INTRODUCTION

Thank you for choosing the GENIANI Erie Portable Small Cool Mist Humidifier. This manual provides essential information for safe operation, effective use, and proper maintenance of your device. Please read it thoroughly before use and retain it for future reference.

IMPORTANT SAFETY INSTRUCTIONS

- Use only clean tap water or distilled water. Do not add essential oils directly into the water tank as this can damage the unit.
- Ensure the humidifier is placed on a stable, flat surface.
- Do not immerse the unit in water or other liquids.
- Keep out of reach of children and pets.
- Unplug the humidifier when not in use, during cleaning, or when refilling.
- Do not block the mist outlet.
- Do not attempt to repair or disassemble the unit yourself. Contact customer support if issues arise.
- This device is USB powered and not rechargeable.

PRODUCT OVERVIEW

SETUP GUIDE

Follow these steps to set up your humidifier for first use:

1. **Remove Top Cover:** Gently twist and lift the top cover from the water tank.

2. **Pre-soak Filter:** Remove the cotton filter stick from the top unit. Submerge it in water for approximately 30 seconds to ensure it is fully saturated. This is crucial for proper mist production.

3. **Fill Water Tank:** Fill the clear water tank with clean tap water or distilled water up to the maximum fill line. Do not overfill.

4. **Reinsert Filter:** Place the pre-soaked cotton filter stick back into its housing in the top cover.
5. **Reattach Top Cover:** Align the top cover with the water tank and twist it securely into place.
6. **Connect Power:** Plug the USB power cable into the humidifier's port and connect the other end to a compatible USB power source (e.g., computer, USB wall adapter).

OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

The humidifier features a single control button for power and mist modes.

1. **Power On/Continuous Mist:** Press the button once to turn on the humidifier. It will start in continuous mist mode, providing a steady stream of cool mist.
2. **Intermittent Mist:** Press the button a second time to switch to intermittent mist mode. In this mode, the

humidifier will mist for a period, then pause, and then mist again, extending the runtime.

3. **Power Off:** Press the button a third time to turn off the humidifier.
4. **Night Light:** Press and hold the button for 3 seconds to activate the night light feature. The light will illuminate the water tank. Hold again for 3 seconds to turn off the night light.

Auto Shut-Off: The humidifier is equipped with an auto shut-off feature that will automatically turn off the device when the water level is low, ensuring safety and preventing damage.

Essential Oil Tray: This model is not designed for essential oils to be added directly to the water tank. If your model includes a separate essential oil tray (check product specifications), add a few drops of essential oil to the designated pad in the tray, then reinsert the tray into the unit. (Note: The 0.25L Erie model does not have a dedicated essential oil tray for direct use with essential oils in the water tank, as indicated by product warnings. Some larger Geniani models may have this feature, but it's important to follow specific model instructions.)

MAINTENANCE AND CLEANING

Regular cleaning is essential to prevent mineral buildup and maintain optimal performance.

1. **Daily Cleaning:** Empty any remaining water from the tank and wipe it dry with a clean cloth.
2. **Weekly Cleaning:**
 - Unplug the humidifier.
 - Remove the top cover and water tank.
 - Clean the water tank with a soft brush or sponge and mild detergent. Rinse thoroughly to remove any soap residue.
 - Wipe the mist outlet and the ultrasonic atomizer with a soft, damp cloth. Do not use abrasive materials or harsh chemicals.
 - Ensure all parts are completely dry before reassembling.
3. **Filter Replacement:** The cotton filter stick should be replaced every 1-3 months, depending on usage and water quality. Spare filters are available for purchase.

Descaling (if mineral buildup occurs):

- Mix a solution of equal parts white vinegar and water.
- Pour the solution into the water tank and let it sit for 30 minutes.
- Gently scrub any mineral deposits with a soft brush.
- Rinse the tank thoroughly with clean water until the vinegar smell is gone.

TROUBLESHOOTING

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
---------	----------------	----------

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
No mist or weak mist	Low water level Dry cotton filter stick Blocked mist outlet Mineral buildup on atomizer	Refill water tank. Ensure filter is fully saturated (pre-soak for 30s). Clean mist outlet. Clean atomizer with a soft cloth and descaling solution.
Leaking water	Top cover not securely attached Overfilled water tank	Ensure top cover is twisted on tightly. Do not exceed max fill line.
Unusual odor	Stagnant water Dirty tank	Empty and refill water daily. Clean the water tank thoroughly.
