1. INTRODUCTION

Welcome to the world of **Super Mario 3D World + Bowser's Fury** for the Nintendo Switch. This game offers two distinct Mario adventures, combining classic platforming with new open-world exploration. Players can enjoy the game solo or team up with friends for cooperative and competitive play.

In *Super Mario 3D World*, choose from a variety of characters, each with unique playstyles, as you navigate colorful courses, collect Green Stars, and utilize various power-ups. The game supports local and online multiplayer for up to four players, encouraging both collaboration and friendly competition for the highest score.

The new *Bowser's Fury* adventure introduces free-roaming Super Mario gameplay in Lake Lapcat. Here, players must collect Cat Shines and work with Bowser Jr. to calm a rampaging, gargantuan Bowser. Both adventures feature a newly added Snapshot Mode for capturing memorable in-game moments.

2. SETUP

2.1 Inserting the Game Card

1. Ensure your Nintendo Switch console is powered off or in sleep mode.
2. Locate the game card slot on the top right side of your Nintendo Switch console.
3. Open the game card slot cover.
4. Insert the **Super Mario 3D World + Bowser's Fury** game card into the slot with the label facing the same direction as the console's screen. Push it in until you hear a click.
5. Close the game card slot cover.
6. Power on your Nintendo Switch. The game icon should now appear on the HOME Menu.

2.2 Digital Version Installation

If you purchased the digital version, download and install the game from the Nintendo eShop. Ensure you have sufficient storage space on your console or microSD card.

3. OPERATING

3.1 Game Modes

- **Super Mario 3D World:** This mode features traditional linear levels with a clear start and goal. Players progress through various worlds, collecting Green Stars, Stamps, and reaching the Goal Pole.
- **Bowser's Fury:** This is a new, open-world experience where Mario explores Lake Lapcat, a series of islands. The objective is to collect Cat Shines to power up the Giga Bell and confront a giant, enraged Bowser.

3.2 Characters and Power-ups

In *Super Mario 3D World*, you can choose from Mario, Luigi, Peach, Toad, and unlock Rosalina. Each character possesses unique abilities:

- **Mario:** Well-balanced, standard abilities.
- **Luigi:** Jumps higher but has slightly less traction.
- **Peach:** Can float for a short period, useful for crossing gaps.
- **Toad:** Fastest runner, but has a lower jump.
- **Rosalina:** Features a spin attack, similar to her abilities in *Super Mario Galaxy*.

Key power-ups include:

- **Super Bell:** Transforms characters into Cat form, allowing them to climb walls, pounce, and scratch.
- **Super Mushroom:** Increases character size and health.
- **Fire Flower:** Allows characters to shoot fireballs.
- **Tanooki Suit:** Grants the ability to float and perform a tail whip.
- **Boomerang Flower:** Equips characters with a boomerang for attacking enemies and collecting items.

3.3 Multiplayer

Both games offer multiplayer options:

- **Super Mario 3D World:** Supports 1-4 players locally and online. Players can cooperate to clear levels or compete for the highest score.
- **Bowser's Fury:** Supports 1-2 players. The second player controls Bowser Jr., who can assist Mario by attacking enemies and finding secrets.

 - **Console Care:** Keep your Nintendo Switch console clean and dry. Avoid exposing it to extreme temperatures or direct sunlight.
 - **Software Updates:** Periodically check for and install game software updates to ensure optimal performance and access to the latest features.

5. TROUBLESHOOTING

- **Game Not Loading:** Ensure the game card is inserted correctly. If using a digital version, verify the download is complete and not corrupted. Try restarting your Nintendo Switch console.
- **Freezing/Crashes:** If the game freezes or crashes, try restarting the console. Ensure the game software is updated to the latest version.
- **Controller Issues:** Ensure your Joy-Con controllers are properly attached or paired wirelessly. Check battery levels.
- **Online Play Issues:** Verify your internet connection is stable. A Nintendo Switch Online membership is required for online features.
