vidaXL Removable Livestock Tent

USER MANUAL

PRODUCT OVERVIEW

The vidaXL Removable Livestock Tent is engineered to provide a robust and portable shelter solution for various large livestock, including horses, sheep, and cows. Its primary function is to offer protection against harsh weather conditions, making it an ideal choice for temporary pastures, open fields, or paddocks. The tent's design emphasizes both durability and ease of use, ensuring a safe and accessible environment for your animals.

IMPORTANT SAFETY INFORMATION

WARNING: This product must NEVER be used in severe weather conditions, including but not limited to strong winds, heavy rain, snow, or storms. Failure to adhere to this warning may result in damage to the tent, property, or injury to animals or persons.

Always ensure the tent is securely anchored to the ground using all provided ropes and pegs. Regularly inspect the tent for any signs of wear or damage, especially after adverse weather. Do not modify the tent structure or materials, as this may compromise its integrity and safety.

PACKAGE CONTENTS

Before beginning assembly, please verify that all components listed below are present and undamaged:

- 1 x Roof with hook-and-loop fasteners
- 1 x Tubular Frame (consisting of various galvanized steel pipes)

- 2 x Door Panels (with roll-up zippered openings)
- Guy Ropes
- Screws
- Pegs

SETUP AND ASSEMBLY

The vidaXL Livestock Tent is designed for straightforward assembly. It is recommended that at least two people are involved in the assembly process for safety and efficiency.

Step-by-Step Assembly

1. **Unpack and Organize:** Carefully unpack all components and lay them out. Group similar parts together to facilitate identification.
2. **Assemble the Frame:** Begin by connecting the galvanized steel pipes according to the provided diagram (not included in this manual, refer to manufacturer's instructions). Ensure all connections are secure.

3. **Attach the Roof Cover:** Drape the 100% PVC roof cover over the assembled frame. Ensure it is

centered and aligned correctly. Secure the roof cover to the frame using the integrated hook-and-loop fasteners.

4. **Install Door Panels:** Attach the two door panels to the designated ends of the tent. These panels feature roll-up zippered openings for convenient access.

5. **Secure the Tent:** Use the provided guy ropes and pegs to firmly anchor the tent to the ground. Proper anchoring is crucial for stability, especially in moderate weather conditions.

OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

Once assembled and securely anchored, the vidaXL Livestock Tent provides a functional shelter. The tent is designed for easy access and ventilation.

Access and Ventilation

The tent features two door panels, one at each end. These panels can be rolled up and secured to allow for easy entry and exit of livestock of various sizes. The roll-up design also facilitates air circulation, which is important for maintaining a comfortable environment inside the tent.

To open a door, unzip the closure and roll the panel upwards. Secure it in the open position using the integrated fasteners. To close, unfasten the rolled-up panel and zip it down completely.

CARE AND MAINTENANCE

Proper care and maintenance will extend the lifespan of your vidaXL Livestock Tent.

- **Cleaning:** The 100% PVC material is water-resistant and can be cleaned with a damp cloth and mild soap. Avoid using harsh chemicals or abrasive cleaners, as these can damage the material.

- **Inspection:** Regularly inspect the tent for any signs of wear, tear, or damage to the PVC cover, zippers, fasteners, and especially the steel frame. Address any issues promptly to prevent further damage.
- **Anchoring:** Periodically check the tension of the guy ropes and the security of the pegs, especially after strong winds or heavy rain. Re-tension or re-secure as needed.
- **Storage:** If disassembling for storage, ensure all components are clean and completely dry before packing to prevent mold or rust. Store in a cool, dry place away from direct sunlight.

TROUBLESHOOTING

This section addresses common issues you might encounter with your livestock tent.

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Tent unstable or swaying in wind	Insufficient anchoring; loose guy ropes; pegs not fully secured.	Ensure all guy ropes are taut and pegs are driven fully into the ground. Consider additional anchoring in very soft soil.
Water pooling on roof	Improper tensioning of roof cover; frame not fully extended.	Re-tension the roof cover to ensure a tight fit. Verify all frame components are correctly assembled and fully extended.
Zipper difficult to operate	Dirt or debris in zipper teeth; zipper misaligned.	Clean zipper teeth with a small brush. Apply a silicone-based lubricant if necessary. Ensure the fabric is not caught in the zipper.
