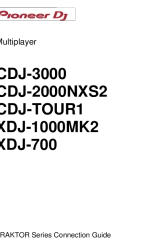

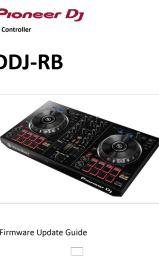

4. SETUP

Follow these steps to set up your CDJ-3000 and connect it to a mixer and other devices:

1. **Power Connection:** Connect the provided power cable to the CDJ-3000 unit and a power outlet.
2. **Audio Connection:** Connect the digital audio cable from the CDJ-3000's DIGITAL OUT port to a digital input channel on your mixer (e.g., Channel 2 or 3).
3. **Ethernet Link (Pro DJ Link):** For multi-player setups and advanced features like sharing music from a single USB drive across multiple players and a mixer, connect the CDJ-3000's LINK port to an Ethernet hub using an Ethernet cable. Then, connect your mixer and other CDJ-3000 units to the same Ethernet hub.
4. **USB Device:** Insert your USB drive containing music files into the USB port on the CDJ-3000.
5. **Power On Sequence:** Always power on your CDJ-3000 units and mixer first. After they are fully powered on, then power on your amplifiers and speakers. When powering off, turn off speakers/amplifiers first, then your DJ equipment. This prevents damaging
