PRODUCT OVERVIEW

The X-PRO 125cc ATV is a 4-wheel quad designed for recreational use. Key features include a 125cc engine, front and rear luggage racks, decorative plastic trim, LED lights, a kill switch for safety, a speed governor, reverse capability, and matching rims.

SETUP AND ASSEMBLY

The X-PRO 125cc ATV requires some assembly upon delivery. This typically includes attaching the handlebars, wheels, and other accessories. Ensure all components are present and undamaged before beginning assembly.

Key Assembly Steps:

- 4. Battery Connection: Connect the battery terminals (positive first, then negative).

OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

Starting the ATV:

- 1. Ensure the kill switch is in the "Run" position.

- Throttle: Located on the right handlebar. Apply gently for smooth acceleration.
- Brakes: Hand levers for front and rear brakes. Use both for effective stopping.
- Gear Selector: This model features a reverse gear. Consult the specific gear shift pattern for your ATV.
- Speed Governor: The ATV is equipped with a speed governor for adjustable speed limits, enhancing safety for new riders.
- Kill Switch: A safety feature to immediately shut off the engine in emergencies.

MAINTENANCE

Regular maintenance is crucial for the longevity and safe operation of your X-PRO 125cc ATV. Perform checks before and after each ride, and adhere to the scheduled maintenance outlined in the full owner's manual.

- Oil Changes: Change the engine oil after the initial break-in period and then at regular intervals as specified in the full manual.
- Tire Pressure: Maintain correct tire pressure for optimal handling and safety.
- Brake Inspection: Check brake fluid levels and inspect brake pads for wear.
- Chain Lubrication: Keep the drive chain clean and properly lubricated.
- Fastener Checks: Periodically check and tighten all bolts and nuts, as vibrations can cause them to loosen.
- . Battery Care: If the ATV is stored for extended periods, use a trickle charger to maintain battery health.

TROUBLESHOOTING

This section addresses common issues you might encounter with your ATV. For more complex problems, consult a qualified technician or the full owner's manual.

• Engine Not Starting:

- o Check fuel level.
- Ensure kill switch is in "Run" position.
- Verify battery connections and charge.
- Check spark plug.

· Loss of Power:

- o Inspect air filter for clogs.
- · Check fuel quality and delivery.
- · Verify spark plug condition.

· Brake Issues:

- · Check brake fluid level.
- o Inspect brake pads for wear.
