two adults. Clear a spacious area for assembly and keep all tools and hardware within reach.

1. **Unpack Components:** Carefully remove all parts from the packaging. Lay them out on a soft, clean surface to prevent scratches.
2. **Identify Parts:** Refer to the included parts list and diagrams (if provided in physical manual) to identify each component.
3. **Assemble Main Daybed Frame:** Follow the step-by-step instructions provided in your physical assembly guide to connect the main daybed frame components using the supplied hardware. Ensure all connections are finger-tightened initially.
4. **Install Bed Slats:** Attach the bed slats or support system to the main daybed frame. Ensure they are evenly spaced and securely fastened. *Note: A foundation or box spring is not required for this daybed.*
5. **Assemble Trundle Bed:** Construct the trundle bed frame, attaching the casters as directed. Ensure casters are firmly attached for smooth operation.
6. **Insert Trundle:** Carefully slide the assembled trundle bed into position under the main daybed frame.
7. **Final Tightening:** Once all components are assembled, go back and securely tighten all bolts and screws using the provided Allen wrench. Do not overtighten.

## OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

---

The Lexicon Adra Daybed is designed for ease of use, featuring a pull-out trundle for additional sleeping space.

- **Main Daybed Use:** Place a twin-sized mattress (maximum 8 inches thick) on the main daybed frame. The daybed serves as a comfortable seating area or primary sleeping surface.
- **Trundle Bed Operation:** To use the trundle bed, gently pull the trundle frame out from under the main daybed. The casters allow for smooth movement.
- **Trundle Mattress:** Place a twin-sized mattress (maximum 8 inches thick) on the trundle bed frame.
- **Storing the Trundle:** When not in use, push the trundle bed back under the main daybed until it is fully recessed.

## MAINTENANCE

Proper care will extend the life and appearance of your Lexicon Adra Daybed.

- **Cleaning Upholstery:** Wipe the faux leather upholstery with a dry, soft cloth. For spills, gently blot with a damp cloth and mild soap, then wipe dry immediately. Avoid harsh chemicals or abrasive cleaners.
- **Frame Care:** Periodically check all bolts and screws to ensure they remain tight. Re-tighten as necessary to maintain structural integrity.
- **Caster Maintenance:** Keep trundle casters free of debris to ensure smooth operation.
- **Avoid Direct Sunlight:** Prolonged exposure to direct sunlight can cause fading or damage to the faux leather.

## TROUBLESHOOTING

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Daybed feels unstable or wobbly.	Loose fasteners.	Check and tighten all bolts and screws on the main frame.
Trundle bed does not slide smoothly.	Debris in casters or casters not properly installed.	Clean casters of any obstructions. Ensure casters are securely attached and facing the correct direction.
Mattress does not fit properly.	Incorrect mattress size or thickness.	Ensure you are using a twin-sized mattress no thicker than 8 inches for both the main daybed and trundle.
Missing parts during assembly.	Packaging not thoroughly checked.	Double-check all packaging materials. If still missing, contact Lexicon customer support.
