1. Introduction

This manual provides essential information for the safe and efficient operation of your Thomson LED TV 55UG6300. Please read this manual thoroughly before using your television and retain it for future reference. This television features a 55-inch 4K Ultra HD LED display with Smart TV capabilities, including pre-installed applications like Netflix and YouTube.

2. SAFETY INFORMATION

4. SETUP

4.1 Attaching the Stand

- 1. Carefully place the TV face-down on a soft, clean surface to prevent screen damage.
- 2. Align each stand piece with the corresponding slots on the bottom of the TV.
- 3. Secure the stands using the provided screws. Ensure they are tightened firmly.

4.2 Wall Mounting

The TV supports VESA wall mounting. For wall mounting, remove the stand. The VESA mounting pattern is 300 x 300 mm. Use M6 screws (not included) with a length appropriate for your wall mount bracket and wall type. Consult a professional for wall mounting installation.

4.3 Connecting Peripherals

Your Thomson TV offers various connectivity options:

- **HDMI:** Connect external devices such as Blu-ray players, game consoles, or set-top boxes using HDMI cables. The TV has 3 HDMI 2.0b ports.
- **USB:** Connect USB storage devices for media playback. The TV has 2 USB 2.0 ports.
- Wi-Fi: Connect to your home wireless network for Smart TV features.
- Ethernet (LAN): For a stable wired internet connection, connect an Ethernet cable to the LAN port.
- Antenna/Cable: Connect your antenna or cable TV feed for broadcast channels.

4.4 First Time Setup

After connecting the power cord and turning on the TV, follow the on-screen instructions to complete the initial setup. This typically includes selecting your language, connecting to a network, and scanning for channels.

5. OPERATING THE TV

5.1 Remote Control

Use the included remote control to navigate the TV's functions. Common buttons include Power, Volume Up/Down, Channel Up/Down, Input Source, Home, and Navigation (Up, Down, Left, Right, OK).

5.2 Smart TV Features

- Always unplug the TV before cleaning.

6.2 Software Updates

To ensure optimal performance and access to the latest features, it is recommended to keep your TV's software updated. Check for updates periodically through the TV's settings menu. Some updates may require a USB drive if not available over-the-air (OTA).

7. TROUBLESHOOTING

If you encounter issues with your TV, refer to the following common problems and solutions:

- **No Power:** Ensure the power cord is securely plugged into both the TV and a working electrical outlet. Check the power indicator light on the TV.
- **No Picture/Sound:** Verify the correct input source is selected. Check all cable connections (HDMI, antenna). Try another channel or input device.
- **Poor Picture Quality:** Check antenna/cable connections. Adjust picture settings (brightness, contrast, sharpness). Ensure the source content is high quality.
- Remote Control Not Working: Replace the batteries. Ensure there are no obstructions between the remote and the TV's IR sensor.
- **No Internet Connection:** Check your Wi-Fi router and internet service. Reconnect to the Wi-Fi network in the TV settings. For wired connections, ensure the Ethernet cable is properly connected.
