1. PRODUCT OVERVIEW

The BaByliss Air Pro 2300 professional hair dryer, manufactured in Italy, delivers a powerful airflow speed of 120 km/h for efficient drying. Air Glide technology ensures consistent performance. Featuring a streamlined design for smooth airflow, a salon-grade AC motor designed for long-term reliability, and a precisely calibrated fan for optimal speed and pressure. The high-performance ionic system releases conditioning ions to smooth hair and enhance shine. Variable heat and speed settings provide precise drying and styling control. Two fine concentrator nozzles direct airflow for smooth styling, and a large salon-quality diffuser enhances natural curls and adds volume.

2. SETUP

Before first use, ensure all packaging materials are removed. Inspect the appliance for any signs of damage. If any damage is observed, do not use the appliance and contact customer support.

2.1 Connecting to Power

- 1. Ensure the appliance is switched off.
- 2. Plug the appliance into a suitable power outlet.

3. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

3.1 Preparation

1. Ensure hair is towel-dried and detangled before using the hair dryer.

3.2 Heat and Speed Settings

The appliance features 3 heat settings and 2 speed settings, plus a cool shot button. These controls are typically located on the handle of the dryer.

- Use higher heat and speed settings for initial drying of wet hair.
- Use lower heat and speed settings for styling and gentle drying as hair begins to dry.
- Press the cool shot button to set your style with a burst of cool air.

3.3 Using Attachments

The BaByliss Air Pro 2300 includes two concentrator nozzles and one diffuser for versatile styling.

- Concentrator Nozzle: Attach a concentrator nozzle to direct airflow precisely during styling. This is ideal for smooth, straight styles.
 - Important: Use the concentrator nozzle only on the lowest heat/speed setting to prevent overheating and potential damage to hair or the appliance.

- Diffuser: Attach the diffuser to enhance natural curls and create volume.
 - Important: Use the diffuser only on the lowest heat and speed settings to protect curls and prevent frizz.

3.4 After Use

- 1. Turn off the appliance using the power switch.
- 2. Unplug the appliance from the power outlet.
- 3. Allow the appliance to cool down completely before storing.
- 4. *Important:* Always keep the rear of the appliance clear of hair during use to prevent hair from being drawn into the rear air filter.

4. MAINTENANCE AND CLEANING

To maintain your appliance in optimal condition and ensure its longevity, follow these steps:

4.1 General Cleaning

- 1. Ensure the appliance is switched off, unplugged, and completely cooled down before cleaning.
- 2. To clean the exterior, wipe with a damp cloth. Ensure no water enters the appliance and that it is completely dry before next use.
- 3. Do not wrap the power cord tightly around the appliance. Instead, coil the cord loosely beside the appliance.
- 4. Do not use the appliance if the power cord is stretched or damaged.
- 5. Always unplug after use.

4.2 Filter Cleaning

Regular cleaning of the rear filter is crucial for maintaining airflow and appliance performance.

- 1. While holding the appliance handle firmly, twist the rear filter cover to the left to remove it.
- 2. Using a soft brush, clean any accumulated hair and debris from the filter.
- 3. Replace the rear filter cover by aligning the grooves and twisting to the right until it locks securely into place.

5. SAFETY INFORMATION

Please read all safety instructions carefully before using the appliance to prevent injury or damage.

- · Always keep the rear of the appliance clear of hair during use to prevent hair from being drawn into the air filter.
- Use the concentrator nozzle only on the lowest heat/speed setting to avoid excessive heat concentration.
- Ensure the appliance is switched off, unplugged, and completely cooled before cleaning or storing.
- Do not use this appliance near water (e.g., in a bathroom, near a shower or bathtub).
- Do not block the air inlet or outlet during operation.
- This appliance is not intended for use by persons (including children) with reduced physical, sensory or mental capabilities, or lack of experience and knowledge, unless they have been given supervision or instruction concerning use of the appliance by a person responsible for their safety.
- Children should be supervised to ensure that they do not play with the appliance.
