1. INTRODUCTION AND SAFETY INFORMATION

This manual contains important information regarding the safe operation, assembly, maintenance, and troubleshooting of your Mac Allister 2800W Leaf Blower Vacuum. Please read it thoroughly before using the product and keep it for future reference.

General Safety Warnings

- Always wear appropriate personal protective equipment, including eye protection, hearing protection, and sturdy footwear.
- Ensure the power supply matches the specifications of the tool (230-240V).
- Keep children and bystanders away while operating the machine.
- Do not operate the machine in wet conditions or rain.
- Inspect the work area for objects that could be thrown or entangled in the machine.
- Disconnect the power supply before cleaning, maintenance, or when not in use.

2. PRODUCT OVERVIEW

The Mac Allister 2800W Leaf Blower Vacuum is a versatile garden tool designed for clearing leaves and debris. It offers three primary functions: blowing, vacuuming, and mulching. The unit features quick-change levers for switching between modes, variable speed control for airflow management, and a telescopic tube for comfortable operation.

3. SETUP

Before first use, ensure all components are present and undamaged. Refer to the diagram in the Product Overview section for component identification.

Assembly Steps:

1. **Attach the Blower/Vacuum Tube:** Align the tube with the main unit's outlet/inlet and secure it firmly. Ensure it clicks into place or is tightened according to the mechanism.
2. **Connect the Collection Bag:** For vacuuming and mulching, attach the 40L collection bag to the designated port on the main unit. Ensure the bag is securely fastened to prevent debris leakage.
3. **Adjust the Telescopic Tube:** Extend or retract the telescopic tube to a comfortable working height. Secure it in position.
4. **Attach the Shoulder Harness:** For extended use and improved comfort, attach the adjustable single harness to the designated points on the unit. Adjust the strap length to distribute weight evenly.
5. **Power Connection:** Plug the power cord into a suitable 230-240V outdoor-rated power outlet. Ensure

the cord is free from damage and positioned to avoid tripping hazards.

4. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

Switching Modes (Blower/Vacuum):

The unit features quick-change levers to switch between blowing and vacuuming modes. Locate the mode selection lever, typically near the handle. Move the lever to the desired position (blower or vacuum). Ensure the collection bag is attached when in vacuum mode.

Variable Speed Control:

The Mac Allister Leaf Blower Vacuum is equipped with variable speed control. Use the speed dial or trigger to adjust the airflow speed. Lower speeds are suitable for delicate areas or light debris, while higher speeds are effective for stubborn leaves and larger areas. The maximum airflow speed is 145 mph.

Operating the Blower:

1. Ensure the unit is in blower mode.
2. Point the nozzle away from yourself and others.
3. Start the motor.
4. Sweep the nozzle from side to side, directing leaves and debris into piles.

Operating the Vacuum/Mulcher:

1. Ensure the unit is in vacuum mode and the collection bag is securely attached and empty.
2. Start the motor.
3. Slowly move the nozzle over the leaves and debris. The mulching function will reduce the volume of collected material.
4. Monitor the collection bag and empty it when full to maintain optimal performance.

5. MAINTENANCE

Regular maintenance ensures the longevity and efficient operation of your leaf blower vacuum.

Cleaning:

- Always disconnect the power supply before cleaning.
- Wipe the exterior of the unit with a damp cloth. Do not use harsh chemicals or abrasive cleaners.
- Clear any debris from the air intake and exhaust vents to prevent overheating.
- Empty and clean the collection bag regularly. Wash the bag if necessary and ensure it is completely dry before reattaching.

Storage:

- Store the unit in a dry, well-ventilated area, away from direct sunlight and extreme temperatures.
- Ensure the power cord is neatly coiled and not kinked.
- Keep the unit out of reach of children.

6. TROUBLESHOOTING

If you encounter issues with your Mac Allister Leaf Blower Vacuum, refer to the following common problems

and solutions:

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Unit does not start	No power supply Damaged power cord Faulty switch	Check power connection and outlet Inspect power cord for damage; replace if necessary Contact customer support
Low blowing/vacuuming power	Blocked air intake/outlet Full collection bag Incorrect mode selection	Clear any obstructions Empty the collection bag Ensure correct mode (blower or vacuum) is selected
Excessive vibration/noise	Debris in impeller Loose components	Disconnect power and carefully remove debris from impeller Check all connections and tighten as needed
