INTRODUCTION

The LEGO City Fire Command Unit 60282 playset offers an engaging building and play experience for children aged 6 and up. This set features a detailed fire truck with a functioning cherry picker arm, a separate firefighter robot with a water cannon, and a science lab setting with stackable LEGO flames. It includes minifigure characters Bob, Feldman, and Toastie the firefighter robot, allowing for imaginative play scenarios based on the LEGO City Adventures TV series.

SETUP AND ASSEMBLY

Follow the step-by-step instructions provided in the box to assemble your LEGO City Fire Command Unit. For an interactive building experience, you can also download the Instructions PLUS app on smartphones and tablets, which offers zoom and rotate viewing tools.

The set consists of 380 pieces, designed for a rewarding building process. Ensure all pieces are accounted for before beginning assembly. The main components to build are:

- The Fire Command Unit truck with a detachable trailer.
- A functioning cherry picker arm for high-reach operations.
- Toastie the firefighter robot with a water cannon.
- A science lab setting with stackable LEGO flames.
- Minifigures: Bob, Feldman, and Toastie the firefighter robot.

OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

Once assembled, the LEGO City Fire Command Unit offers various interactive play features:

- **Fire Truck and Cherry Picker:** The main fire truck features a cabin for a minifigure and a functioning cherry picker arm that can be elevated and rotated to reach high areas.
- **Firefighter Robot (Toastie):** Place Toastie the firefighter robot on its small vehicle, which is equipped with a water cannon. Press the button on the water cannon to shoot blue 'water' elements at the LEGO flames.
- **Science Lab with Flames:** The science lab setting includes stackable LEGO flame elements. Use Toastie's water cannon or the fire truck's cherry picker to 'extinguish' these flames. The lab also has a feature to simulate an 'explosion' by releasing a green element.
- **Accessory Storage:** The fire truck has compartments that open to store firefighting accessories like an axe and a walkie-talkie.

MAINTENANCE

To keep your LEGO City Fire Command Unit in optimal condition, follow these simple maintenance guidelines:

- **Cleaning:** Clean LEGO bricks and elements using mild soap and lukewarm water. Rinse thoroughly and air dry at room temperature. Avoid hot water, direct sunlight, or harsh chemicals, as these can damage the plastic.
- **Storage:** Store the set in a clean, dry place away from direct sunlight and extreme temperatures to prevent discoloration or warping of the plastic.
- **Handling:** Handle the set with care to prevent pieces from breaking or becoming lost.
