SETUP

1. Charging

Connect the headphones to a power source using the supplied USB-C charging cable. A full charge provides up to 20 hours of battery life. The headphones support fast charging.

2. Bluetooth Pairing

- 1. Ensure the headphones are powered off.
- 2. Press and hold the power button for 6 seconds until the LED indicator flashes blue, indicating pairing mode.
- 3. On your device (phone, tablet, laptop), enable Bluetooth and select "Shure AONIC 50" from the list of available devices.
- 4. The LED indicator will turn solid blue when successfully paired.

3. ShurePlus PLAY App

Download the free ShurePlus PLAY app for iOS and Android devices. This app allows you to customize your EQ, noise cancellation levels, and Environment Mode settings for a personalized listening experience.

1. Fingertip Controls

The headphones feature intuitive fingertip controls for easy management of audio and calls:

- Volume Control: Use the dedicated volume buttons to adjust playback levels.
- Music Playback: A single press on the multi-function button plays or pauses music. Double-press for next track, triple-press for previous track.
- Call Management: Press the multi-function button to answer or end calls. Press and hold to reject a call.

2. Adjustable Noise Cancelling & Environment Mode

Toggle between different listening modes to suit your environment:

- Noise Cancelling: Eliminate distractions for an immersive listening experience. Levels can be adjusted via the ShurePlus PLAY app.
- Environment Mode: Hear the outside world with the flip of a switch, allowing you to stay aware of your surroundings without removing your headphones. Levels can be customized in the ShurePlus PLAY app.

3. Wired Connectivity

The AONIC 50 headphones offer versatile wired connection options:

- 3.5mm Analog Audio Input: Use the included 3.5mm audio cable to connect to any device, including airplane entertainment systems, for continued listening.
- USB-C Digital Input: Connect via USB-C for charging and High-Resolution audio playback from compatible devices.

MAINTENANCE

To ensure the longevity and optimal performance of your Shure AONIC 50 headphones, follow these maintenance guidelines:

- Cleaning: Gently wipe the earcups and headband with a soft, dry cloth. Avoid using harsh chemicals or abrasive materials.
- Storage: When not in use, store the headphones in their protective carrying case. This helps prevent damage and keeps them clean. The headphones fold flat for convenient storage.
- Avoid Extreme Conditions: Do not expose the headphones to extreme temperatures, humidity, or direct sunlight for extended
 periods.

TROUBLESHOOTING

- Intermittent Static/Distortion with LDAC: If experiencing static or distortion when connected via LDAC, try adjusting the LDAC connection speed in your device's Bluetooth settings. Ensure your device's firmware and the headphone firmware are up to date.
- ANC Effectiveness: The Active Noise Cancelling is designed to reduce a broad range of ambient noise. If you find it less effective for certain sounds (e.g., human voices), this is typical for ANC technology. Ensure the earcups form a good seal around your ears.
- **Comfort Issues:** While designed for comfort, individual fit may vary. Ensure the headband is adjusted correctly and the earcups are positioned properly. The earcups are made with breathable mesh for extended wear.
- Battery Life Shorter Than Expected: Battery life can vary based on volume levels, ANC usage, and codec selection. Ensure the headphones are fully charged and try reducing volume or disabling ANC if extended battery life is critical.
