Garage-Pro Passenger Side Power Heated Mirror User Manual

Model: JCWGM01ER-SGP

PRODUCT OVERVIEW

This manual provides instructions for the Garage-Pro Passenger Side Power Heated Mirror, designed for specific Cadillac Escalade models. This mirror features power folding, power glass adjustment, an in-glass signal light, and a puddle lamp. It is a direct fit replacement for the original equipment.

COMPATIBILITY

This mirror is compatible with the following vehicle models:

- 2007-2014 Cadillac Escalade
- 2007-2013 Cadillac Escalade EXT
- 2007-2014 Cadillac Escalade ESV

Note: This mirror is designed for models equipped with a courtesy lamp and is for the passenger (right) side of the vehicle.

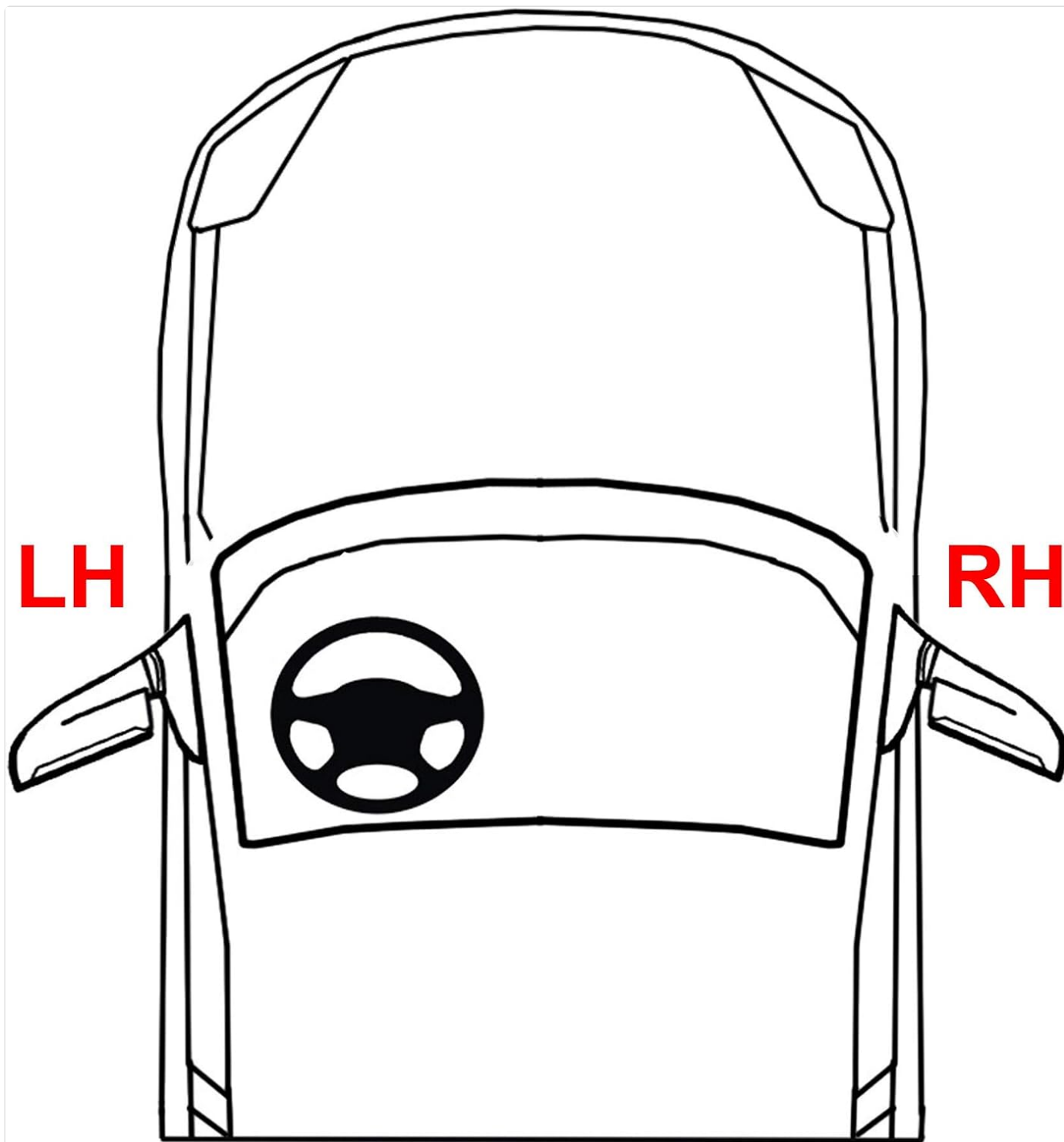

INSTALLATION AND SETUP

Professional installation is recommended. Ensure the vehicle's power system is disconnected before beginning installation to prevent electrical hazards.

Required Tools (Suggested)

- Plastic Pry Bar
- Safety Glasses
- Mechanic's Gloves
- Socket Wrench Set
- Screwdriver Set

Installation Steps

1. **Preparation:** Park the vehicle on a level surface and engage the parking brake. Disconnect the negative terminal of the vehicle's battery.
2. **Remove Old Mirror:** Carefully remove the interior door panel to access the mirror mounting bolts and electrical connector. Disconnect the electrical connector and unbolt the old mirror from the door frame.
3. **Inspect Wiring:** Before installing the new mirror, inspect the vehicle's existing wiring harness for any damage.
4. **Connect New Mirror:** Align the new Garage-Pro mirror with the mounting holes on the door. Connect the electrical harness from the new mirror to the vehicle's corresponding connector. Ensure a secure connection.

5. **Secure Mirror:** Bolt the new mirror securely to the door frame. Do not overtighten.
 6. **Test Functionality:** Reconnect the vehicle's battery. Test all mirror functions: power adjustment, power folding, signal light, and puddle lamp.
 7. **Reassemble:** Once all functions are verified, reattach the interior door panel.

OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

The Garage-Pro Power Heated Mirror operates using your vehicle's existing controls.

