# BaBylissPRO TT Tourmaline Titanium Travel Dryer (Red)

## PRODUCT OVERVIEW

---

The BaBylissPRO TT Tourmaline Titanium Travel Dryer is a compact and powerful hair dryer designed for portability and efficient drying. Featuring Tourmaline Titanium technology, it helps to reduce frizz and enhance shine, providing professional results on the go. Its lightweight design and dual voltage capability make it an ideal companion for travel.

## IMPORTANT SAFETY INSTRUCTIONS

---

When using electrical appliances, especially when children are present, basic safety precautions should always be followed, including the following:

- **DANGER** - Any appliance is electrically live even when the switch is off. To reduce the risk of death by electric shock:
  - a. Always unplug appliance immediately after using.
  - b. Do not use while bathing or in a shower.
  - c. Do not place or store appliance where it can fall or be pulled into a tub or sink.
  - d. Do not place in or drop into water or other liquid.
  - e. If an appliance falls into water, unplug it immediately. Do not reach into the water.
  
- **WARNING** - To reduce the risk of burns, electrocution, fire, or injury to persons:
  - a. This appliance should never be left unattended when plugged in.
  - b. Do not pull, twist, or wrap line cord around appliance.
  - c. This appliance is not intended for use by persons (including children) with reduced physical, sensory or mental capabilities, or lack of experience and knowledge, unless they have been given supervision or instruction concerning use of the appliance by a person responsible for their safety.
  - d. Children should be supervised to ensure that they do not play with the appliance.
  - e. Use this appliance only for its intended use as described in this manual. Do not use attachments not

recommended by the manufacturer.

- f. Never operate this appliance if it has a damaged cord or plug, if it is not working properly, or if it has been dropped, damaged, or dropped into water. Return the appliance to an authorized service center for examination and repair.
- g. Keep the cord away from heated surfaces.
- h. Never block the air openings of the appliance or place it on a soft surface, such as a bed or couch, where the air openings may be blocked. Keep the air openings free of lint, hair, and the like.
- i. Never use while sleeping.
- j. Never drop or insert any object into any opening.
- k. Do not use outdoors or operate where aerosol (spray) products are being used or where oxygen is being administered.
- l. Do not use an extension cord with this appliance.
- m. Do not direct hot air toward eyes or other heat-sensitive areas.
- n. Air outlet grille and attachments may be hot during use. Allow them to cool before handling.
- o. Do not place appliance on any surface while it is operating.
- p. While using the appliance, keep your hair out of the air inlets.
- q. Do not use with a voltage converter.

## SETUP

---

Before first use, ensure the dryer is properly set up for your region's voltage and that all components are securely attached.

1. **Unpacking:** Carefully remove the dryer and all accessories from the packaging. Retain packaging for storage or future transport.
2. **Inspect for Damage:** Check the dryer and cord for any signs of damage. Do not use if damaged.
3. **Voltage Selection:** This dryer features dual voltage (125V/250V). Locate the voltage selector switch, typically on the handle. Use a coin or screwdriver to rotate the switch to the correct voltage for your location.

**Important:** Ensure the voltage selector is set to the correct voltage before plugging in. Incorrect voltage setting can damage the dryer or cause safety hazards.

- 4. Attach Concentrator Nozzle (Optional):** If desired, attach the concentrator nozzle to the front of the dryer. Align the nozzle with the dryer's barrel and push firmly until it clicks into place.

5. **Plug In:** Insert the power plug into a suitable electrical outlet.

## OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

---

Follow these steps for effective and safe use of your travel dryer.

1. **Prepare Hair:** Gently towel-dry hair to remove excess moisture.
2. **Select Heat/Speed Setting:** The dryer features a rocker switch for controlling heat and speed.
  - **OFF:** Center position.
  - **LOW:** Lower position for gentle drying and styling.
  - **HIGH:** Upper position for fast drying.

*Start with a lower setting for delicate hair or to begin drying, then increase as needed.*

3. **Drying Technique:**
  - Direct airflow from roots to ends.

- Keep the dryer moving to prevent concentrating heat in one area.
  - For added volume, lift sections of hair at the roots while drying.
  - Use the concentrator nozzle for precise styling and smoothing.
4. **Cool Shot (if applicable):** This model may not have a dedicated cool shot button. To achieve a cooler airflow, switch to the lowest heat setting or turn off the dryer briefly.
  5. **Finish:** Once hair is dry and styled, switch the dryer to the OFF position and unplug it from the outlet.

## MAINTENANCE

---

Regular maintenance ensures optimal performance and extends the life of your dryer.

- **Cleaning the Air Filter:** The rear filter of your dryer should be cleaned regularly to prevent lint and hair buildup, which can restrict airflow and cause overheating.
  - a. Ensure the dryer is unplugged and completely cool.
  - b. Gently twist or pull off the rear filter cover (refer to product diagram if unsure).
  - c. Use a small brush or vacuum cleaner to remove any accumulated lint or hair.
  - d. Replace the filter cover securely.
- **Exterior Cleaning:** Wipe the exterior of the dryer with a soft, damp cloth. Do not use abrasive cleaners or solvents.
- **Cord Care:** Do not wrap the power cord around the dryer. Store the cord loosely coiled to prevent kinks and damage.
- **Storage:** Store the dryer in a cool, dry place when not in use. The foldable handle allows for compact storage.

## TROUBLESHOOTING

---

If you encounter issues with your dryer, refer to the following common problems and solutions.

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Dryer does not turn on.	Not plugged in; power outlet issue; voltage selector incorrect; internal thermal cut-off activated.	Ensure plug is fully inserted. Test outlet with another appliance. Verify voltage selector is set correctly (125V or 250V). Unplug and allow to cool for 10-15 minutes, then try again.
Dryer stops during use.	Overheating due to blocked air intake/outlet; internal thermal cut-off activated.	Unplug immediately. Allow to cool for 10-15 minutes. Clean the rear air filter to remove lint/hair. Ensure air vents are not blocked during use.
Weak airflow or low heat.	Blocked air filter; incorrect heat/speed setting.	Clean the rear air filter. Ensure the heat/speed switch is set to the desired level (HIGH for maximum heat/speed).
Unusual noise or smell.	Internal component issue; foreign object in fan.	Unplug immediately. Do not use. Contact customer support or an authorized service center.
