INTRODUCTION

With its easy-to-use design, the TRU Single Serve Brew System will have your cup of coffee ready in mere minutes. Simply add your preferred amount of water and select either the capsule or ground option, depending on your brewing preference. The included capsule holder is perfect for those busy mornings when you need a quick and easy cup of coffee. And the removable filter basket lets you savor the rich flavors of your favorite ground coffee roast.

Cleaning up after your coffee-making adventure is a breeze with the removable drip tray. Not only does it make cleaning easy, but it also allows you to use taller travel mugs, making it the ideal companion for your morning commute.

IMPORTANT SAFETY INSTRUCTIONS

Please read all instructions carefully before using this appliance to ensure safe operation and to prevent damage.

- Read all instructions.
- Do not immerse cord, plugs, or appliance in water or other liquid.
- Close supervision is necessary when any appliance is used by or near children.
- Unplug from outlet when not in use and before cleaning. Allow to cool before putting on or taking off parts, and before cleaning the appliance.
- Do not operate any appliance with a damaged cord or plug or after the appliance malfunctions, or has been damaged in any manner.
- The use of accessory attachments not recommended by the appliance manufacturer may result in fire, electric shock, or injury to persons.
- Do not use outdoors.
- Do not let cord hang over edge of table or counter, or touch hot surfaces.
- Do not place on or near a hot gas or electric burner, or in a heated oven.
- Always fill the water reservoir first before turning on the appliance.
- Do not open the brew chamber during the brewing process.
- Use only cold water in the water reservoir.
- This appliance is for household use only.

SETUP

Before First Use

1. Unpack all components from the packaging.
2. Wash the removable parts (drip tray, drip tray grate, removable filter, and capsule holder) in warm, soapy water. Rinse thoroughly.
3. Wipe the exterior of the coffee maker with a damp cloth.
4. Perform a cleansing brew cycle: Fill the water reservoir with clean water (without coffee), place a mug on the drip tray, and press either brew button to run a full cycle. Discard the water. This cleans the internal components.

OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

Brewing with Coffee Capsules

1. Place your coffee mug on the drip tray.
2. Open the top lid of the coffee maker.
3. Insert a coffee capsule into the capsule holder. Ensure it is seated correctly.
4. Close the top lid firmly until it clicks into place.
5. Fill the water reservoir with your desired amount of fresh, cold water (up to 14 fluid ounces). The water tank has markings for 6oz, 8oz, 10oz, and 14oz.
6. Press the 'CAPSULE' button. The button will illuminate, indicating brewing has started.
7. Wait for the brewing cycle to complete. The light will turn off when finished.

Brewing with Ground Coffee

1. Place your coffee mug on the drip tray.
2. Open the top lid of the coffee maker.
3. Remove the capsule holder if it is in place.
4. Insert the permanent filter basket into the brew chamber.
5. Add your desired amount of ground coffee to the filter basket. Do not overfill.
6. Close the top lid firmly until it clicks into place.
7. Fill the water reservoir with your desired amount of fresh, cold water (up to 14 fluid ounces).
8. Press the 'GROUND' button. The button will illuminate, indicating brewing has started.
9. Wait for the brewing cycle to complete. The light will turn off when finished.

CARE AND MAINTENANCE

Cleaning

- Always unplug the coffee maker and allow it to cool completely before cleaning.
- Remove and empty the drip tray and the filter basket/capsule holder after each use.
- Wash all removable parts in warm, soapy water. Rinse thoroughly and dry.
- Wipe the exterior of the coffee maker with a damp cloth. Do not use abrasive cleaners or scouring pads, as they may scratch the surface.
- Do not immerse the coffee maker unit in water or any other liquid.

Descaling

Over time, mineral deposits (limescale) can build up in your coffee maker, affecting its performance and taste. Regular descaling is recommended, especially in areas with hard water.

To descale, you can use a descaling solution specifically designed for coffee makers or a mixture of white vinegar

and water (1:1 ratio). Follow the instructions provided with your descaling solution or the general descaling procedure for single-serve coffee makers, which typically involves running several brew cycles with the descaling solution, followed by several cycles with clean water to rinse.

TROUBLESHOOTING

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Coffee maker does not turn on.	Not plugged in; power outlet not working.	Ensure the power cord is securely plugged into a working electrical outlet.
Coffee is not brewing.	Insufficient water in reservoir; lid not closed properly; capsule/filter not inserted correctly.	Fill water reservoir to desired level; ensure top lid is firmly closed; check that the capsule or filter basket is correctly seated.
Coffee tastes weak.	Too much water for coffee amount; coffee grounds too coarse; old coffee.	Use less water or more coffee grounds/stronger capsule; ensure coffee grounds are appropriate for drip brewing; use fresh coffee.
Coffee overflows from mug.	Mug is too small for selected water amount.	Use a larger mug or select a smaller water amount for brewing.
