## INTRODUCTION

Welcome to your VIZIO V-Series 43-inch 4K HDR Smart TV, Model V Series 2018. This television delivers stunning 4K Ultra HD resolution, vibrant Dolby Vision HDR, and smart features for an immersive entertainment experience. Equipped with the VIZIO IQ Active 4K HDR Processor and Full Array Backlight, it ensures superior picture quality and uniform brightness. This product is part of the Amazon Renewed program, professionally inspected and tested to work and look like new.

*Please note: The SmartCast feature is no longer available for use outside of the USA, as the Vizio manufacturer has disabled this feature for international use.*

## SETUP

### 1. Unpacking and Stand Assembly

Carefully remove your VIZIO TV from its packaging. Ensure all included components are present: Power Cable, Remote Control, and Stand.



Figure 1: Rear view of the VIZIO V-Series TV with the stand attached. The stand feet are designed for easy slide-in installation at the bottom of the TV.

To attach the stand, align each stand leg with the corresponding slots at the bottom of the TV. Slide the legs into place and secure them with the provided screws. Alternatively, the TV is wall-mountable (mounting hardware sold separately).

## 2. Connecting Peripherals

Your VIZIO TV offers multiple connectivity options for your devices.

- **HDMI Ports:** Connect your cable box, gaming console, Blu-ray player, or other HDMI-enabled devices.
- **USB Port:** Insert a USB flash drive to view photos, play music, or watch videos directly on your TV.
- **Ethernet Port:** For a stable wired internet connection.
- **Antenna/Cable Input:** Connect an antenna for over-the-air broadcasts or a cable TV connection.
- **Audio Out (Optical/RCA):** Connect to external sound systems or soundbars for enhanced audio.

## 3. Initial Power On and Network Connection

Plug the power cable into the TV and a wall outlet. Press the power button on the TV or the remote control.

Follow the on-screen prompts to select your language, connect to your Wi-Fi network, and complete the initial setup.

### 1. Remote Control

The included remote control provides full functionality for navigating your VIZIO Smart TV.

- **Menu Button:** Accesses the main settings menu for picture, sound, network, and more.

For added convenience, you can also download the VIZIO SmartCast Mobile app on your smartphone to use it as a remote control.
