INTRODUCTION

These earphones are designed to provide clear audio and convenient hands-free communication for compatible devices with a 3.5mm audio jack. Featuring sound isolation and a built-in microphone with an answer/end button, they are ideal for use with smartphones and tablets.

PRODUCT OVERVIEW

Familiarize yourself with the components of your ATWATEC Wired Earphones:

- **Earbuds:** Deliver audio to your ears.
- **Inline Microphone:** Captures your voice during calls.
- **On/Off Button:** Used for answering/ending calls.
- **3.5mm Audio Jack:** Connects to your device's audio port.
- **Flat Cable:** Designed to resist tangles.

SETUP

1. Connecting to Your Device

1. Locate the 3.5mm audio jack on your smartphone, tablet, or other compatible device.
2. Insert the 3.5mm audio jack of the ATWATEC earphones firmly into your device's audio port.
3. Ensure the connection is secure for optimal audio quality and microphone functionality.

2. Choosing and Installing Ear Gels

The earphones come with extra ear gels in different sizes to ensure a comfortable and secure fit. A proper fit is essential for sound isolation and audio quality.

1. Gently remove the pre-installed ear gels from the earbuds.
2. Select the ear gel size that best fits your ear canal. Experiment with different sizes to find the most comfortable and secure fit.
3. Carefully push the chosen ear gels onto the earbud nozzles until they are securely attached.

OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

1. Audio Playback

Once connected to your device, you can play audio (music, podcasts, videos) through the earphones. Control playback (play, pause, skip tracks) directly from your connected device.

2. Call Management

The inline microphone and On/Off button allow for convenient hands-free call management.

- **Answering a Call:** When a call comes in, press the On/Off button once to answer.
- **Ending a Call:** During a call, press the On/Off button once to end the call.
- **Making a Call:** Initiate calls directly from your connected device. The microphone will automatically activate when a call is in progress.

MAINTENANCE

1. Cleaning

- Regularly clean the ear gels with a soft, dry cloth to remove earwax and debris.
- For deeper cleaning, ear gels can be gently washed with mild soap and water, then thoroughly dried before reattaching.
- Wipe the earphone cables and body with a soft, slightly damp cloth. Avoid using harsh chemicals or abrasive materials.
- Ensure the 3.5mm audio jack is clean and free of dust or lint.

2. Storage

- When not in use, store the earphones in a clean, dry place.
- Avoid wrapping the cable too tightly to prevent damage. The flat cable design helps reduce tangles.

- Keep earphones away from extreme temperatures and direct sunlight.

TROUBLESHOOTING

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
No sound from earphones.	Earphones not fully plugged in; device volume too low; incorrect audio output selected on device.	Ensure the 3.5mm jack is fully inserted. Increase device volume. Check device audio settings.
Microphone not working.	Earphones not fully plugged in; device microphone settings; microphone port blocked.	Ensure the 3.5mm jack is fully inserted. Check device privacy/microphone settings. Ensure microphone is not covered.
Poor sound quality (e.g., muffled, distorted).	Loose connection; dirty audio jack/port; damaged cable; incorrect ear gel size.	Re-insert the jack firmly. Clean the audio jack and device port. Try different ear gel sizes for a better seal.
On/Off button not responding.	Incompatibility with device; button malfunction.	Ensure your device supports inline controls. Test with another compatible device if possible.
Earphones fall out easily.	Incorrect ear gel size.	Try a different size of ear gels to find a more secure fit.
Cable tangles frequently.	Improper storage.	While the flat cable is designed to resist tangles, proper coiling during storage will further prevent tangles.
Sound isolation is poor.	Incorrect ear gel size or improper fit.	Ensure ear gels form a tight seal in your ear canal. Experiment with different sizes.
Earphones are uncomfortable.	Incorrect ear gel size or improper insertion.	Try different ear gel sizes. Ensure earphones are inserted gently and correctly.
