1. INTRODUCTION

Thank you for choosing the LeadsaiL Wireless Slim 2.4G USB Mouse. This manual provides essential information for the proper setup, operation, and maintenance of your device. Please read it thoroughly before use.

2. PACKAGE CONTENTS

Ensure all items are present in your package:

- LeadsaiL Wireless Slim 2.4G USB Mouse
- Mini USB Receiver
- User Manual (this document)
- 1 AA Battery (included)

3. PRODUCT OVERVIEW

Familiarize yourself with the components of your LeadsaiL wireless mouse.

- **Left Button:** Standard click function.
- **Right Button:** Context menu function.
- **Scroll Wheel:** For scrolling up and down. Also functions as a middle click.
- **DPI Switch Button:** Adjusts cursor sensitivity (800, 1200, 1600 DPI).
- **ON/OFF Switch:** Located on the bottom of the mouse to conserve battery.
- **Battery Compartment:** Houses one AA battery.
- **Nano USB Receiver Storage:** A dedicated slot on the bottom for storing the USB receiver when not in use.
- **Optical Sensor:** For precise tracking on various surfaces.

4. SETUP INSTRUCTIONS

1. Insert Battery:

Open the battery cover on the bottom of the mouse. Insert one AA battery (included) into the compartment, ensuring correct polarity. Close the battery cover securely.

2. Retrieve USB Receiver:

Locate the Mini USB receiver stored in its dedicated slot next to the battery compartment on the bottom of the mouse. Gently pull it out.

