INTRODUCTION

SETUP

The HP w200 webcam features a plug-and-play design, requiring no additional driver installation for most operating systems.

System Requirements

- Operating Systems: Windows XP (SP2, SP3), Vista, 7, 8, 10; Mac OS X 10.6 or higher.
- · Available USB port.

Installation Steps

1. Positioning the Webcam:

Attach the webcam to your monitor or place it on a flat surface using its adjustable clip. The clip allows for secure placement and angle adjustment.

- 2. **Select Device:** In the application's settings, navigate to the audio and video input options. Select "HP w200 Webcam" as your video device and "HP w200 Microphone" (or similar) as your audio input device.
- 3. **Adjust Position:** Adjust the webcam's position and angle using its 270-degree swivel and up-down adjustment to achieve the desired view.
- 4. Start Communication: Begin your video call or recording. The webcam will provide 720P HD video

at 30 frames per second.

Microphone Usage

The webcam includes a single digital microphone for audio input. Ensure it is selected as the default microphone in your application settings for clear communication.

MAINTENANCE

- Cleaning the Lens: Gently wipe the webcam lens with a soft, lint-free cloth. Avoid using harsh chemicals or abrasive materials that could scratch the lens.

- Cable Care: Avoid bending or twisting the USB cable excessively to prevent internal damage.

TROUBLESHOOTING

Problem	Possible Solution
Webcam not detected by computer.	 Ensure the USB cable is securely plugged into both the webcam and the computer. Try plugging the webcam into a different USB port. Restart your computer. Verify your operating system meets the minimum requirements.
No video output in application.	 Check the application's video settings to ensure the "HP w200 Webcam" is selected as the video input device. Ensure no other application is currently using the webcam.
No audio input from microphone.	 Check the application's audio settings to ensure the "HP w200 Microphone" is selected as the audio input device. Verify microphone privacy settings in your operating system.
Poor video quality.	 Ensure adequate lighting in your environment. Clean the webcam lens. Check your internet connection speed if streaming video.
