INTRODUCTION

Welcome to the KETTLER Alpha Run 600 Treadmill user manual. This guide provides essential information for the safe and effective operation, maintenance, and troubleshooting of your new fitness equipment. Please read this manual thoroughly before assembly and use to ensure optimal performance and longevity of your treadmill.

SETUP AND ASSEMBLY

Proper setup is crucial for the safety and performance of your KETTLER Alpha Run 600 treadmill. Ensure you have adequate space and follow these guidelines.

1. Unpacking and Placement

- Carefully remove all components from the packaging. Retain packaging materials for future transport or storage.
- Place the treadmill on a flat, stable surface. Ensure there is at least 2 meters (6.5 feet) of clear space behind the treadmill and 0.5 meters (1.6 feet) on each side for safe operation and emergency dismount.
- Avoid placing the treadmill in direct sunlight or near heat sources, and ensure good ventilation.

2. Assembly (General Guidelines)

While specific assembly steps are detailed in a separate assembly guide, general steps involve:

1. Attaching the uprights to the base frame.
2. Mounting the console to the uprights.
3. Connecting all necessary cables as indicated in the assembly diagram.
4. Ensuring all bolts and screws are securely tightened before use.

3. Power Connection

- Connect the power cord to the treadmill's power inlet and then to a grounded electrical outlet.
- Ensure the power switch (usually located near the power cord inlet) is in the "ON" position.

OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

The KETTLER Alpha Run 600 is designed for intuitive use, offering a range of features for an effective workout.

1. Console Overview

The console features an LCD screen, control buttons for speed and incline, program selection, and quick keys. Familiarize yourself with the layout before starting your workout.

2. Starting a Workout

- Ensure the safety key is properly placed on the console. The treadmill will not operate without it.
- Step onto the side rails of the treadmill.
- Press the **START** button. The belt will begin to move at a low speed.
- Carefully step onto the running belt.

3. Adjusting Speed and Incline

- **Speed:** Use the **SPEED +** and **SPEED -** buttons to adjust your running speed. The treadmill supports speeds up to 20 km/h. Quick speed buttons may also be available for instant adjustments.
- **Incline:** Use the **INCLINE +** and **INCLINE -** buttons to change the incline level. The incline can be adjusted up to 12%. Quick incline buttons may also be available.

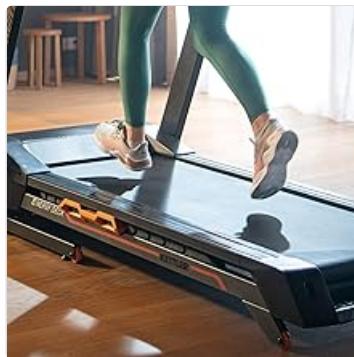


Figure 4: A user actively running on the KETTLER Alpha Run 600 treadmill, demonstrating its use during a workout session.

4. Training Programs

The Alpha Run 600 offers 32 pre-set training programs. Select a program from the console to automatically adjust speed and incline throughout your workout, providing varied and challenging routines.

5. Connectivity and Features

- **Bluetooth Interface:** Connect your smartphone or tablet via Bluetooth to compatible fitness apps for enhanced tracking and workout experiences.
- **Smartphone/Tablet Support:** The console includes a holder for your device, allowing you to use apps or watch media during your workout.
- **Energy Deck Cushioning:** This system provides joint-friendly running with optimal energy return, enhancing comfort and reducing impact.

6. Stopping a Workout

- Press the **STOP** button. The belt will gradually slow down and stop.
- Alternatively, pull the safety key from the console for an emergency stop. The treadmill will immediately cease operation.

MAINTENANCE

Regular maintenance ensures the longevity and safe operation of your KETTLER Alpha Run 600 treadmill.

1. Cleaning

- Always unplug the treadmill before cleaning.

- Wipe down the console and exterior surfaces with a soft, damp cloth. Avoid abrasive cleaners or solvents.
- Regularly vacuum under and around the treadmill to prevent dust and debris from accumulating.

2. Belt Lubrication

The running belt requires periodic lubrication to reduce friction and extend its lifespan. Refer to your specific lubrication instructions provided with the treadmill or contact KETTLER support for recommended lubricants and frequency.

3. Belt Tension and Alignment

Over time, the running belt may become loose or shift to one side. Consult the detailed assembly guide for instructions on how to properly tension and align the belt. Incorrect tension or alignment can lead to premature wear or unsafe operation.

TROUBLESHOOTING

This section addresses common issues you might encounter with your KETTLER Alpha Run 600 treadmill. For problems not listed here, please contact customer support.

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Treadmill does not power on.	Power cord not connected; power switch off; circuit breaker tripped.	Ensure power cord is securely plugged in. Check power switch is ON. Reset household circuit breaker if tripped.
Running belt does not move.	Safety key not in place; emergency stop activated.	Ensure safety key is correctly inserted into the console. Check if the emergency stop button is pressed.
Belt slips or hesitates during use.	Belt too loose; belt requires lubrication.	Adjust belt tension according to the assembly guide. Lubricate the running belt as per maintenance instructions.
Unusual noises from the treadmill.	Loose components; motor issues; worn belt.	Inspect for any loose bolts or screws and tighten them. If noise persists, discontinue use and contact KETTLER customer support.