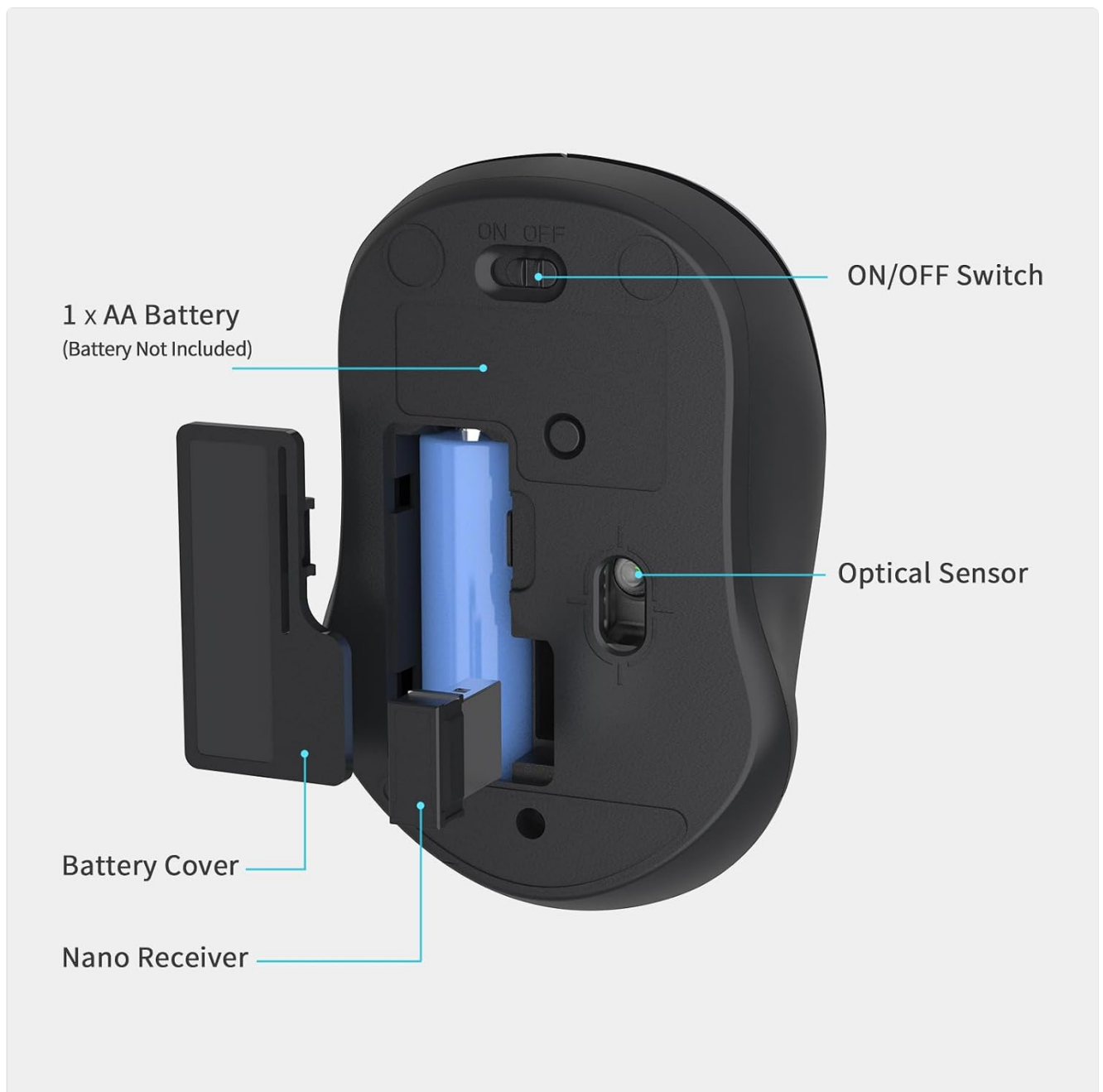


Image: The underside of the mouse, indicating the storage location of the Nano USB receiver.

3. Connect USB Receiver:

Plug the Mini USB receiver into an available USB port on your computer (laptop, desktop, or MacBook). Your computer should automatically detect and install the necessary drivers.

4. Power On Mouse:

Flip the ON/OFF switch on the bottom of the mouse to the "ON" position. The optical sensor light will illuminate, indicating the mouse is active.

