1. PRODUCT OVERVIEW

The KUAFU Fuel Tank Skid Plate (Model BL756) is designed to provide robust protection for your vehicle's fuel tank. Constructed from high-quality steel, this skid plate safeguards the fuel tank from potential damage caused by harsh road conditions, debris, and off-road elements. Its durable design ensures extended longevity and reliable protection for a critical component of your vehicle.

2. COMPATIBILITY

This KUAFU Fuel Tank Skid Plate is compatible with the following vehicle models:

It is designed to replace OEM part numbers: 52100376AB, 52100376AD, 52100376AE, 52100376AF, 52100376AG.

4. SAFETY INFORMATION

5. INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS

This fuel tank skid plate is designed for a direct bolt-on installation and typically requires no drilling. Professional installation is highly recommended for optimal safety and performance.

General Installation Steps:

1. **Prepare Vehicle:** Park the vehicle on a level surface and engage the parking brake. If necessary, lift the vehicle using a hydraulic jack and secure it with jack stands.
2. **Locate Mounting Points:** Identify the existing mounting points on the vehicle's chassis where the fuel tank skid

plate will attach. These are typically pre-drilled holes.

3. **Position Skid Plate:** Carefully lift and position the new KUAFU Fuel Tank Skid Plate against the underside of the vehicle, aligning its mounting holes with the vehicle's chassis.
4. **Secure with Hardware:** Insert the provided bolts through the skid plate and into the vehicle's mounting points. Hand-tighten all bolts initially.
5. **Install Straps:** Attach the fuel tank straps as per the vehicle's original configuration, ensuring the fuel tank is securely held in place.
6. **Final Tightening:** Once all bolts and straps are in place and aligned, progressively tighten all hardware using appropriate tools. Ensure all connections are secure but do not overtighten.
7. **Inspect:** Double-check all mounting points and connections to ensure the skid plate is firmly installed and there is no interference with other vehicle components.

6. OPERATION AND FUNCTION

The KUAFU Fuel Tank Skid Plate operates passively by providing a protective barrier beneath your vehicle's fuel tank. Its primary function is to absorb impacts and deflect debris, preventing punctures, dents, or other damage to the fuel tank during driving, especially in challenging terrain or off-road conditions. Once installed, no further operational input is required from the user.

7. CARE AND MAINTENANCE

- **Regular Inspection:** Periodically inspect the skid plate for any signs of damage, such as deep scratches, dents, or rust. Check the mounting hardware for tightness.
- **Cleaning:** Clean the skid plate as needed to remove accumulated dirt, mud, or salt, which can contribute to corrosion. Use mild soap and water, then rinse thoroughly.
- **Corrosion Protection:** If any paint chips or rust spots appear, clean the area and apply a rust-inhibiting primer and paint to maintain the protective finish.
- **Hardware Check:** Re-tighten all mounting bolts annually or after severe off-road use to ensure the skid plate remains securely attached.

8. TROUBLESHOOTING

- **Difficulty Aligning Holes:** Ensure the skid plate is correctly oriented. Slight adjustments to the vehicle's position or gentle manipulation of the skid plate may be necessary. Do not force bolts.
- **Loose Fit After Installation:** Re-check all mounting hardware. Ensure bolts are tightened to the manufacturer's recommended torque specifications (if available) or are firmly snug.
- **Unusual Noises:** If you hear rattling or rubbing noises after installation, inspect the skid plate for contact with other vehicle components. Adjust as necessary or add rubber isolators if appropriate.
- **Missing Hardware:** Refer to the package contents list. If any hardware is missing, contact KUAFU customer support for assistance.
