1. Introduction

2. IMPORTANT SAFETY INSTRUCTIONS

Always observe the following safety precautions to prevent injury or damage to the product.

- Keep the glue gun away from children.
- Do not touch the nozzle or melted glue, as they reach high temperatures and can cause severe burns.
- Use only recommended glue sticks.
- Do not operate the glue gun in damp or wet conditions.
- Ensure proper ventilation when using the glue gun.
- Never pull out a melting glue stick from the gun after use; allow it to cool and remain inside for the next use.
- Charge the battery in a power-off state for optimal battery life and safety.
- Do not use the glue gun while it is charging.
- Disconnect the charger once the battery is fully charged.



3. PRODUCT OVERVIEW

4. SETUP

4.1. Charging the Battery

- 1. Ensure the glue gun is powered off.
- 2. Connect the charger to the battery pack.
- 3. Plug the charger into a power outlet.
- 4. Charge the 2.2Ah lithium-ion battery for approximately 1-1.5 hours. The indicator light will show charging status (refer to charger instructions for specific light indications).
- 5. Unplug the charger once charging is complete.

Important: The glue gun will not heat when charging. Always charge the battery in the power-off state and use it without charging for optimal performance and battery longevity.

5. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

5.1. Inserting a Glue Stick

- 1. Ensure the glue gun is off and cool.
- 2. Insert a full-size glue stick (0.44" diameter) into the opening at the back of the glue gun. Push it firmly until it stops.

5.2. Powering On and Preheating

- 1. Press and hold the power button for 3 seconds to turn on the glue gun. The indicator light will illuminate.
- 2. Allow the glue gun to preheat for 2-3 minutes. The indicator light may change color or stop blinking when ready (refer to specific model indications).

5.3. Applying Glue

- 1. Once preheated, gently squeeze the trigger to dispense melted glue.
- 2. Apply glue to the desired surface.
- 3. Release the trigger to stop the glue flow.
- 4. For continuous application, gently push the glue stick further into the gun as needed.

5.4. Powering Off

Press and hold the power button for 3 seconds to turn off the glue gun. Allow it to cool completely before storing.

Attention: Do not pull out the melting glue stick from the glue gun after finishing work. Keep it inside for next use to prevent damage and ensure proper function.

6. MAINTENANCE

- **Cleaning**: Ensure the glue gun is completely cool before cleaning. Wipe the exterior with a clean, damp cloth. Do not use abrasive cleaners or solvents.
- **Storage**: Store the glue gun in a dry, cool place, out of reach of children. Ensure no glue sticks are partially pulled out.
- **Battery Care**: To prolong battery life, avoid fully discharging the battery frequently. Recharge when the power is low. If storing for extended periods, charge the battery to approximately 50% every 3-6 months.

7. TROUBLESHOOTING

| Problem | Possible Cause | Solution |
|---------------------------------|---|---|
| Glue gun does not heat up. | Battery not charged. | Charge the battery fully. |
| Glue gun does not heat up. | Power button not held long enough. | Press and hold the power button for 3 seconds. |
| Glue gun does not heat up. | Using while charging. | Disconnect charger; use only when not charging. |
| Glue not dispensing. | Not preheated sufficiently. | Allow 2-3 minutes for preheating. |
| Glue not dispensing. | Glue stick not fully inserted. | Push glue stick firmly into the gun. |
| Glue drips excessively. | Nozzle not fully heated or faulty. | Ensure full preheating. If problem persists, contact support. |
| Battery indicator light issues. | Refer to charger/battery specific instructions. | Ensure proper charging sequence (power off, then charge). |
