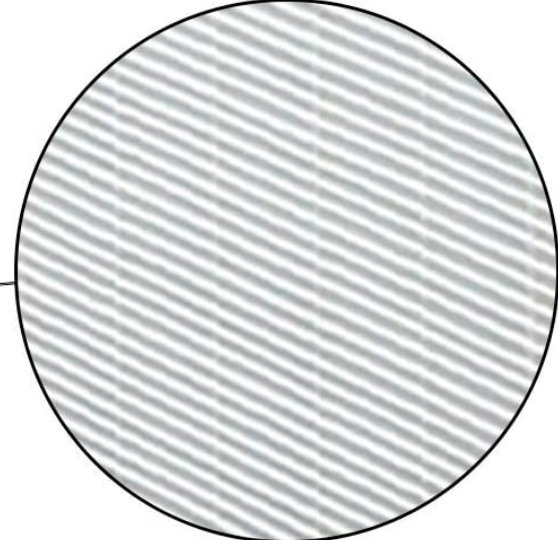
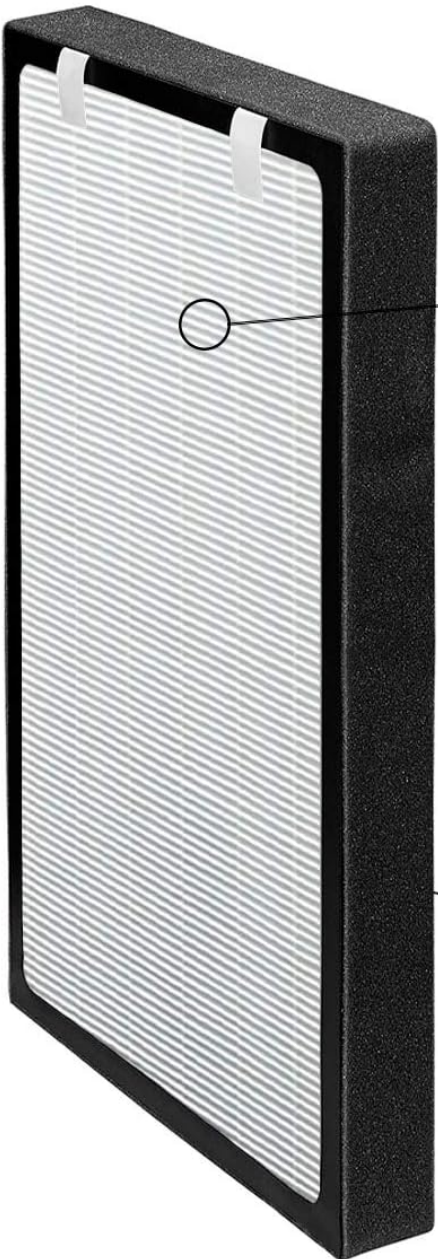
1. PRODUCT OVERVIEW

The Pro Breeze PB-P06F is a genuine replacement filter designed specifically for the Pro Breeze Large Air Purifier PB-P06 (CADR 800). This multi-layer compound filter is engineered to capture a wide range of airborne particles, contributing to cleaner indoor air quality.

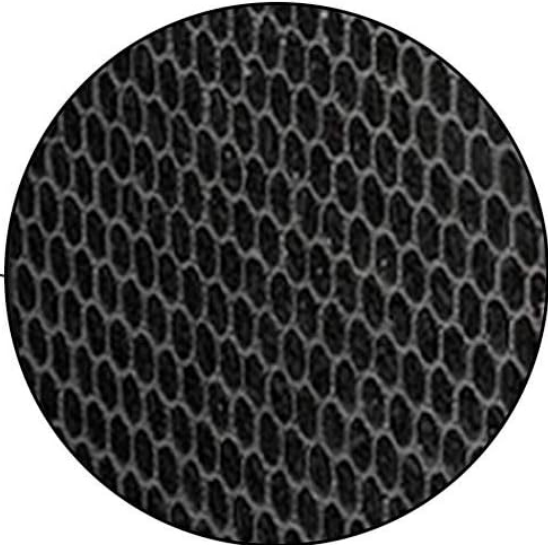
It features a 3-in-1 filtration system:

- **Pre-Filter:** Captures larger particles such as dust, lint, and pet fur.
- **True HEPA 13 Filter:** Traps up to 99.7% of airborne particles as small as 0.3 microns, including pollen, dust mites, pet dander, and smoke.
- **Activated Carbon Filter:** Absorbs odors from cooking, pets, smoke, and volatile organic compounds (VOCs).

