4. FILTER TECHNOLOGY

The Coway Airmega Max2 filter system integrates an Activated Carbon filter and a Green True HEPA filter to provide comprehensive air purification.

4.1. Green True HEPA Filter

This filter captures up to 99.99% of 0.1-micron particles in the air, including pollen, pollutants, and other allergens. It is effective against fine dust, bacteria, mold, viruses, and pet dander.

4.2. Activated Carbon Filter

The Activated Carbon filter is designed to reduce bad odors and harmful gases by more than 99%. This includes volatile organic compounds (VOCs), pet odors, food smells, and fumes such as NH3 and CH3CHO.





Figure 4.1: HyperCaptive Air Filtration System components and their functions.

Simple steps to replace Max2 Filter




Step 1

- ·Odor filter replacement (1/6months).
- ·HEPA filter replacement (1/year).

Step 2

To replace the filters, takeoff the front cover.



Step 3

Take out the old and replace with new filters (Odor > Green True HEPA™ filter).



Step 4

Put the cover back on, press button to reset.

Follow these steps to replace the Max2 filter set in your Coway Airmega 150 air purifier:

- 1. Step 1: Power Off Turn off the air purifier and unplug it from the power outlet.
- 2. Step 2: Remove Front Cover Gently pull the front cover of the air purifier to detach it.
- 3. **Step 3: Remove Old Filters** Remove the used Activated Carbon filter and the Green True HEPA filter from the unit.
- 4. **Step 4: Install New Filters** Insert the new Green True HEPA filter first, followed by the new Activated Carbon filter. Ensure they are correctly oriented according to the markings on the filters and the unit.
- 5. **Step 5: Replace Front Cover** Reattach the front cover to the air purifier, ensuring it clicks securely into place.
- 6. **Step 6: Reset Filter Indicator** Plug in the air purifier and turn it on. Press and hold the 'Filter Reset' button (or the relevant indicator for Max2 filter) for 3 seconds until the indicator light turns off.

6. MAINTENANCE

Regular maintenance ensures the longevity and efficiency of your air purifier. While the Max2 filter set is replaced, the air purifier typically includes a washable pre-filter that requires periodic cleaning.

6.1. Washable Pre-Filter Cleaning

The pre-filter should be cleaned regularly to remove larger particles like dust and pet hair, extending the life of the Max2 filters. Refer to your air purifier's main instruction manual for specific cleaning intervals, typically every 2-4 weeks.

- 1. **Step 1: Remove Pre-Filter** Turn off and unplug the air purifier. Remove the front cover and then carefully slide out the pre-filter.
- 2. **Step 2: Clean Pre-Filter** Wash the pre-filter with water. You may use a soft brush to gently remove accumulated dust and debris.
- 3. Step 3: Dry Pre-Filter Allow the pre-filter to air dry completely before reinstallation. Ensure it is fully dry

to prevent mold growth.

4. Step 4: Reinstall Pre-Filter - Slide the clean, dry pre-filter back into its slot, then replace the front cover.

6.3. Filter Replacement Indicators

Your Coway Airmega 150 air purifier is equipped with indicator lights that signal when the filters need attention. The 'Odor' and 'HEPA' lights will illuminate when it's time to replace the respective filters.

- Odor Filter: Typically replaced every 6 months.
- **HEPA Filter:** Typically replaced every 12 months.

After replacing the filters, press and hold the 'Filter Reset' button for 3 seconds to clear the indicator lights.

- Unusual Noise: Check that all filters and the front cover are securely in place.
