# Thule Panorama Awning Instruction Manual

Model: Omnistor 5200 (4.50m, XL)

## 1. INTRODUCTION

This manual provides detailed instructions for the installation, operation, and maintenance of your Thule Panorama Awning, designed for use with the Thule Omnistor 5200 awning system. The Thule Panorama Awning creates a spacious and comfortable living area outside your recreational vehicle, offering protection from the elements and enhancing your outdoor experience.

Please read this manual thoroughly before attempting to set up or use the awning to ensure safe and correct operation and to maximize the lifespan of your product.

## 2. SAFETY INFORMATION

Always prioritize safety during installation and use. Failure to follow these instructions could result in injury or damage to the product or vehicle.

- **Wind and Weather Conditions:** Do not use the awning in strong winds, heavy rain, or snow. Retract the awning immediately if adverse weather conditions are anticipated or occur.
- **Secure Installation:** Ensure all poles, straps, and pegs are securely fastened to prevent the awning from collapsing or being lifted by wind.
- **Clearance:** Verify sufficient clearance around the awning when extended to avoid obstructions or damage.
- **Children and Pets:** Keep children and pets away from the awning during setup and retraction.
- **Maintenance:** Regularly inspect all components for wear, damage, or loose connections. Do not use a damaged awning.

## 3. COMPONENTS AND PACKAGE CONTENTS

Your Thule Panorama Awning package should include the following main components:

- Awning fabric (main body)
- Frame poles (roof poles, vertical poles)
- Tensioning straps and pegs
- Carry bag for storage

- Instruction manual

Please check all contents against the packing list upon receipt.

## 4. SETUP

Follow these steps for proper setup of your Thule Panorama Awning:

1. **Prepare the Area:** Park your vehicle on a level surface. Clear the area where the awning will be extended of any sharp objects or debris.
2. **Extend the Vehicle Awning:** Fully extend your Thule Omnistor 5200 vehicle awning.
3. **Attach the Panorama Awning:** Unroll the Panorama awning fabric. Slide the keder bead of the Panorama awning into the rail on the front profile of your vehicle awning. Ensure it is fully inserted and centered.
4. **Install Roof Poles:** Insert the roof poles into the designated pockets or attachment points on the Panorama awning fabric and connect them to the vehicle awning's support arms. Tension the poles to create a taut roof.
5. **Assemble Vertical Poles:** Assemble the vertical poles and attach them to the corners of the Panorama awning. Extend them to the desired height.
6. **Secure with Pegs and Straps:** Use the provided pegs to secure the base of the vertical poles and the ground skirt of the awning. Attach tensioning straps to the designated points on the awning and peg them securely into the ground at an appropriate angle (approximately 45 degrees) to provide stability.
7. **Adjust Tension:** Adjust all poles and straps to ensure the awning fabric is taut and wrinkle-free, allowing for proper water runoff and wind resistance.

## 5. OPERATING

Once set up, the Thule Panorama Awning is designed for ease of use. The side and front panels can be rolled up or removed to adapt to changing weather conditions or privacy needs.

- **Opening/Closing Panels:** Zippers and buckles allow for easy opening, closing, or removal of individual panels.
- **Ventilation:** Integrated ventilation options, such as mesh windows, can be opened to improve airflow and reduce condensation.
- **Retracting the Awning:** To retract, reverse the setup steps. Ensure the fabric is clean and dry before packing to prevent mold and mildew.

### Awning Panel Configurations

The Thule Panorama Awning is available in various lengths, which determine the number of window panels. Below are illustrative diagrams of common panel configurations:




Image: Diagram illustrating a two-window panel configuration, typical for shorter awning lengths.




Image: Diagram illustrating a two-window panel configuration, showing a slightly different design or size variation.




Image: Diagram illustrating a three-window panel configuration, common for medium-length awnings.




Image: Diagram illustrating a four-window panel configuration, typically found on longer awning models like the 4.50m XL.

## 6. MAINTENANCE

Regular maintenance will extend the life of your Thule Panorama Awning.

- **Cleaning Fabric:** Clean the awning fabric with mild soap and lukewarm water. Do not use harsh chemicals or abrasive cleaners. Rinse thoroughly and allow to air dry completely before packing.
- **Cleaning Windows:** Use a soft cloth and a non-abrasive cleaner specifically designed for clear vinyl or plastic windows.
- **Frame and Poles:** Wipe down poles and frame components to remove dirt and moisture. Check for any signs of corrosion or damage. Lubricate moving parts if necessary.
- **Storage:** Store the awning in its carry bag in a dry, cool place, away from direct sunlight and extreme temperatures. Ensure it is completely dry to prevent mold and mildew.

## 7. TROUBLESHOOTING

Here are solutions to common issues you might encounter:

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Awning fabric sags or pools water.	Insufficient tension; incorrect pole height.	Adjust pole heights and tensioning straps to ensure fabric is taut and has a slight slope for water runoff.

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Difficulty sliding keder bead into rail.	Rail obstruction; keder bead misaligned.	Check rail for debris. Ensure keder bead is aligned straight and apply gentle, consistent pressure. A silicone spray can help.
Awning unstable in light wind.	Insufficient pegging; loose straps.	Ensure all pegs are fully inserted and tensioning straps are tight. Consider using storm straps in windy conditions.


