In-line Audio Controls

SETUP GUIDE

Connecting to Xbox One / Xbox Series X|S

- 1. Ensure your Xbox controller has a 3.5mm headset jack. Most modern Xbox controllers include this.
- 2. Plug the 3.5mm audio jack from the HyperX CloudX headset firmly into the headset jack on your Xbox controller.
- 3. If prompted, update your controller's firmware via the Xbox settings.
- 4. Adjust the volume using the in-line audio control on the headset cable or through your Xbox audio settings.
- 5. Ensure the microphone mute switch on the in-line control is in the 'unmuted' position if you intend to use voice chat.

Connecting to Mobile Devices

- 1. The HyperX CloudX headset is compatible with mobile devices that have a CTIA standard 3.5mm audio jack.
- 2. Plug the 3.5mm audio jack from the headset into your mobile device's audio port.
- 3. For audio-only use, you may detach the microphone.

OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

Adjusting Volume

Locate the volume wheel on the in-line audio control unit. Rotate the wheel upwards to increase volume and downwards to decrease volume.

Microphone Mute/Unmute

The in-line audio control unit features a switch to mute or unmute the microphone. Slide the switch to the position indicated for 'mute' (often with a red indicator) to turn off your microphone, and slide it to the 'unmute' position to enable it.

Detaching the Microphone

To detach the microphone, gently pull it straight out from the headset's microphone port. To reattach, align the microphone's connector with the port and push it firmly until it clicks into place.

MAINTENANCE AND CARE

- Cleaning Ear Cushions: Gently wipe the leatherette ear cushions with a soft, damp cloth. Avoid using harsh chemicals or abrasive cleaners.
- Cleaning Headband: Wipe the headband with a soft, dry cloth.
- Cleaning Microphone: If necessary, gently wipe the microphone foam with a dry cloth.
- Cable Care: Avoid sharp bends or excessive pulling on the cable to prevent damage.
- Storage: Store the headset in a cool, dry place away from direct sunlight and extreme temperatures.

TROUBLESHOOTING

No Audio from Headset

- Ensure the 3.5mm jack is fully inserted into the controller or device.
- Check the in-line volume wheel and ensure it is turned up.
- Verify the audio settings on your Xbox or mobile device.
- Test the headset with another device to rule out a device-specific issue.

Microphone Not Working

• Ensure the microphone is securely attached to the headset.

- Check the in-line microphone mute switch and ensure it is in the 'unmuted' position (no red indicator).
- Verify microphone settings on your Xbox or mobile device.
- Ensure your Xbox controller firmware is up to date.
- Test the microphone with another application or device if possible.
