1. INTRODUCTION TO WATCH LIST

The Amazon Prime Video Watch List is a convenient feature that allows you to keep track of movies, TV shows, and other video content you wish to watch later. It acts as a personal queue, making it easy to find and access content without having to search for it repeatedly. This manual will guide you through adding, managing, and troubleshooting your Watch List.

2. SETUP: ADDING ITEMS TO YOUR WATCH LIST

Adding content to your Watch List is a straightforward process, accessible from various points within the Prime Video interface.

2.1. Adding from a Product Detail Page

If you encounter problems with your Watch List, try these solutions:

| Problem | Solution |

| Item not appearing on Watch List | Ensure you clicked the "Add to Watchlist" button. Refresh the page or restart the app. Check your internet connection. |
| Cannot remove an item | Try refreshing the page or restarting the app. Ensure you are logged into the correct Amazon account. |

| Content on Watch List is no longer available | Content availability on Prime Video can change due to licensing agreements. This is normal and not a Watch List malfunction. |
| Watch List is empty or incorrect | Verify you are logged into the correct Amazon account associated with your Prime Video subscription. Clear your browser's cache and cookies, or reinstall the app. |

- **Internet Connection:** A stable internet connection is required to access and manage your Watch List.
- **Amazon Account:** An active Amazon account is necessary to use Prime Video and its features, including the Watch List.
- **Prime Membership:** While you can add content to your Watch List without a Prime membership, access to Prime-exclusive content requires an active Amazon Prime subscription.