2. INSTALLATION AND REPLACEMENT

To ensure optimal performance of your Pro Breeze Air Purifier, it is essential to replace the filter correctly. Always ensure the air

purifier is unplugged before beginning the replacement process.

1. **Power Off and Unplug:** Before attempting any filter replacement, turn off the Pro Breeze Air Purifier and unplug it from the power outlet.
2. **Access Filter Compartment:** Locate the filter compartment on your Pro Breeze PB-P06 Air Purifier. This is typically at the base or rear of the unit. Follow the instructions in your air purifier's manual to open the compartment cover.
3. **Remove Old Filter:** Carefully remove the used filter from the air purifier. It may contain accumulated dust and debris. Dispose of the old filter responsibly.
4. **Unpack New Filter:** Take the new Pro Breeze PB-P06F replacement filter out of its packaging.**Important:** Ensure all plastic wrapping is removed from the filter before installation. Failure to do so will prevent the air purifier from functioning correctly.
5. **Insert New Filter:** Insert the new filter into the air purifier, ensuring it is oriented correctly according to the markings on the filter or the air purifier's compartment. The filter should fit snugly.
6. **Close Compartment:** Securely close the filter compartment cover.
7. **Plug In and Power On:** Plug the air purifier back into the power outlet and turn it on.
8. **Reset Filter Indicator:** After replacing the filter, you may need to reset the filter life indicator on your air purifier. For the Pro Breeze PB-P06, this is typically done by pressing and holding two specific buttons on the control panel simultaneously until the indicator light resets. Refer to your air purifier's main manual for exact instructions on resetting the filter indicator.

