Inspired by the legendary SM7B, it is ideal for close-mic applications such as podcasting, recording, live streaming, and gaming. Its robust all-metal construction ensures durability, while the adjustable yoke provides flexible placement options on various microphone stands.

SETUP

Connecting the Microphone

The microphone features both USB and XLR outputs. For direct connection to a computer or smartphone, use the provided USB-A or USB-C cables. For professional audio interfaces or mixers, utilize the XLR output.

On-Mic Controls

The microphone features a touch panel interface for quick adjustments. You can control microphone gain, headphone level, monitor mix, and mute directly from the mic.

For advanced control and customization, download the ShurePlus MOTIV Desktop Application. This software allows you to:

- Save custom presets.
- Enable Auto-Gain mode for real-time level adjustment.
- Apply compression and EQ presets.
- Utilize Voice-Isolating Technology to minimize background noise.

MAINTENANCE

To ensure the longevity and optimal performance of your Shure MV7 microphone, follow these maintenance

guidelines:

- **Cleaning:** Gently wipe the microphone body with a soft, dry cloth. Avoid using harsh chemicals or abrasive materials.
- **Storage:** When not in use, store the microphone in a dry, dust-free environment. The original packaging or a protective case is recommended.
- **Handling:** Handle the microphone with care. Avoid dropping it or subjecting it to strong impacts, as this can damage internal components.
- **Cable Care:** Ensure USB and XLR cables are not kinked or excessively bent, which can lead to internal wire damage.

TROUBLESHOOTING

If you encounter issues with your Shure MV7, refer to the following common troubleshooting steps:

- **No Sound Output:**
 - Ensure the microphone is properly connected via USB or XLR.
 - Check the microphone's mute button on the touch panel.
 - Verify input levels in your computer's sound settings or the ShurePlus MOTIV app.
 - If using XLR, ensure your audio interface has phantom power enabled if required by your setup (though the MV7 is dynamic and typically doesn't require it, check your interface settings).
- **Distorted Audio:**
 - Reduce the microphone gain in the ShurePlus MOTIV app or on the touch panel.
 - Ensure you are not speaking too close to the microphone.
- **Background Noise:**
 - Activate Voice-Isolating Technology in the ShurePlus MOTIV app.
 - Ensure your recording environment is as quiet as possible.
 - Adjust microphone position to minimize ambient sound pickup.
- **Microphone Not Recognized by Computer:**
 - Try a different USB port on your computer.
 - Ensure the USB cable is securely connected at both ends.
 - Restart your computer.
 - Check for updated drivers for your operating system or the ShurePlus MOTIV app.
