INSTALLATION AND SETUP

Proper installation is crucial for the reliable operation of your relay. Always ensure the vehicle or equipment's power is disconnected before beginning installation.

- Identify Terminals:** Refer to the wiring diagram (if available for your specific application) or the markings on the relay for terminal identification (e.g., 30, 85, 86, 87, 87a).
- Prepare Connections:** Ensure all wires are correctly sized for the current load and have appropriate connectors.
- Apply Dielectric Grease:** Before connecting wires, apply a small amount of the provided dielectric grease to each terminal. This helps prevent corrosion and ensures a good electrical connection.
- Secure Relay:** Mount the relay securely in a suitable location, away from excessive heat or moving parts, if not already integrated into a relay box. The IP68 rating allows for exposure to moisture, but a protected location is always recommended.
- Connect Wiring:** Connect the wires to the corresponding terminals according to your application's wiring diagram. Double-check all connections for tightness and correct polarity.
- Test Functionality:** Once all connections are made, reconnect power and test the relay's operation. Observe the LED indicator to confirm proper switching.

FREE DIELECTRIC GREASE

OPERATION

The HD Switch relay operates automatically based on the electrical signal it receives. When the control circuit activates the relay, the internal contacts switch, allowing power to flow through the main circuit. The integrated LED indicator provides a visual confirmation of this activation.

- **LED On:** Indicates that the relay coil is energized and the relay contacts have switched, allowing current to pass through the main circuit.
- **LED Off:** Indicates that the relay coil is de-energized and the relay contacts are in their default (open or closed) state, interrupting the main circuit.

MAINTENANCE

The HD Switch Waterproof Relay is designed for minimal maintenance due to its robust construction and IP68 certification. However, periodic checks can ensure long-term performance:

- **Inspect Connections:** Periodically check all wiring connections to the relay for tightness and signs of corrosion. Reapply dielectric grease if necessary.
- **Clean Exterior:** If the relay is exposed to dirt or debris, gently clean its exterior with a damp cloth. Avoid using harsh chemicals.
- **Monitor LED:** The LED indicator serves as a continuous diagnostic tool. If the relay is expected to be active but the LED is off, or vice-versa, it may indicate an issue with the relay or its control circuit.

TROUBLESHOOTING

The integrated LED indicator is a primary tool for troubleshooting. Use it to quickly identify if the relay is receiving power and switching correctly.

Symptom	Possible Cause	Solution
Relay not activating (LED off)	No power to coil (terminals 85/86), faulty control switch, open circuit in control wiring.	Check control circuit wiring, fuse, and switch. Verify 12V at coil terminals when activated.
Relay activating but no power to load (LED on, but device not working)	Open circuit in main power wiring (terminal 30 to 87), faulty load, corroded main power terminals.	Check main power wiring, fuse for the load, and load device itself. Inspect terminals for corrosion and reapply dielectric grease.
Relay constantly active (LED always on)	Stuck contacts, short circuit in control wiring, faulty control switch.	Disconnect control signal. If LED remains on, replace relay. Check control switch for short.
Intermittent operation	Loose connections, corroded terminals, intermittent fault in control circuit or relay.	Inspect all connections for tightness. Clean and reapply dielectric grease to terminals. If issues persist, consider replacing the relay.