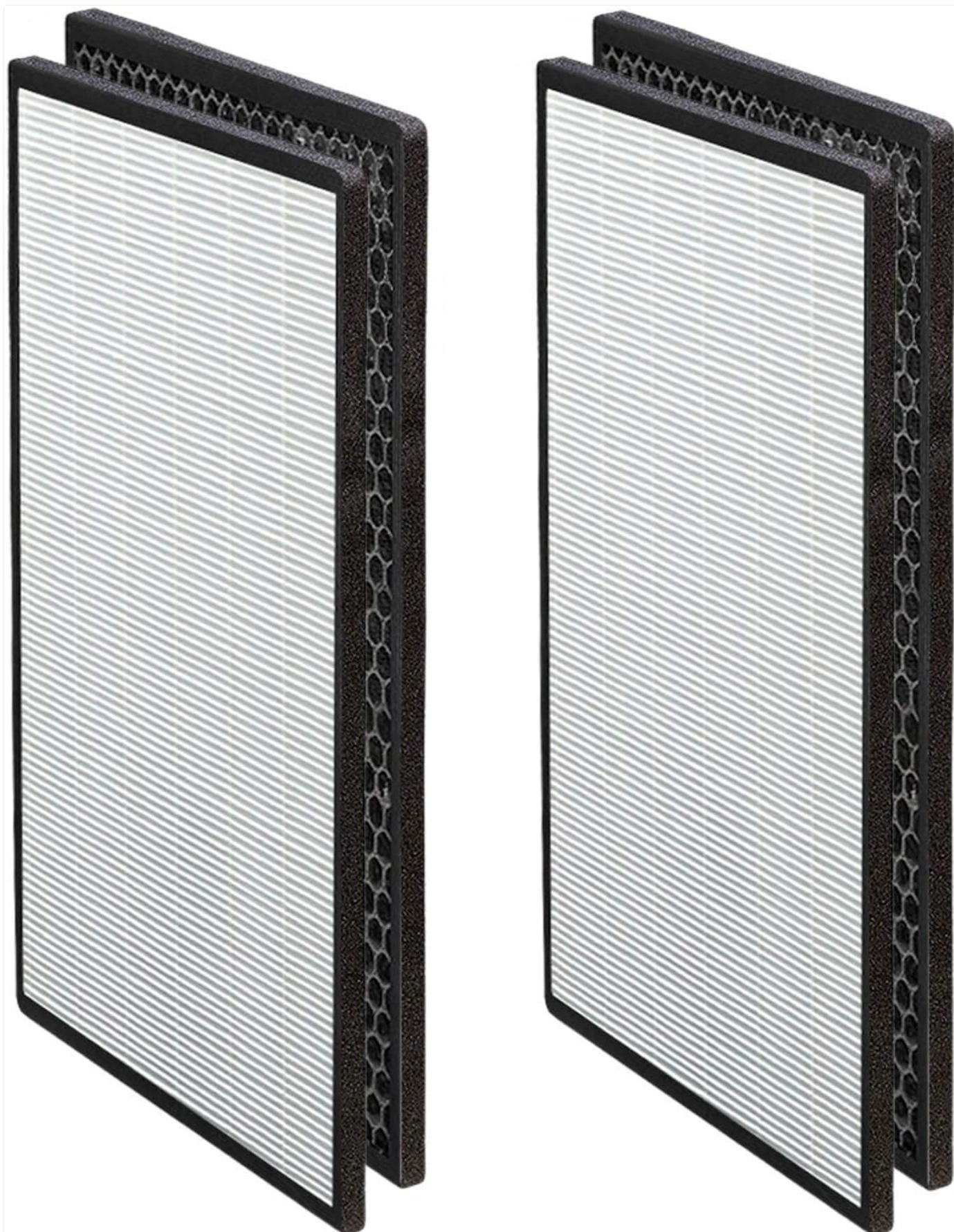


Image 2.1: Pro Breeze PB-P06F filters, ready for installation.

3. MAINTENANCE

Regular filter replacement is crucial for maintaining the efficiency and effectiveness of your air purifier. The Pro Breeze PB-P06F filter is designed for long-lasting performance.

- **Replacement Frequency:** Pro Breeze recommends replacing your filter every **5000 hours** of operation. This duration can vary based on air quality and usage frequency.
- **Filter Indicator:** Your Pro Breeze Air Purifier PB-P06 is equipped with a filter replacement indicator light. When this light illuminates, it signifies that the filter needs to be replaced.
- **Do Not Wash:** The PB-P06F filter is not washable. Attempting to wash the filter will damage its filtration capabilities and render it ineffective.

4. TROUBLESHOOTING

If you encounter issues after replacing your filter, consider the following common solutions:

- **Air Purifier Not Working/Beeping After Filter Replacement:**
 - **Check Plastic Wrapping:** Ensure all plastic packaging has been completely removed from the new filter. The filter will not function if the plastic is still on.
 - **Filter Seating:** Verify that the filter is correctly seated and fully inserted into its compartment. A loose or improperly installed filter can prevent the unit from operating.
 - **Reset Indicator:** Confirm that you have successfully reset the filter life indicator. If the indicator is not reset, the air purifier may continue to signal a need for replacement or not operate at full capacity. Refer to your air purifier's manual for the specific reset procedure (e.g., pressing two top-left buttons simultaneously for the PB-P06).
 - **Compartment Cover:** Ensure the filter compartment cover is securely closed. Some air purifiers have safety switches that prevent operation if the cover is not properly latched.
- **Reduced Airflow or Odor:**
 - If you experience reduced airflow or persistent odors shortly after replacement, double-check that the filter is installed correctly and that all plastic is removed. If the issue persists, the filter may be defective or the air purifier itself requires servicing.
