INTRODUCTION

Thank you for choosing the MAXLam4 4-Roller Thermal Laminator. This device is designed for efficient and high-quality lamination of documents up to double letter size, using laminating pouches ranging from 3 to 10 mil in thickness. Please read this manual thoroughly before operating the laminator to ensure safe and optimal performance.

The MAXLam4 laminator features a 4-roller system for smooth, bubble-free results and pre-programmed settings for various pouch thicknesses. Its compact design and quick heating make it suitable for various office and home applications.

SAFETY INSTRUCTIONS

- Always place the laminator on a stable, flat surface.
- Ensure adequate ventilation around the machine during operation.
- Do not touch the laminator's hot surfaces during or immediately after use.
- Keep hands, hair, and loose clothing away from the feed opening.
- Do not laminate objects thicker than recommended pouch thickness or metal objects.
- Unplug the laminator from the power outlet when not in use or before cleaning.
- Do not operate the laminator if the power cord or plug is damaged.
- This appliance is not intended for use by persons (including children) with reduced physical, sensory or mental capabilities, or lack of experience and knowledge, unless they have been given supervision or instruction concerning use of the appliance by a person responsible for their safety.

PRODUCT OVERVIEW

Familiarize yourself with the components of your MAXLam4 laminator.

Key Features:

- Laminates documents up to double letter size.
- 4-roller system for perfect lamination results.
- Pre-programmed settings for 3, 5, 8, and 10 mil pouches.
- Compact, lightweight design with rapid warm-up.
- Reverse button for clearing misfeeds (ideal for photos, menus, and documents).

SETUP

1. **Unpack the Laminator:** Carefully remove the laminator from its packaging. Retain the packaging for future storage or transport.
2. **Placement:** Place the laminator on a flat, stable, and heat-resistant surface. Ensure there is enough clear space behind the machine for laminated documents to exit without obstruction.
3. **Power Connection:** Plug the power cord into a standard electrical outlet (110V / 60Hz).
4. **Power On:** Press the **POWER** button. The laminator will begin to warm up. The **READY** indicator light will illuminate when the machine has reached the optimal operating temperature for the selected pouch thickness. This typically takes a few minutes.

OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

1. **Select Pouch Thickness:** Once the laminator is powered on and warmed up, press the **SET** button repeatedly to cycle through the available pouch thickness settings: 3 mil, 5 mil, 8 mil, and 10 mil. The corresponding indicator light will illuminate. Wait for the **READY** light to turn on for the selected thickness before proceeding.
2. **Prepare Document:** Place your document inside a laminating pouch, ensuring it is centered and there is an even border around the document. Do not use pouches that are too large for your document, as this can cause air bubbles.
3. **Feed Document:** Insert the sealed edge of the laminating pouch straight into the laminator's feed opening. The laminator will automatically pull the pouch through. Do not force the pouch or pull it from the exit slot.

4. **Retrieve Laminated Document:** Once the pouch has fully exited the laminator, carefully remove it. The laminated document will be warm; allow it to cool on a flat surface for a few moments to ensure a firm seal.
5. **Using the Reverse Function:** In case of a misfeed or jam, immediately press and hold the **REV** (Reverse) button. This will reverse the rollers, allowing you to carefully pull the pouch out from the feed opening. Release the button once the pouch is clear.
6. **Power Off:** After completing your lamination tasks, press the **POWER** button to turn off the laminator. Allow the machine to cool down completely before storing.

MAINTENANCE

- **Cleaning:** Ensure the laminator is unplugged and completely cool before cleaning. Wipe the exterior with a soft, dry cloth. Do not use abrasive cleaners or solvents. For internal cleaning, occasionally run a laminator cleaning sheet (not included) through the machine to remove adhesive residue from the rollers.
- **Storage:** Store the laminator in a cool, dry place, away from direct sunlight and moisture. Ensure the power cord is neatly wrapped and not kinked.

TROUBLESHOOTING

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Laminator does not turn on.	No power, power cord not connected, power button not pressed.	Check power outlet, ensure power cord is securely plugged in, press the POWER button.
Laminated document has bubbles or is cloudy.	Incorrect temperature setting, pouch too thick/thin, document not centered, old pouches.	Ensure correct mil setting is selected and READY light is on. Use fresh, good quality pouches. Ensure document is centered. Run through the laminator again if necessary.
Pouch jams in the laminator.	Pouch inserted crooked, pouch too thick, multiple documents inserted.	Immediately press and hold the REV button to reverse the rollers. Carefully pull out the pouch. Ensure pouches are inserted straight and one at a time.
Laminator is slow to heat up.	Normal operation, cold environment.	Allow sufficient time for warm-up. Heating time may vary based on ambient temperature and selected mil setting.
