# NutriBullet Juicer Centrifugal Juicer Machine User Manual

Model: NBJ50100

## INTRODUCTION

Welcome to the world of fresh, homemade juice with your new NutriBullet Juicer. This manual provides essential information for the safe and efficient operation, maintenance, and care of your centrifugal juicer. Designed for convenience and performance, the NutriBullet Juicer makes it easy to extract juice from a variety of fruits and vegetables.

## IMPORTANT SAFETY INFORMATION

**Please read all instructions carefully before using the appliance. Failure to follow these instructions may result in electric shock, fire, or serious injury.**

- Always ensure the juicer is properly assembled and all parts are securely locked before operation.
- Do not operate the appliance with a damaged cord or plug. Contact customer service for repair.
- Keep hands and utensils out of the feed chute during operation to prevent injury. Always use the food pusher provided.
- Do not immerse the motor base in water or any other liquid.
- Unplug the juicer from the outlet when not in use, before assembling or disassembling parts, and before cleaning.
- This product is designed for household use only.
- Product built to North American & Canadian Electrical Standards (110V).

## PARTS AND FEATURES

Familiarize yourself with the components of your NutriBullet Juicer:

- **800W Motor Base:** The main power unit of the juicer.
- **1.5L Pulp Basin with 3" wide feed chute:** Collects pulp and allows for whole fruit/vegetable insertion.
- **Stainless Steel Sieve:** Separates juice from pulp.
- **27oz Juice Pitcher:** Collects extracted juice.
- **Sealing Pitcher Lid with Froth Separator:** For storing juice and reducing foam.
- **Food Pusher:** Used to guide produce into the feed chute.
- **Cleaning Brush:** For easy cleaning of the sieve.

## SETUP

---

Follow these steps for initial assembly:

1. Place the motor base on a clean, dry, and stable surface.
2. Insert the stainless steel sieve into the pulp basin, ensuring it is seated correctly.
3. Place the assembled pulp basin and sieve onto the motor base. Align the locking arms on the side of the motor base with the grooves on the pulp basin and push them up until they click into place, securing the assembly.
4. Position the juice pitcher under the juicer's spout.
5. Ensure the control dial is in the 'OFF' position before plugging the unit into a 110V electrical outlet.

## OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

---

Prepare your fruits and vegetables and begin juicing:

1. Wash all produce thoroughly. For most fruits and vegetables, no slicing or dicing is required due to the 3-inch wide feed chute. Remove large seeds or pits from fruits like peaches or avocados.
2. Ensure the juice pitcher is in place under the spout.
3. Turn the control dial to the desired speed: 'LOW' for softer fruits and vegetables, or 'HIGH' for harder produce.
4. Gradually feed produce into the feed chute using the food pusher. Apply gentle, even pressure. Do not force produce into the chute.
5. Once juicing is complete, turn the control dial to 'OFF' and unplug the unit.
6. The 27 oz. sealing juice pitcher allows you to store fresh juice for up to 48 hours in the refrigerator.

## CLEANING AND MAINTENANCE

---

Proper cleaning ensures the longevity and hygiene of your juicer. The sieve, pulp basin, and juice pitcher are all dishwasher-safe.

1. Always unplug the juicer before cleaning.
2. Disassemble all removable parts: food pusher, pulp basin, sieve, and juice pitcher.
3. Rinse all removable parts under running water immediately after use to prevent pulp from drying and sticking.
4. Use the provided cleaning brush to thoroughly clean the stainless steel sieve. Pay special attention to the small holes to ensure optimal performance.
5. All removable parts can be washed on the top rack of a dishwasher.
6. Wipe the motor base with a damp cloth. Never immerse the motor base in water.
7. Ensure all parts are completely dry before reassembling or storing.

## TROUBLESHOOTING

If you encounter issues with your NutriBullet Juicer, refer to the following common problems and solutions:

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Juicer does not turn on.	Not plugged in; parts not assembled correctly; thermal overload.	Ensure unit is plugged in. Check that locking arms are securely in place. Unplug and let cool for 15-20 minutes if motor overheated.
Excessive vibration or noise.	Sieve is not properly seated or damaged; too much produce.	Disassemble and re-seat the sieve. Reduce the amount of produce being fed at once. Inspect sieve for damage.
Pulp is wet.	Incorrect speed setting; sieve clogged.	Use 'HIGH' speed for harder produce. Clean the sieve thoroughly, especially the small holes.
Juice leaks from unit.	Parts not assembled correctly; pulp basin full.	Ensure all parts are securely locked. Empty the pulp basin if it's full.