- **Power Adjustment:** Use the vehicle's interior mirror control switch to adjust the mirror glass position (up, down, left, right).
- **Power Folding:** If your vehicle is equipped with a power folding mirror feature, use the corresponding button or switch to fold the mirror inward or outward.
- **Heated Function:** The heated mirror function typically activates automatically with the rear defroster or a dedicated mirror heat button, depending on your vehicle's configuration. This helps clear fog and ice from the mirror surface.
- **Signal Light:** The integrated signal light will flash in conjunction with your vehicle's turn signals.
- **Puddle Lamp:** The puddle lamp illuminates the ground beneath the mirror when the doors are unlocked or opened, providing visibility in low-light conditions.

MAINTENANCE

Regular maintenance helps ensure the longevity and optimal performance of your mirror.

- **Cleaning:** Clean the mirror glass and housing with a soft cloth and automotive-safe glass cleaner. Avoid abrasive cleaners or materials that could scratch the surface.
- **Inspection:** Periodically inspect the mirror for any signs of damage, loose components, or frayed wiring.
- **Winter Care:** In freezing conditions, ensure the mirror is free of ice before attempting to power fold it to prevent damage to the motor mechanism.

TROUBLESHOOTING

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Mirror not adjusting/folding	Loose electrical connection, blown fuse, motor malfunction.	Check electrical connections. Inspect vehicle's fuse box for a blown fuse related to mirrors. If issues persist, professional diagnosis may be required.
Signal light not working	Faulty bulb/LED, wiring issue, vehicle's turn signal system problem.	Verify vehicle's turn signals are functioning correctly. Check mirror wiring.
Heated function not working	Heater element failure, wiring issue, vehicle's defroster system problem.	Ensure vehicle's rear defroster or mirror heat function is active. Check wiring.
Puddle lamp not illuminating	Bulb failure, wiring issue, vehicle's courtesy light system problem.	Check for power to the puddle lamp. Verify vehicle's interior/courtesy lights are functioning.

For complex issues or if troubleshooting steps do not resolve the problem, consult a qualified automotive technician.