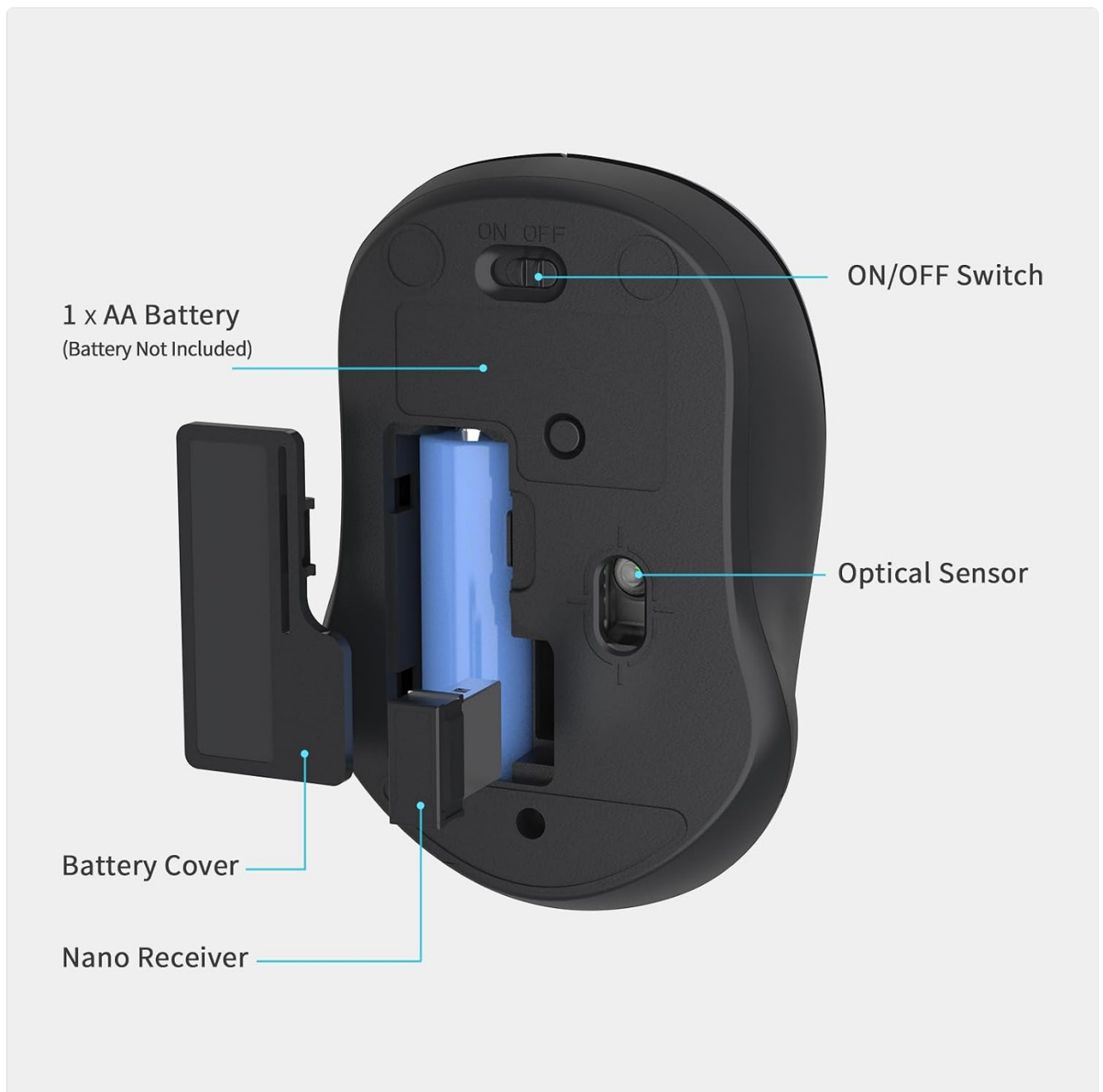


Image: The ON/OFF switch on the bottom of the mouse in the "ON" position.

The mouse should now be ready for use. If it does not connect immediately, try restarting your computer or plugging the USB receiver into a different port.

5. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

5.1 Adjusting DPI Sensitivity

The Leadsail mouse features 3 adjustable DPI levels (800, 1200, 1600) to suit your preference for cursor speed and precision.

- Press the **DPI Switch Button** (located below the scroll wheel) to cycle through the available DPI settings.
- Each press will change the sensitivity, allowing you to find the optimal speed for your tasks.

5.2 Silent Click Feature

The mouse is designed with silent click buttons to minimize noise, making it suitable for quiet environments like libraries, offices, or late-night use.

5.3 Ergonomic Design

6. POWER MANAGEMENT

- **Automatic Sleep Mode:** The mouse will enter sleep mode after 15 minutes of inactivity to conserve battery power.
- **Waking Up the Mouse:** To wake the mouse from sleep mode, simply press any button.
- **Manual Power Off:** For extended periods of non-use, switch the ON/OFF button on the bottom of the mouse to "OFF" to maximize battery life.

7. COMPATIBILITY

The LeadsaiL Wireless Slim 2.4G USB Mouse is compatible with a wide range of operating systems, including:

- Windows XP

- Windows 7/8/10/11
- Mac OS X
- Windows 2000 Server

It is suitable for use with laptops, desktops, and netbook PCs.

8. MAINTENANCE AND CARE

- **Cleaning:** Use a soft, dry cloth to clean the mouse. Avoid using harsh chemicals or abrasive materials.
- **Battery Replacement:** Replace the AA battery when the mouse performance degrades or stops working.
- **Storage:** When not in use, especially during travel, store the Mini USB receiver in its dedicated slot on the mouse to prevent loss. Turn off the mouse to conserve battery.
- **Durability:** The mouse is designed for durability, having passed 5,000,000 keystroke tests. However, avoid dropping or subjecting it to excessive force.

9. TROUBLESHOOTING

Problem	Solution
Mouse not responding	◦ Ensure the mouse is turned ON. ◦ Check if the battery is correctly inserted and has sufficient charge. Replace if necessary. ◦ Verify the USB receiver is securely plugged into a working USB port on your computer. ◦ Try plugging the USB receiver into a different USB port. ◦ Restart your computer.
Cursor movement is erratic or slow	◦ Clean the optical sensor on the bottom of the mouse. ◦ Ensure you are using the mouse on a suitable surface (e.g., a mouse pad). ◦ Adjust the DPI sensitivity using the DPI switch button. ◦ Check for low battery.
Wireless connection issues	◦ Ensure the mouse is within the 50ft/15M transmission range of the USB receiver. ◦ Avoid placing the mouse or receiver near strong electromagnetic interference sources.
