INTRODUCTION

This manual provides essential information for the proper installation, operation, and maintenance of your MAXTO Helmet Bluetooth Headset Microphone Accessory. This accessory is designed to enhance the communication capabilities of your existing MAXTO Bluetooth headset models M2, M2C, MX1, and M3, offering clear voice transmission for various activities.

- MAXTO Microphone (Soft or Hard mic, depending on selection)

SETUP AND INSTALLATION

1. Choosing the Right Microphone

The MAXTO microphone accessory comes in two types: a **soft microphone** and a **hard microphone**. Select the appropriate type for your helmet:

- **Soft Microphone:** Ideal for full-face helmets, where the microphone can be discreetly placed inside the helmet padding near your mouth.
- **Hard Microphone:** Suitable for open-face or modular helmets, typically mounted on a boom arm that extends closer to your mouth.

2. Connecting to the Headset

1. Locate the dedicated microphone port on your MAXTO M2, M2C, MX1, or M3 Bluetooth headset unit. This port is typically a small jack or a specific connector designed for the microphone.
2. Carefully insert the microphone's connector into the port until it is securely seated. Ensure a firm connection to prevent audio interruptions.

3. Helmet Installation

1. **For Soft Microphone:** Position the microphone inside the helmet's cheek pad or liner, ensuring it is close to your mouth (within 1-2 cm) but not directly touching it. Use the adhesive backing or clips provided with your main headset unit to secure the microphone cable.
2. **For Hard Microphone:** Attach the microphone boom arm to the inside of your helmet, typically along the chin bar or near the opening. Adjust the boom arm so the microphone capsule is positioned directly in front of your mouth, approximately 1-2 cm away.
3. Route the microphone cable neatly along the helmet's interior, tucking it under padding or using cable clips to prevent interference with helmet operation or discomfort. Connect the cable to your MAXTO Bluetooth headset unit.

OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

Once the microphone accessory is correctly installed and connected to your MAXTO Bluetooth headset, its operation is integrated with the main headset unit. Refer to your specific MAXTO M2, M2C, MX1, or M3 headset manual for detailed instructions on:

- Powering on/off the headset.
- Pairing with Bluetooth devices (e.g., smartphone, GPS).
- Initiating and receiving calls.
- Using intercom functions.
- Voice commands (if supported by your headset model).

The microphone will automatically activate when you use any voice-enabled function on your connected MAXTO headset, such as making calls, participating in intercom conversations, or using voice assistants.

MAINTENANCE AND CARE

Proper care ensures the longevity and optimal performance of your microphone accessory.

- **Cleaning:** Gently wipe the microphone capsule and cable with a soft, dry cloth. Avoid using harsh chemicals, solvents, or abrasive materials.
- **Storage:** When not in use for extended periods, store the microphone in a clean, dry place away from extreme temperatures and direct sunlight.
- **Handling:** Avoid pulling on the microphone cable or bending it sharply, as this can damage internal

wiring. Handle the microphone and its connector with care.

- **Moisture:** While designed for helmet use, avoid exposing the microphone to excessive moisture. If it gets wet, allow it to air dry completely before use.

TROUBLESHOOTING

If you encounter issues with your microphone accessory, consider the following:

- **No Sound/Low Volume:**
 - Ensure the microphone connector is fully inserted into the headset port.
 - Check the volume settings on your MAXTO headset and connected device.
 - Verify that the microphone is positioned correctly near your mouth.
- **Unclear/Distorted Sound:**
 - Ensure the microphone is not obstructed or touching any part of the helmet.
 - Check for any damage to the microphone cable or capsule.
 - Test the microphone in a quiet environment to rule out external noise interference.
- **Intermittent Connection:**
 - Re-seat the microphone connector firmly into the headset port.
 - Inspect the cable for any signs of wear or damage.
